

Dear Mr. Whittaker,

The purpose of this letter is to clarify and amend our Alternate Quotation for roller shades for this requirement.

On this bid, we are offering roller shades made by MechoShade Systems as a less expensive, more durable, more functional product to the cellular shades which were specified.

We are quoting using either shade cloth 0100 Equinox Series or 0700 ThermoVeil Blackout shade cloth. There are 20 available colors all of which are room darkening, fire retardant and washable. We will supply these shades with either the Suburban 3 or Mecho 5 operating system both of which are manually operated systems using a clutch roller and bed chain. The Suburban system is a little less institutional appearing whereas the Mecho 5 system is more substantial and engineered for years of use. Both systems come with a 10 year limited warranty on all parts. Window Fashions will guarantee installation for 2 years.

Whereas, the products are built to give years of service, another nice feature is that should repair be necessary, parts can be replaced on site without necessitating return to the factory. Even the shade cloth can be replaced on premises should they be vandalized or stained. Using this type of shade should eliminate any space problems with the room door handles.

Based upon my visit to the site, there may be windows where totaling room darkening may not be desired. We will allow substitution of fabrics in those areas.

These shades require an operating space of approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ " on each side so the rooms will not be 100% dark. This would be the same situation with the specified cellular shades.

The MechoShade roller shades are available with side channels to eliminate light creep around the edges. These channels will not work on the doors and I think them unnecessary in the guest rooms. However, Mr. Hanshaw stated that they do photography workshops in some of the

conference rooms where these channels would be an added benefit. We have stated the necessary added charges on our bid sheet for adding these channels.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.

SPECIFICATIONS AND SCOPE OF WORK

Scope of Work:

The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources; hereinafter Division is accepting Bids for the purchase and installation of window shades for its new twenty-seven guest room addition and the purchase and installation of window shades for the Azalea, Chinquapin, and Dogwood conference rooms as well as the lodge office and fitness center. All items are to be F.O.B. Destination. Freight or delivery charges must be included in the price of the line item cost. Vendor must provide all necessary labor, materials, supervision, tools, equipment and hardware to properly install the blinds as per the manufacturer's recommendations. Vendor must provide inventory recommendations for maintenance, cleaning and upkeep.

Pre-bid Meeting:

A pre-bid meeting is not necessary for this project; however, the Vendors should make arrangements with the Park Superintendent or Assistant Park Superintendent for a site visit to individually field measure each window and door to ensure proper fit and operation.

Basis of Award:

Damaged or defective items must be rejected, removed, and replaced at no additional expense to the Division. Vendor must be responsible for damages that occur during assembly and set-up.

Project Closeout:

Vendor must provide inventory recommendations for maintenance, cleaning and upkeep.

Safety:

Successful Vendor will be working in public areas where guests and employees will be present. The successful Vendor is therefore required to maintain a safe, clean, and orderly Work area at all times.

Warranty Period:

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
