The West Virginia Lottery, an agency of the West Virginia Department of Revenue, is seeking quotations from qualified certified public accounting firms for financial review analysis and advice concerning video lottery terminal manufacturers, licensed racetracks and licensed operators, table games supply manufacturers or persons applying for licenses for these licenses or permits under the Racetrack Video Lottery Act [W.Va. Code §29-22A-1 et seq.], the Limited Video Lottery Act [W.Va. Code §29-22B-1 et seq.], the Racetrack Table Games Act [W.Va. Code §29-22C-1 et seq.], the Limited Gaming Facility [Casino] Act [W.Va. Code §29-25-1] and/or other Acts that may be enacted prior to or during the term of the contract issued pursuant to their RFQ. The State Lottery Commission requires a consultant accounting firm that is able to provide calculations and analysis, and to give the Commission candid and unbiased advice, concerning the initial licensing and continuing re-licensing processes as well as intermediate financial transactions requiring the prior approval of the Commission. The accounting firm will provide management consulting services and will perform special reviews and/or analysis of administration of the Lottery's responsibilities under WV Code §29-22-29.

"Qualified Certified Public Accounting Firm" defined

Any CPA firm submitting a quotation under this procurement shall meet or exceed the minimum qualifications set forth in this RFQ. Those quotations not meeting the mandatory specifications will be eliminated.

- Except for the engagement being procured by this Request for Quotation, the firm has no accountant-client relationship with the State of West Virginia Department of Revenue and the West Virginia Lottery.
- The firm has no conflict of interest with regard to any other work performed by the firm for the State of West Virginia.
- The firm has no accountant-client relationship with any of the four pari-mutuel racetracks that are located in West Virginia and regulated by the State Lottery Commission. See Appendix A for listing of the four licensed racetracks.
- The firm has no accountant-client relationship with any of the manufacturers of the video lottery machines that are now licensed by the West Virginia Lottery and that

may hereafter become licensed or permitted. See Appendix A for listing of the licensed/permitted manufacturers.

The firm has no accountant-client relationship with any of the limited video lottery operators that now hold West Virginia Lottery limited video lottery licenses or that may hereafter become licensed. See Appendix B for listing of limited video lottery licensees.

The firm has no accountant-client relationship with any of the supply manufacturers for the table games that are now licensed by the West Virginia Lottery and that may hereafter become licensed. See Appendix C for listing of table games supply manufacturers.

The firm has no accountant-client relationship with any limited gaming facility that is now licensed by the West Virginia Lottery and that may hereafter become licensed. See Appendix D for listing of limited gaming facilities.

The one or more partners or members to be assigned to this contract are properly licensed to practice accountancy in the State of West Virginia and is (are) a certified public accountant who has (have) met all continuing professional education requirements within the preceding two years.

The one or more partners or members to be assigned to this contract are experienced in the preparation and analysis of a variety of regulatory financial forms required by the United States Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC").

None of the partners or members shall have been convicted of any violation of security laws or of gambling laws.

The firm agrees, by submission of its quotation, that the West Virginia Lottery reserves the right to engage other providers for this type service during the term of this contract.

Firm has no un-appealed delinquencies with the State Tax Department, Workers' Compensation [BrickStreet] or Unemployment Compensation.

Scope of Services

The firm awarded the contract as a result of this RFQ will assist the Director of the West Virginia Lottery and the seven-member Commission to review the financial condition of businesses licensed, permitted, or applying for licenses or permits as video lottery terminal manufacturers, licensed racetracks, limited video lottery licensed operators and table games supply manufacturers under the Racetrack Video Lottery Act [W.Va. Code §29-22A-1 et seq.], the Limited Video Lottery Act [W.Va. Code §29-22B-1 et seq.], the Racetrack Table Games Act

[W.Va. Code §29-22C-1 et seq.], the Limited Gaming Facility [Casino] Act [W.Va. Code §29-25-1] and/or by other Acts that may be enacted prior to or during the term of the contract issued pursuant to this RFQ. The accounting firm will provide management consulting services and will perform special reviews and/or analysis of administration of the Lottery's responsibilities under WV Code §29-22-29.

Services will include, but are not limited to, the review of year-end financial statements, (both audited and unaudited) of applicants. The review of applicants interim financial statements, business plan, financial projections, Federal and State tax returns as well as, when applicable, their filings with the SEC. Such services will also include the review of proposed and final loan documents. In addition, a review may be required of the personal financial statements of certain shareholders, officers and members of their board of directors (or other group depending upon the business structure of the applicant) of the applicant as well as a review of personal federal and state income tax returns.

From time to time, the Commission will meet in other parts of West Virginia, usually at a racetrack location, and the firm will be expected to attend most of these meetings to present analysis at public meetings.

Bid Amount

The amount of the bid submitted by each potential vendor shall be a fixed hourly rate for services rendered. This rate shall be the same regardless of which partner or member performs the services and shall be sufficient to cover any and all incidental expenses including but by no means limited to copy or computer research costs. Out of pocket travel expenses shall be billed in accordance with the State of West Virginia's Travel Rules as prescribed by the Travel Management Unit, Purchasing Division.

Expenses Incurred

The State of West Virginia and the West Virginia Lottery will not be liable for any expenses incurred by any Vendor in the preparation and submission of quotations for this RFQ

Termination/Cancellation of this RFQ

The Purchasing Division reserves the right to modify, withdraw, and/or cancel this RFQ at any time, even after the submission of responding quotations, if such withdrawal is to the benefit of the State of West Virginia or the West Virginia State Lottery. If this RFQ is withdrawn, no contract awards will be made pursuant to this RFQ.

Assignment

The relationship of the selected firm to the State of West Virginia, and to the West Virginia Lottery, will be that of an independent contractor, with no principal-agent or employer-employee relationships created by the parties to any resultant agreement. The firm shall not assign, convey, transfer, or delegate any of its responsibilities or obligations under the resultant agreement without prior written approval of the State Lottery Commission. Such approval may be granted by the sole discretion of the State Lottery Commission. No assignments, if any are granted, shall release the vendor from its liability for the prompt and effective performance of the obligations hereunder.

Governing Law

The contract resulting from this RFQ will be governed by the laws of the State of West Virginia. The State of West Virginia asserts its Eleventh Amendment right not to be sued in any federal court.

Taxes

The State of West Virginia, and the West Virginia Lottery, are exempt from Federal Excise taxes, and from State and local sales and use taxes, on the services to be supplied as a result of any contracts resulting from this RFQ. Consequently, the State of West Virginia and the West Virginia Lottery will have no responsibilities for the payment of any taxes that become payable by the successful firm.

Acceptance Period for Quotations

The quotations submitted in response to this RFQ shall remain fixed and valid for a period of six (6) months commencing on the date the quotations are due.

Firm Information

Responding firms should include the following information with their bid proposal submittal. The WV Lottery reserves the right to request this or any additional information at any time during the bid evaluation process prior to their recommendation of award notification to the West Virginia Purchasing Division.
