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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.

3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division

and have paid the required \$125 fee.

- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.

Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.

The Acquisition and Contract Administration Section of the Purchasing Division "State" for the West Virginia General Services Division is soliciting quotations to restore campus signage at the West Virginia State Capitol Complex in Charleston, West Virginia. This document is intended to supplement information provided in the standard "Request for Quotation" and "General Terms and Conditions" issued by the Purchasing Division for this project. Vendors should carefully review all documents.

Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting:

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on Wednesday, February 9, 2011, at 10:00 am. Contractors attending the meeting shall assemble at Room MB-60 in the Capitol Building basement. See Purchasing Division Request for Quotation for additional information.

Scope of Work:

The work consists of restoring four complex directories and fifteen building signs at the State Capitol Complex. Work includes, but is not limited to, remounting two (2) directories so they are parallel with sidewalks, replace all electrical components in directories and restore glass; all complex signage and directories that are recognized in the specifications must have all existing lettering and decals removed; remove existing paint to metal finish; signs shall be repainted, lettered and remounted as shown in specification and drawings; and replacement of landscaping and surfaces around project site and other related work.

Work shall be conducted as a single project. Within 72 hours of the issuance of the notice to proceed successful bidder shall submit a schedule showing the commencement and completion dates for each proposed area or subsystem. The schedule shall be reviewed and approved by the Owner prior to commencement of the work. Coordinate the schedule around Owner's work requirements. Following issuance of the purchase order but prior to the issuance of the notice to proceed, successful bidder shall be required to participate in a pre-construction meeting with the Owner to establish basic criteria for scheduling, submittals, and execution of the work.

Furnish all materials, labor, and equipment necessary to complete all work as indicated by these specifications. Intent is that the completed work consists of a complete removal of signs, refinishing and remounting them. Final paint colors, lettering style, lettering color and size shall be submitted to the Owner for final approval. Contractor must provide manufacturer's full range of colors. Furnish any incidental work, materials, labor and equipment that are necessary to complete the work, even if such incidental work is not explicitly included in the contract documents.

Any equipment contracted for prior to receipt of the signed purchase order and written Notice to Proceed letter shall be at the Bidder's risk.

4. Bid Form

Contract Period:

The Contract shall be substantially completed within **Ninety (90)** calendar days from the issuance of the written Notice to Proceed. In accordance with the West Virginia State Code 5A-3-4(8), vendor agrees that liquidated damages shall be imposed at the rate of \$250.00 per day for failure to complete the project within the contract period. This clause shall in no way be considered exclusive and shall not limit the State or Agency's right to pursue any other additional remedy to which the State or Agency may have legal cause for action including further damages against the vendor.

Definitions:

- A. The Department of Administration, General Services Division, Room MB-60, State Capitol, Charleston, West Virginia shall be hereinafter called the "Owner".
- B. The vendor or service organization contracted by these specifications shall hereinafter be called the "Contractor".
- C. "The Contract", as herein stated, shall mean the agreement between the Owner and the Contractor to provide the services as herein specified.
- D. "Owners Representative", as herein stated, shall be defined as that person so designated by the Director of the General Services Division.
- E. "Architect/Engineer", as stated in these Contract Documents shall refer to the General Services Division.

Payment:

The Contractor shall submit two copies (one original and one copy) of invoices once each month on AIA forms G702 and G703. Invoices shall be signed in blue ink. Deliver invoices to:

General Services Division Attn: Business Manager 1900 Kanawha Blvd. East Building 1, Room MB-68 Charleston, West Virginia 25305

Payments shall be made monthly based on the percentage of work completed. A ten percent (10%) retainage will be deducted until substantial completion of the contract. Progress payments shall not be made when the total value of the work performed since the last estimate amounts to less than Five Hundred (\$500.00) dollars.

Submit the proposed invoice to the General Services Division - Projects / Engineering Section for approval of format prior to submission of first invoice. All work shall be inspected and

approved prior to payment.

Submit certified payrolls with each payment application.

Supplementary General Conditions:

- 1. The Contractor shall procure all necessary permits and licenses to comply with all applicable laws, Federal, State, or municipal, along with all regulations, and ordinances of any regulating body.
- 2. The Contractor shall pay any applicable sales, use, or personal property taxes, arising out of this Contract and the transactions contemplated thereby. Any other taxes levied upon this Contract, the transaction, or the equipment, or services delivered pursuant hereto shall be borne by the Contractor. It is clearly understood that the State of West Virginia is exempt from any taxes regarding performance of the scope of work of this Contract.
- 3. Contractor shall be responsible for parts and materials as follows:
 - A. The Contractor shall supply all tools, tool accessories, personal safety equipment, and supplies necessary to execute the responsibilities of this Contract.
 - B. Contractor shall furnish a warranty of twelve (12) months for labor and materials.

Bonds and Insurance:

Refer to Purchasing Division's 'Request for Quotation' for requirements on bonding; insurance; wage rates; "Foreign made aluminum, glass and steel in Public Works Projects", and other project requirements.

General Requirements:

Submittals:

All submittals for this project shall be reviewed and approved by the General Services Division Architectural/Engineering Section (Owner) prior to the beginning of any work or the installation of any material for which an approved submittal is required. Submittals will include, but not be limited to: paint, paint colors, lettering (proofs), LED lighting, etc.

Project Closeout:

- Closeout documents, including marked-up shop drawings shall be submitted in bound format prior to final application payment.
- 2. Final cleanup shall be completed prior to final acceptance.
- 3. Submit As-Built Drawings and record documents.
- 4. Submit "Affidavit of Payment of Debts and Claims."

Final inspection:

The Final Inspection will be conducted by a Project Manager from the General Services Division, Architectural / Engineering Section.

Work found to be in accordance with the Contract Documents will be accepted as complete for final acceptance. Unacceptable work, or work not in accordance with the Contract Documents shall be removed, replaced, changed or cleaned as required to meet requirements of Contract Documents prior to final acceptance. Final Acceptance does not waive or release Contractor to conform to the Contract Documents.

The date of Substantial Completion shall be determined by the Architect/Engineer conducting the final inspection based on all work being complete for final acceptance or substantially complete to permit beneficial use by the Owner. Final payment shall not be made until all work is finally accepted.

Limits of Work

Work areas will be limited to those spaces required for access to the State Capitol Complex.

No interior space may be utilized for temporary (overnight) storage of equipment and tools. Coordinate storage needs with the GSD Building Manager and GSD Project Manager.

Owner and Agency facilities shall remain in use during this contract. Contractor shall work with the Building Manager and Protective Services to coordinate the temporary access to work areas and otherwise provide for the Contractor needs to complete work. Contractor shall minimize disruptions to the sidewalks and parking areas.

Use of Facilities

Contractor shall be permitted reasonable use of building utilities including power, water and sanitary sewage disposal as required for conducting the work. Coordinate the location of service connections or use of receptacle with the building manager to avoid overloading existing circuits.

Contractor Schedule:

Provide overall project schedule within seventy-two hours of Notice to Proceed.

Provide a proposed construction schedule including areas to be worked. Where coordination or disruption of walkways or parking may be required, provide at least one week's advance notice prior to conducting work in those areas. Adhere to schedule provided and coordinate with through Project Manager.

Waste Removal

Contractor to make arrangements for the collection and disposal of Contractor's waste and construction related debris. Debris shall be removed on a daily basis.

Contractor Visitor Badges

State Capitol is a semi-secured facility. Contractor shall provide a list of all personnel working on this project within the Complex. This list shall include a copy of full name, valid driver's license or other legal identification, date of birth, company name, address, office phone and cell phone. All proposed workers may be subjected to a criminal history / driver's license background check prior to being permitted to work in state buildings. Workers shall carry valid Contractor Photo ID Badges to be worn when working in the building. Under no circumstances shall a worker be assigned to this project without the validation first being submitted to the General Services Division and approval given.

Work Restrictions:

Work shall be generally performed at entry sign during normal business working hours of 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday, except state recognized holidays.

Smoking is not permitted within any building or near entrances, operable windows or outdoor air intakes.

Parking

No parking is available on the project site. Parking in non-designated areas is not permitted. A limited number of spaces will be allocated for contractors vehicles near the project site. Parking for Contractor's personnel will be available in the designated contractor's parking area near the project site. Provisions will be made for locating refuse dumpsters if required by the project.

With prior approval, contractor's vehicles may be brought on-site for loading & unloading or to provide equipment necessary for conducting the work. Vehicles not necessary for conduct of work shall be removed from site within one-half hour.

Building Access

The complex is available from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. Extended work hours may be acceptable if approved by the Owner. The complex is a semi-secure location. Access to the building shall be coordinated with the Owner. Contractor shall not leave open doors unattended and shall close doors when not in use.

Codes:

All work is to be performed in compliance with applicable Federal and State codes including but not limited to the International Building Code, International Mechanical Code, Life Safety Code, NEC, OSHA,UL, ANSI, ASME, West Virginia State Fire Code and related standards.

Safety:

Perform all work in compliance with applicable safety regulations. Work shall be subject to verification and inspection by GSD Safety representatives. Such verification shall not relieve the Contractor from meeting all applicable safety regulations and inspection by other agencies.

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Notify Owner if suspected hazardous materials are encountered. Any areas requiring abatement will be provided by the GSD under separate contract.

Hot Work Permit:

Contractor shall obtain Owner's permission prior to performing any work that requires an open flame, creates sparks, use's equipment that creates combustible temperatures, or performs any work that could result in a fire hazard. Owner will review work area and issue a 'Hot Work Permit' prior to Contractor commencing work. Note that the Contractor must take proper precautions and may be required to provide a Fire Watch as a condition of the permit.

Workmanship:

Contractor shall complete all work in a neat and workmanlike manner. All work shall be done using new materials in a manner that meets commercial quality standards. Work shall be neat, true, plumb and square, as applicable. Contractor shall verify all dimensions.

Warranty:

In addition to individual material warranties, Contractor shall warranty all work for a period of one year from the date of Substantial Completion.

4 - Directories

Sign shall have a State Seal, Capitol Dome and West Virginia Capitol Directory lettering on each side. (See Drawing for Details)

<u>Complex Signs – (15 signs)</u> - Every sign shall have a state seal located on each side of the sign. See map for locations of signs and directories.

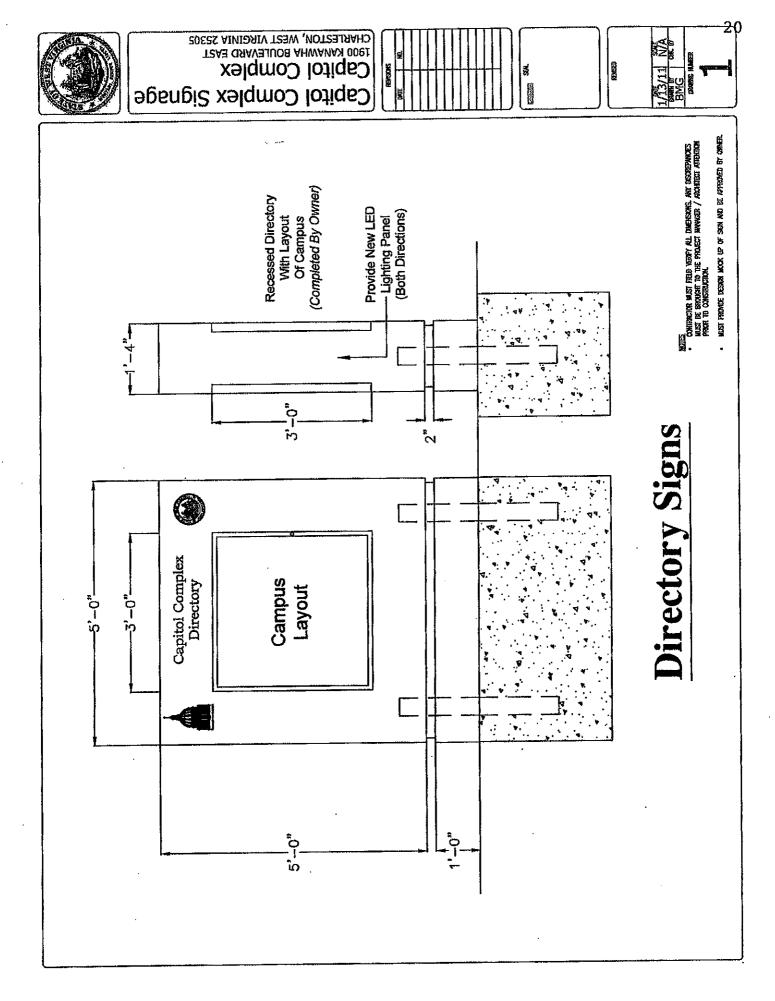

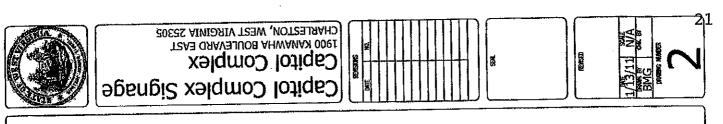

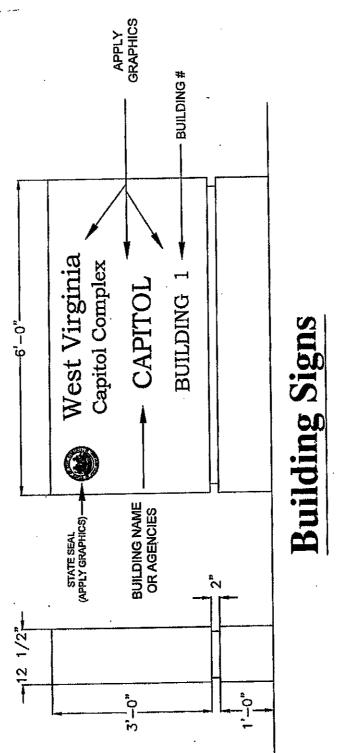

Complex Signs Painting and Electrical Details

- 1. Strip all vinyl / paint from aluminum cabinets and signs;
- 2. Remove remaining residue with denatured alcohol;
- 3. Spray primer on entire sign with Blue tint bonding primer (or equal);
- 4. Spray several light coats of acrylic gloss enamel WV Blue (or equal);
- 5. Computer mask lettering then spray the lettering with One Shot Brand (or equal) lettering enamel silver;
- 6. Computer mask and spray the State Seal;
- 7. Provide new LED lighting panel in large directory signs.

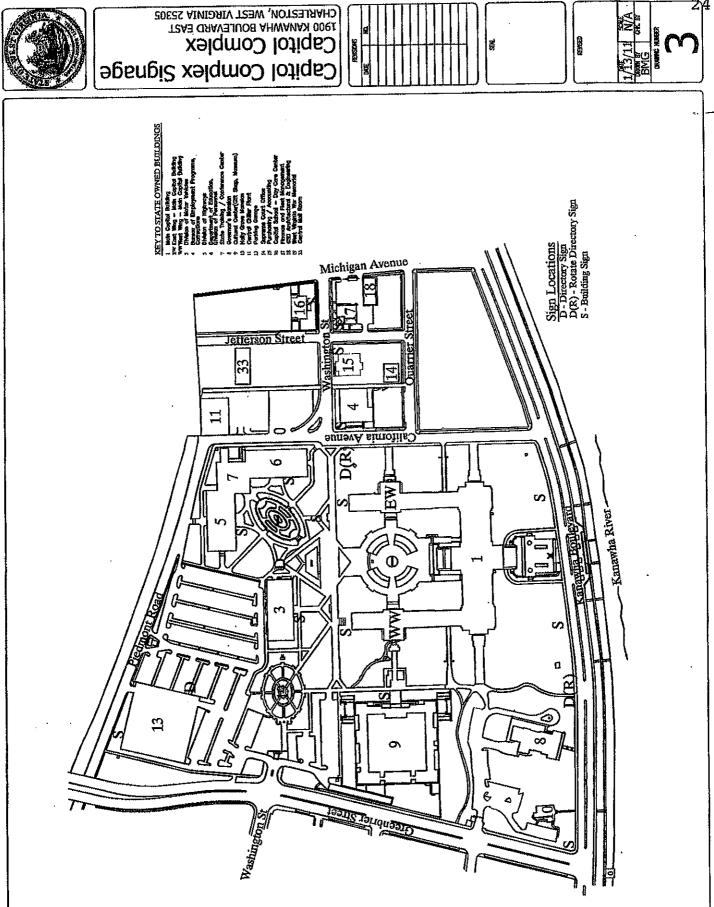

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
