PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

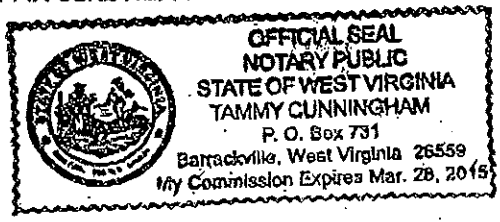

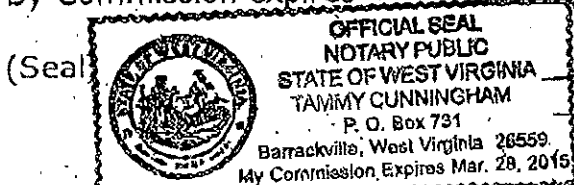

 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.



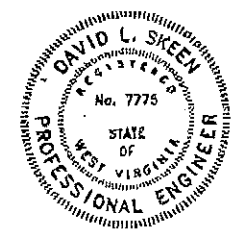

Run an MC cable with two #12 phase conductor and a #12 equipment grounding conductor from Panel 2NGC on the first floor to the first floor retherm room outdoor and indoor cooling units, connecting them in parallel. Provide a 15A/2P CB disconnect at each unit. Provide new 20A/2P circuit breaker in panel. Provide liquidtight conduit and NEMA 3R CB outdoors.
6. Run an MC cable with two #12 phase conductors and a #12 equipment grounding conductor from Panel 2NMC on the second floor to the first floor retherm room outdoor and indoor cooling units, connecting them in parallel. Provide a 15A/2P CB disconnect at each unit. Provide new 20A/2P circuit breaker in panel. Provide liquidtight conduit and NEMA 3R CB outdoors.
7. Provide refrigerant tubing sets. Insulate refrigerant suction piping.
8. Provide Johnson Controls or equal DDC controller above ceiling above first floor retherm room.
9. Provide current sensors at condensing unit disconnect switches and provide discharge air sensor and room temperature sensor in each retherm room.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK – LAUNDRY ROOM AIR CONDITIONING

1. Relocate existing self-contained AC units from retherm rooms and mount above ceilings of laundry rooms as indicated on Drawings M-4 and M-5.
2. Relocate existing 24x24 return grilles with 1" thick disposable filter from the dining rooms and install in the laundry rooms. Provide new filters.
3. Provide a new Titus TDC, or equal, supply diffuser in each laundry room.
4. Run uninsulated round steel ducts to the existing return air duct above the ceiling. Ducts shall be 26 gage longitudinal seam galvanized steel.
5. Reroute existing AC unit power circuits to new AC unit locations in laundry rooms.
6. Relocate existing thermostats .

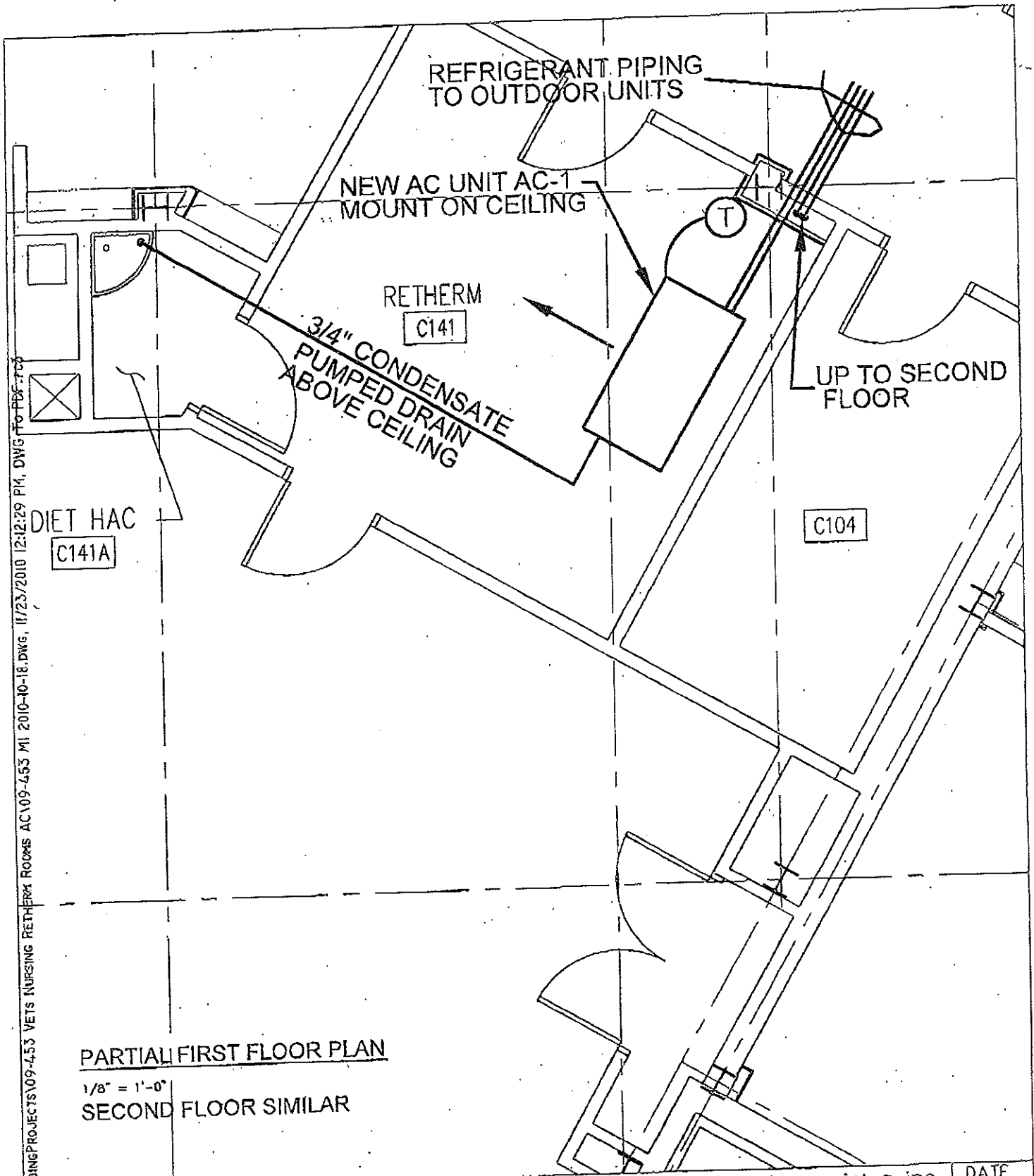

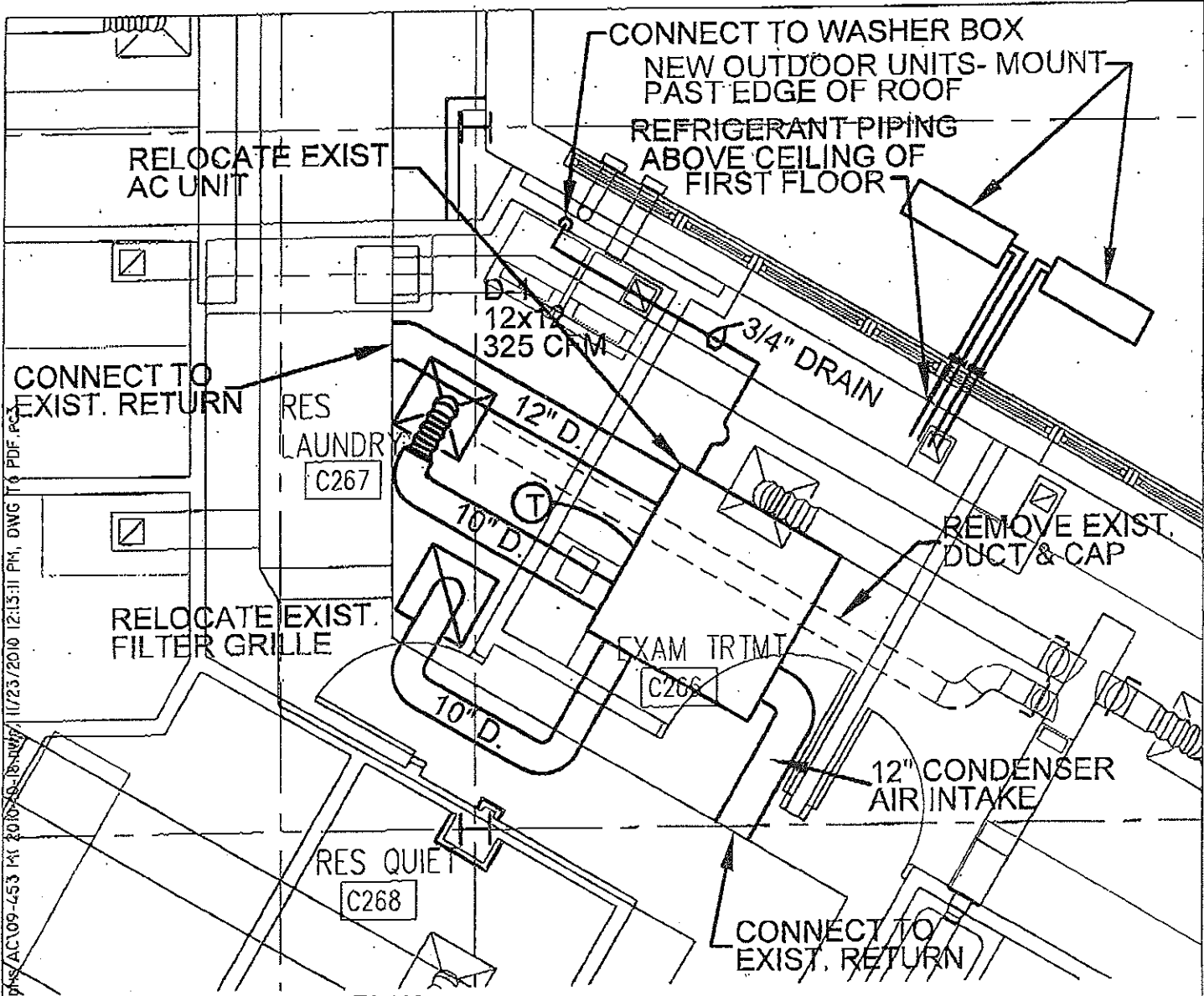

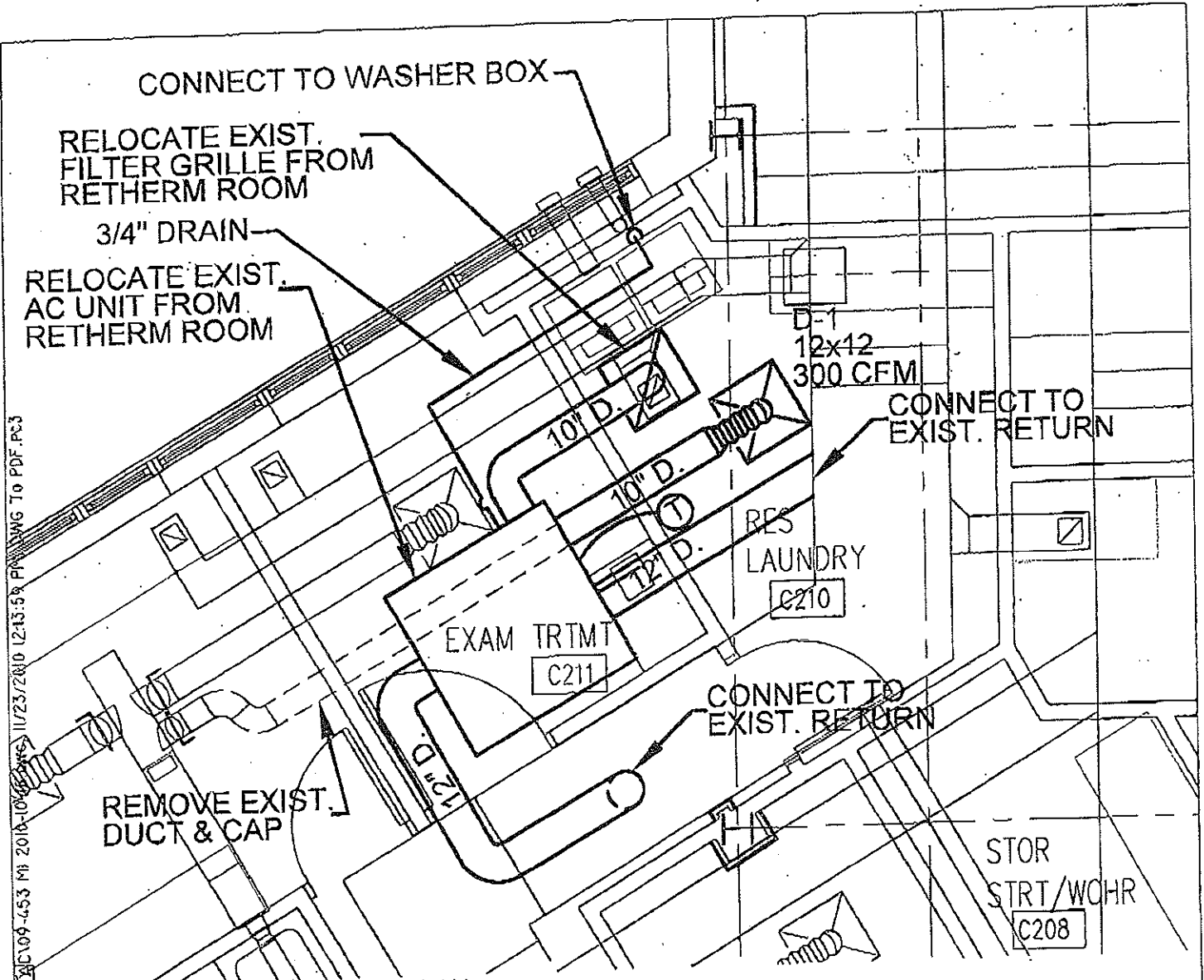
