GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

The Department of Administration, General Services Division, is soliciting quotations for all labor, materials and associated costs to provide and install a fire sprinkler system on the First Floor Suite B-122, Seventh Floor Suite 749 Southeast and Eighth Floor West Side of Building 6 on the Capitol Complex in Charleston, WV. This document is intended to supplement information provided in the standard "Request for Quotation" and "General Terms and Conditions" issued by the Purchasing Division for this project. Contractors should carefully review all documents.

Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting:

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on **Tuesday, May 17**, at 10:00 am. Contractors attending the meeting shall assemble in the lobby of Building 6 at 1900 Kanawha Blvd East, Charleston, WV 25305. See Purchasing Division Request for Quotation for additional information.

Scope of Work:

This RFQ includes furnishing all labor, equipment, appliances, materials, transportation and shop drawings necessary for the extension of the wet pipe fire protection sprinkler system for

specified areas. The sprinkler system shall be designed to comply with all requirements of NFPA 13, other related NFPA standards and applicable state and local codes. Project areas are to be: First Floor Suite B-122, 2,600 square feet plus 400 square feet to allow for pipe runs (Note: abatement will be required after routing is determined); Seventh Floor Suite 749 Southeast, 3,900 square feet; Eighth Floor West Side 7,900 square feet. Total square footage is estimated to be approximately 15,100 square feet. Actual square footage area is subject to contractor inspection and verification prior to bid submittal. Successful Bidder will be given thirty (90) calendar days from the written notice to proceed to complete the project.

The successful contractor shall be required to keep the work area clean on a daily basis and remove debris/waste materials from the site daily. Any other material selections not specified herein will be made by the Contractor only after prior written approval of General Services Division's Project Manager or designee.

Contractor will be solely responsible for any/all professional fees incurred by Contractor to satisfactorily complete the work described herein to the satisfaction of the General Services Divisions Engineering Manager or designee.

- 1. Mechanical sprinkler alarm. (NFPA 13 or accepted approval)
- 2. All electrical power and alarm connections and wiring. (NFPA 13 or accepted approved)
- 3. Painting of fire protection pipe. (NFPA 13 or accepted approval)

Contractor will prepare detailed shop drawings for the complete sprinkler system showing the location of the heads, piping and other installation details and submit for State or Local approval prior to submission to the Architect. Provide plans for the Owner's insurance rate review. Plans will be prepared by the installing contractor, who will have an "Automatic Sprinkler System Design" NICET Level III or IV certification, to the Owner prior to final payment. The plans shall be in electronic format of A-CADD 2077 LT, or equivalent.

All above ground piping will be black steel pipe, copper tube, or other materials accepted by NFPA 13. Fittings shall be cast iron threaded, welded, or mechanical fittings similar to "Victaulic", as indicated I NFPA 13. Maximum required system working pressure, 175 PSI. Provide Reliable Automatic Sprinkler Company, or equal, water motor and gong. Locate on the outside of the building near the dry pipe valve. Provide Reliable Automatic Sprinkler Company, or equal, pressure type water flow alarm switch on the dry pipe valve trim. Provide chrome plated dry pendent spray sprinklers and escutcheons in all areas with finished ceilings and requiring concealed pipe. Provide standard brass upright spray sprinklers in all exposed pipe areas. Sprinklers lower than 7' – 0" should be provided with wire head guards. Locate and

space sprinklers as indicated in NFPA 13 for the appropriate occupancy hazard. Quick response sprinklers shall be used in all areas, unless not approved for such use by their listing. The Contract shall be completed within **Ninety (90)** calendar days from the issuance of the written Notice to Proceed. Scheduled work may not begin until successful vendor has received a signed purchase order and Notice To Proceed letter. In accordance with the West Virginia State Code 5A-3-4(8), Contractor agrees that liquidated damages shall be imposed at the rate of \$100.00 per day for failure to complete the project within the contract period.

This clause shall in no way be considered exclusive and shall not limit the State or Agency's right to pursue any other additional remedy to which the State or Agency may have legal cause for action including further damages against the Contractor.

Use of Facilities

Contractor shall be permitted reasonable use of building utilities including power, water and sanitary sewage disposal as required for conducting the work. Coordinate the location of service connections or use of receptacle with the building manager to avoid overloading existing circuits.

Contractor Schedule:

Provide overall project schedule within seventy-two hours of Notice to Proceed.

Provide a proposed construction schedule indicating areas to be worked. Where coordination or disruption of occupants may be required, provide at least one week's advance notice prior to conducting work in those areas. Adhere to schedule provided and coordinate with through Project Manager. Work schedules will be reviewed and approved by the General Services Division's Project Manager. Work Restrictions:

On the Eighth Floor (half occupied), work will be conducted after normal business hours between 5:00pm and 6:00am to lessen impact on daily operations and access to space if required. For the First and Seventh Floor areas, work shall be generally performed inside the unoccupied spaces during normal business working hours of 7:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday, except State-recognized holidays.

This is a non-smoking building: Smoking is not permitted within the building or near entrances, operable windows or outdoor air intakes.

Waste Removal

Parking

Parking for Contractor's personnel will be available in the designated contractor's parking area near Laidley Field. Provisions will be made for locating refuse dumpsters if required by the project.

Use of loading dock areas for parking is strictly prohibited.


Hot Work Permit:




Workmanship:

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.


