1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
12. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

EXHIBIT A

EXCEPTIONS TO/COMMENTS REGARDING STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA RFQ #HOP11005 DATED 5/24/10

1. Bid Item #0001:

The three (3) year parts warranty does not include pagers carried by staff or the transmitters/signaling devices worn by residents. See Exhibit B attached for Stanley's specific warranty language.

The two (2) year labor warranty does not mean that Stanley will automatically dispatch a service technician for every facility request for service. Please note that because system diagnostics can be performed remotely with the Arial® system, "On-site warranty service will be provided by Stanley only if a reported problem is deemed by Stanley to be not otherwise curable through the exchange of defective components, the remote troubleshooting and diagnostics capabilities of the System, or in consultation with a Stanley technician by phone." Also, the appointment of a "system administrator" at the facility is key. (See attached Exhibit E "Customer Assistance," Section [g] attached.)

2. Bid Item #0005:

The resident transmitter bands we have quoted are not, in the strictest sense, "hypo-allergenic plastic-nylon/Kevlar reinforced." Rather, per our specifications they are made of "45MIL 22 OZ. light grey vinyl laminate over a polyester scrim." They contain no latex. Also, our bands have a 100 lb. pull pressure at the snap rather than a 150 lb. pull pressure.

3. Bid Item #0009:

The PC unit quoted will not "allow paging from all network computers" if "network computers" implies "other" computers which may be in use at the facility which have nothing to do with the Arial® system. Only the monitor quoted in Item #0010 (and the one in Alternative Item #0016) will receive system notifications from pagers, door units, transmitters worn by residents, etc. The Arial® computer base station (monitor) should be dedicated for call system purposes only and no other programs or applications should be loaded onto it or used with it.

Maintenance of the Arial® software is covered under the terms set forth in the "Arial® Software Maintenance Agreement," a copy of which is attached as Exhibit D. A software maintenance fee is charged annually on an automatic renewal basis unless the facility terminates the agreement in accordance with Section 7 of the agreement. The software maintenance fee currently in effect is \$495.

4. Bid Item #0011:

The Arial® system operates wirelessly and is not centrally powered. Thus, receivers will not be connected to the "central monitoring system for power." Instead, they will need to be plugged into local outlets provided by the facility.

5. Bid Item #0015:

The Arial® system is expandable for future growth and can accommodate over 1000 call points. Likewise, though not quoted in this RFQ, elevator lockout can be installed and integrated with the Arial® system.

1. **Description of Software Maintenance Plan.** During the term of this Agreement, Stanley will provide the services described herein so as to maintain the Arial® Software (the "Software") in good working order, and provide technical support in order to assist Customer with system support functions. All software updates and enhancements provided to Customer by Stanley pursuant to the terms of this Agreement shall be subject to the terms and conditions of the Software License Agreement between the parties.  - 1.2. Revision packages (example 7.1 to 7.2);
 - 1.3. Access to technical phone support, except System Tasks as outlined in Section three (3) below, provided twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week. Technical phone support for said System Tasks will be provided at Stanley's standard rates.
2. **Customer Assistance.** Stanley agrees to offer to Customer telephone support for the Software on a twenty-four (24)-hour basis. Charges for telephone support, if any, may apply and vary for reasons including, but not limited to, the Software Maintenance Plan purchased, the status of the Customer's Software Maintenance Plan coverage, and whether the nature of the call is a billable Systems Task as identified in Section three (3) defined below. Corrections, replacements, and/or updates will generally be accomplished via the remote access feature. Customer agrees to assign its staff to work with Stanley personnel via telephone during the correction, replacement or update process if required by Stanley. Stanley assumes no responsibility or liability for the correctness, performance, or any resulting incompatibilities with, current or future releases of the Software if the Customer has made changes or modifications to the system hardware/software configuration or to any Stanley supplied source code which change or effect the performance of the Software and were made without prior notification to and written approval of Stanley. Stanley assumes no responsibility for the operation or performance of any Customer-developed or third-party application.
3. **Services Not Included; System Tasks.** System Tasks, for the purposes of this Agreement are those services Customer requests, which alter the configuration of Customer's software, or duties that are viewed as routine in the normal operation of the Arial® system that Customer should reasonably be able to complete on its own, but nonetheless requests assistance from Stanley. Stanley reserves the right to add or remove services it deems are System Tasks.

EXHIBIT A**Terms and Conditions for Arial® Software Maintenance Plan**

1. **Payment of Purchase Price.** Payment for Arial® Software Maintenance Plan, if not previously made to Stanley, must be made within thirty (30) days of the invoicing date. If Customer fails to render payment as determined by Software Maintenance Plan or Customer fails to submit payment for renewal of Software Maintenance Plan, or in the event of a lapse in payment, then Stanley may elect not to render such services until advance payment is made by Customer and/or a penalty may be assessed by Stanley before Software Maintenance Plan can be reestablished. In the event of a lapse in payment of greater than sixty (60) days, then, without prejudice to any other right or remedy available to Stanley, Stanley shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement.



In instances where the Arial® central monitoring station is connected to a network not installed and configured by Stanley, Stanley will not be responsible for disruptions of Arial® services or any consequences resulting from said disruptions that are caused by outages of the third party network or by changes made to this network. Customer is responsible for any costs associated with configuring or servicing networks not installed by Stanley including but not limited to the costs of labor for Information Technology specialists, network cabling, network hardware, and subscription costs for access to the Internet.

When someone attempts to exit through a door protected by a Stanley delayed egress lock, an alarm sounds, alerting staff before the door unlocks.
