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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.

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Propane Supply Specifications:

To supply propane gas and tanks and associated equipment for Blackwater Falls State Park for one (1) fiscal year. $7-1-\hat{b}-30$

Vendor will provide, on demand, sufficient tanks, devices, equipment and appurtenances, and propane to meet the usage requirements at the specified property.

Contract will include service and maintenance of all supplies and equipment to the exterior of the facility that is serviced.

All materials, equipment and service must meet current NFPA 58 Liquefied Petroleum Gas Code.

Owner will be responsible for interior equipment.

PRICING:

Vendors must be a firm fixed mark-up price per gallon on fuel delivery with product price tied to the OIL PRICE INFORMATION SERVICE (OPIS) publication. All priced quoted shall be the delivered price to any location within Blackwater Falls State Park.

Pricing will be based on the Weekly OPIS on the DAY OF THE ORDER. Please Note: The OPIS Weekly Average is posted every Friday morning.

FIRM FIXED MARK-UP PER GALLON:

Vendors shall bid only a firm fixed mark-up (percentages not acceptable) for business profit and expenses in supplying the product to the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. Product cost shall be the average rack price of the

product as published (for the preceding week) for the vendor supply terminal location in the OIL PRICE INFORMATION SERVICE as published by United Communications Group, 11300 Rockville Pike, Suite 1100, Rockville, MD 20852. Telephone number (800) 929-4824.

Emergency Service and Telephone Service:

Vendor response time must be within one (1) hour from initial contact.

Vendor must provide a twenty-four (24) hour emergency response number. The number is: 304 - 216 - 5113.

The emergency response number must be affixed the exterior of each tank.

Vendor cannot charge additional fees for emergency fuel deliveries.

Installation and Removal:

Vendor shall install equipment and provide propane service within thirty (30) days of the written "Notice to Proceed". The Vendor will be responsible for all connections, leak detection and supply to the exterior of the facility to which the supply serves. The Vendor will be responsible for coordinating the changeover of any existing tanks, transfer, replacement, etc. with the current Vendor, to assure safe transfer in accordance with all governing regulations and Codes.

Tanks are to be clean and painted white. Tanks must be set according to Owner's schedule and may not disrupt use by park guests. Lines, regulators and devices must be free of defects or repaired immediately.

The Vendor will be responsible for securing any permits required at no cost to the Owner.

All safety devices and equipment protection to be provided by current regulations and Codes, and must be updated whenever regulations or Codes change during the term of contract.

At the termination of this contract, the Vendor shall provide, at the same terms and conditions, during the interim period not to exceed sixty (60) days while a new Vendor supplies equipment and materials. The Vendor shall cooperate with any new Vendor to assure safe transfer in accordance with all governing regulations and Codes.

Removal of equipment, and or supplies, shall be at no expense to the Owner. Any damage or unsafe condition caused by removal must be repaired immediately and at no charge to the Owner.

Unused propane product removed during installation, and not transferred into any new Vendor tanks must be credited to the Owner at the stated contract price.

Propane Gas:

Propane to be supplied on scheduled basis, or upon demand by the Owner. Propane shall be commercial grade propane and conform to specifications and test methods as required by current Federal Specification.

Vendor to formulate delivery schedule commensurate with demand and provide supply as needed. Vendor is responsible for the delivery schedule at no additional cost to the Owner.

Winter additive for cold weather required as needed to prevent lines from freezing.

Billing and Payment:

Vendor must submit a separate invoice for each individual tank. Acceptance of State of West Virginia Purchasing Card is required. Items must be itemized and cannot include items not covered under this contract.

Vendor to provide, at invoice time, the meter reading of each tank before and after filling. A running total of each tank's demand is required and must be provided to the Owner at no additional charge at the end of the contract.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
