GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.
- 16. ANTITRUST: In submitting a bid to any agency for the State of West Virginia, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted the bidder will convey, sell, assign or transfer to the State of West Virginia all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of West Virginia for price fixing and/or unreasonable restraints of trade relating to the particular commodities or services purchased or acquired by the State of West Virginia. As on-site supplies of the lime are depleted, it is necessary to order and receive additional quantities to maintain an adequate supply on site at all times. The contractor shall be responsible for acquiring and making delivery of the lime to the sites. The sites are in remote areas. The roads are passable, but during inclement weather conditions, passage is sometimes difficult. Delivery will be required during all weather conditions and on a seventy-two (72) hour notice and at an agreed upon time.

Vendor to provide a price per ton for delivery of 40 lb. bags of granulated lime. Also, provide a price for one box trailer with rear and side entrance doors, to be furnished for storage of lime, with the cost being no more than \$10.00 per day.

Article I - STATEMENT OF WORK

The Contractor shall furnish bagged CaO and all personnel and equipment necessary to deliver bagged CaO to water treatment sites as directed by a representative of the Department of Environmental Protection.

Article 2 - LOCATION OF WORK-SOUTH

The area of work shall include the Southern Counties of West Virginia. The counties listed below are the coal producing counties and those in parenthesis represent where most of the work required in this contract is located.

Article 4 - ORDERING PROCEDURE

- A. This is an open end quantity contract for the services specified and for the period set forth herein. Delivery or performance shall be made in accordance with the provisions of this contract.
- B. Work will be ordered by the Director or his representative, for the Division of Land Restoration, West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection by issuance of a work directive, which shall include the name of the project site, and the quantity of bagged CaO to be delivered. The contractor shall acknowledge receipt by signing, dating and forwarding back to the Director a copy of the work directive.

Article 5 - DELIVERY

A. The contractor shall acquire and deliver the specified quantity of bagged CaO in accordance to each work directive. The contractor shall give an invoice to the Department of Environmental Protection representative upon completion of work directives.

Article 6 - GENERAL CONDITIONS

- A. The contractor shall be responsible for paying and/or securing all taxes, permits, fees, insurance liability, compensations, and any other items necessary to render the owner free and harmless from all claims arising from services performed under this contract.
- B. The contractor shall take steps required to ensure equal opportunity for employment in accordance with policies promulgated by the Presidents Committee on Equal Opportunity.

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VENDOR:

- C. The State shall be responsible for obtaining all rights of entry for each project, if needed.
- D. The work and services to be performed under this contract shall be subject to continual monitoring and inspection by the State's authorized representative, such inspection will, among other things ensure technical compliance.
- E. In accomplishment of services to fulfill the requirements of the work directive, neither contractor nor his subcontractor shall create any adverse environmental effects and shall be responsible for compliance with all applicable local, state, and federal environmental and occupational health and safety regulations pertinent to the work.

Article 7 - COSTS AND PAYMENTS

- A. Payment to the contractor will be made on the following basis:
 - 1. Unit Pricing

Item - As directed by the State in specific work directive.

Quantity - As directed in the Work Directive.

Unit Price - As provided by the Offeror in the proposal.

B. The contractor shall invoice on specified DEP forms to the division after delivery as specified in the work directive and the delivery is accepted by the division. All invoices shall show the quantities and unit price as directed in the work directive and include <u>verification</u>. More than one work directive can be billed on the same invoice.

Article 8 - CHANGES IN THE CONTRACT

- A. The State, without invalidating the contract, may order changes in the work within the general scope of the contract consisting of additions, deletions, or other revisions, all such changes in the work shall be authorized by a change order, a change order signed by both the State and Offeror indicates their agreement to an adjustment to the contract. The cost or credit to the State resulting from a change in the work shall be determined in one or more of the following ways:
 - 1) By mutual acceptance of a lump sum properly documented (itemized)
 - 2) By unit prices (negotiated)

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
