- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.

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Questions from Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting Tuesday, August 10, 2010 (2:00p.m.) Jackie Withrow Hospital (Formerly Pinecrest Hospital) – Conference Room 1B Request for Quotation – PSH11002

- Question #1 If there is only one 6 inch water line feeding the hospital, does this water line also feed the sprinkler system. If it does, who will be responsible for the sprinkler system before, during, and after the installation or in the event of a fire during and after the installation or in the event of a fire during this period.
- Answer #1: According to the information that we have, the sprinkler system is fed from the fire hydrant loop and is isolated from the domestic 6" line.
- Question #2 It would be very costly to run an underground power supply to the area that the backflow preventers will be installed. Can the hospital have the power company to drop a service in that area and the contractor set a panel to serve the hot boxes that will be required. This would save a lot of money on the installation.
- Answer #2: We are going to either "run" power ourselves to the site, or we will have the power company set a separate meter there for the vendor to connect to. Either way, we will make certain there is power at the site for the vendor to use. At this time, our Maintenance supervisor has a form that will/needs to be submitted to AEP so that they can give us an estimate of what the cost will be for us to put in a new pole/ meter. That way we can determine here what the most cost effective method will be.
- <u>Question #3:</u> Where would vendor get electric for hot box? who is responsible for electric service for hot boxes?

Answer #3: Jackie Withrow Hospital.

Question #4: - Does the water company require a yearly testing of these?

Answer #4: - Yes, and the items to be tested needs to be easy to get to.

Question #5: - Who does the testing, vendor or Jackie Withrow Hospital?

Answer #5: - We prefer that the vendor do this.

Question #6: - Does the fire protection come off that line?

Answer #6: - No, it is separate.

1. GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 1.1. Request for quotation to provide all labor, material, equipment and anything necessary for the provision and installation of two (2) Reduced Pressure Zone (RPZ) backflow preventer valves (RPZ Type ASSE1013 or equal) constructed of bronze and two (2) warming units, HOT BOX or equal, to keep the valves from freezing.
- 1.2. All work will be in compliance with the Fire Marshall, OHFLAC and NFPA regulations and all other building codes and industry standards. Final payment will be withheld if any portion of this overall project is not 100% complete. The award will be made to the overall low bid that complies with the specifications.
- 1.3. "Will, "must", and "shall" listed here in this document are a mandatory requirement.

2. BIDDER REQUIREMENTS:

- 2.1. All qualified bidders, being familiar with and understanding the bidding documents and also having examined the site and being familiar with all local conditions affecting the project hereby propose to furnish all labor, material, equipment, supplies and to perform all work in accordance with the bidding documents within the time set forth below.
- 2.2. It is the bidder's responsibility to verify all field conditions and limitations prior to bidding. It is also the bidder's responsibility to notify the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources in writing, of conditions detrimental to proper and timely completion of the project.
- 2.3. A Mandatory Pre-bid Conference shall be conducted on August 10, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. Said conference will be held at: Jackie Withrow Hospital (Formerly Pinecrest Hospital), 105 S. Eisenhower Drive, Beckley, WV 25801 in the 1B Conference Room. All interested bidders are required to be present at this meeting. Failure to attend the mandatory pre-bid conference shall automatically result in disqualification. No one person can represent more than one vendor.
- 2.4. Technical questions concerning this solicitation must be submitted in writing to Roberta Wagner in the State Purchasing Division via Mail at the address showing in the body of this RFQ, via Fax at 304 558-4115, or via Email at Roberta.A.Wagner@wv.gov. Deadline for technical questions is August 12, 2010 at the close of business. Any technical questions received will be answered by formal addendum issued by the Purchasing Division after the deadline has lapsed.
- 2.5. There will be a tour of the work area during the pre-bid conference.

3. SCOPE OF WORK:

- 3.1. Vendors will provide and install two (2) RPZ (Reduced Pressure Zone) backflow preventer valves (constructed of bronze), RPZ type is the ASSE 1013 or equal, and attach them to the Jackie Withrow Hospital waterline to prevent cross-contamination into the public waterline. There—is one 6" main water line at the Jackie Withrow Hospital.
- 3.2. Vendors will provide and install Two (2) warming units to keep the valves from freezing, HOT BOX or equal, must be installed above the RPZ valve. This will be installed approximately 10' (10 foot) from the main shutoff valve in Jackie Withrow Hospital's front lawn next to Eisenhower Drive. This is approximately 40 or 50 feet away from the main road.
- 3.3. All bidders must provide the estimated amount of time (if any) the water is expected to be off to the facility. (This information is needed because of our residents; if water is estimated to be off for more than 4 hours, Jackie Withrow Hospital's Maintenance Department will supply an alternate means of water for the residents' use during that time period).

4. INSPECTION:

- **4.1.**Vendor shall inspect existing conditions governing this work during pre-bid site inspection to determine conditions and extent of work required. No allowance will be made subsequently on behalf of the contractor for any error or negligence on his part in connection with this requirement.
- 4.2. The Vendor shall inspect all elements subject to movement or damage prior to commencing work.

5. TEMPORARY FACILITIES:

- **5.1** The Owner will provide normal electrical supply from the currently installed electrical system in the building for the use of the contractor. However, the Owner provides no guarantee or warranty as to the system's condition or capabilities. The Contractor shall assure himself that the electrical system is adequate for his requirements or supply additional temporary electrical power at his own expense.
- **5.2.** Any damage to the electrical system resulting from misuse or abuse to the existing electrical system shall be repaired or replaced by the contractor at no expense to the owner.

6. COORDINATION OF WORK:

- **6.1.** The Vendor shall coordinate with the Maintenance Supervisor on all aspects of this project. This is to ensure the safety of our employees, residents, vendors and visitors. In the event of conflict, the building employees shall prevail.
- **6.2.** The Vendor shall take all necessary precautions to protect the exterior of the building from debris, dust or any residue occurring from the scope of work.

7. WARRANTY: (GUARANTEE)

- **7.1.** The Vendor shall warrant to the Owner all materials and equipment will be of good quality, free from faults and defects in conformance with the contract documents. All work not conforming to these requirements may be considered defective.
- **7.2.** All materials and equipment shall be of current year production of manufacturer and manufactured for commercial usage. Used, reconditioned or remanufactured equipment is not acceptable.

8. PERMITS:

The Vendor shall secure and pay for the building permit and for all other permits, governmental fees and licenses which are necessary for the proper execution and completion of the work as specified.

9. The Vendor shall keep the work area as clean as possible during the entire progress of work, and shall be responsible to remove from the site, the packaging materials from his products and other debris as it accumulates.

10. WAGE RATES:

The Vendor and any sub-vendors shall pay the higher of the U.S. Department of Labor minimum wage rates or of the West Virginia Department of Labor wage rates as established for Raleigh county pursuant to West Virginia Code 21-5-1, et seq. West Virginia Department of Labor Wage Rates are available at website:

11. PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

- 11.1. The Vendor shall submit to the Owner one original invoice for the work once the work has been completed in its entirety and upon inspection and approval by the Owner.
- 11.2 The Owner reserves the right to refuse payment in the event the completed work is not in accordance with industry standards or is sub-standard in any way; or, if the amount requested is not within the agreed upon terms of the contract.

12. TERM OF WORK:

All work shall be completed within 120 calendar days from the "Notice to Proceed" letter.

13. DELAYS AND EXTENSION OF TIME:

If the Vendor is delayed at any time in the progress of the work by any act or neglect of the Owner or by any employee of the Owner, or by any separate contractor employed by the Owner, or by changes in the work, or by labor disputes, fire, adverse weather conditions not reasonably anticipated, unavoidable casualties, or any other cause which the Owner determines may justify the delay, the contract time may be extended by written approval of the Owner, after prior approval for an extension of the contract time from the WV Purchasing Division.

14. TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT STORAGE:

Vendor may set a trailer or temporary storage building on the site for all equipment and tools. The Vendor is responsible for his tools, equipment and materials.

15. SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

The Vendor shall provide safety barriers around work areas where heavy equipment may be in operation when placing materials in the building or as required by OSHA.

16. SCHEDULE OF BID RESPONSES:

Bidders shall submit one bid addressing each required item as outlined in "#3-SCOPE OF WORK" with a dollar amount on the attached cost sheet. In addition, please note that this project will be awarded to the vendor with the lowest bid that meets all of the specifications.
