The West Virginia Purchasing Division for the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources is requesting bids for the purchase of one (1) Forestry Grade Compact Track Loader with Rotary Mulcher Attachment. All items are to be F.O.B. Destination. Freight or delivery charges must be included in the price of the goods. Delivery must be made within thirty (30) days of purchase order award.

General Specifications:

The Forestry Grade Compact Track Loader with Rotary Mulcher Attachment must be manufactured for commercial use. All items must be new (2010 model).

Information for Bidders:

Bidders must submit a unit price bid for each item to furnish all items specified.

Damaged Items:

Damaged or defective items must be replaced at no additional expense to The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources.

Warranty:

The equipment must be guaranteed to be free of defects in workmanship and material for a minimum of one (1) year from date of acceptance. However, if manufacturer warranty periods are longer than the required minimum one year warranty, those warranties shall apply.

Forestry Grade Compact Track Loader with Rotary Mulcher Attachment

Forestry grade loader/rotary mulcher must meet the following specifications:

- Must have a diesel engine with a minimum gross horsepower of 95 HP.
- Must have general purpose tracks with minimum track width of 17 inches.
- Must have a hydrostatic powertrain
- Must have a heavy duty independent suspension of undercarriage
- Must have pilot joystick controls
- Must have a suspension seat with lap and shoulder belts and seat belt
- Must have auxiliary hydraulic (quick connect fittings) with low flow maximum of 25 gpm and high flow maximum of 40 gpm
- Must have an engine block heater
- Must be ROPS/FOPS/OPS (certified)

- Must have indicators warning lights for engine oil pressure, hot hydraulic oil and low battery voltage and a tachometer gauge, engine temperature gauge , and a fuel level gauge
- Must have front and rear emergency exits and a heavy duty polycarbonate door (severe duty) and wiper
- Must have light, hood, window, hose and cylinder, and condenser guards and skid plates and heavy duty grill
- Must have a climate control system with high output with a/c, heat and service access
- Must not exceed 14,500 lbs. (total weight) for entire package (track loader and mulcher attachment)
- Must have a heavy duty rotary drum (quick attach) mulcher attachment with steel push bar which has a minimum cutting width of 60 inches and maximum outside width of 75 inches. Rotary drum must have a hydraulic brake.
- Must have a horn and back-up alarm

(Does not apply to construction contracts). *West Virginia Code*, §5A-3-37, provides an opportunity for qualifying vendors to request (at the time of bid) preference for their residency status. Such preference is an evaluation method only and will be applied only to the cost bid in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.  Bidder is a resident vendor who certifies that, during the life of the contract, on average at least 75% of the employees working on the project being bid are residents of West Virginia who have resided in the state continuously for the two years immediately preceding submission of this bid; **or,**

Bidder understands if the Secretary of Revenue determines that a Bidder receiving preference has failed to continue to meet the requirements for such preference, the Secretary may order the Director of Purchasing to: (a) reject the bid; or (b) assess a penalty against such Bidder in an amount not to exceed 5% of the bid amount and that such penalty will be paid to the contracting agency or deducted from any unpaid balance on the contract or purchase order.

By submission of this certificate, Bidder agrees to disclose any reasonably requested information to the Purchasing Division and authorizes the Department of Revenue to disclose to the Director of Purchasing appropriate information verifying that Bidder has paid the required business taxes, provided that such information does not contain the amounts of taxes paid nor any other information deemed by the Tax Commissioner to be confidential.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (*West Virginia Code §61-5-3*), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.
