GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
12. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

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Specifications

Purpose: To furnish all labor, materials and equipment necessary to provide Reinforced Concrete Box Culvert for a current project.

1.0 DEFINITIONS

- A. The "Agency" shall be defined as the West Virginia Division of Highways
- B. The "Vendor" shall be defined as the successful bidder.
- C. The "Purchase Order" shall be defined as the binding agreement that is entered into between the State of West Virginia and the Vendor to provide the services as herein specified.
- D. "Mandatory Requirements: The terms "must", "will", "shall", "minimum", "maximum", or "is/are required" identify a mandatory item or factor. Decisions regarding compliance with any mandatory requirements shall be at the sole discretion of the State.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The successful Vendor shall provide Reinforced Concrete Box Culverts

2.1 Technical Requirements:

2.1.1 36 L.F., Reinforced Concrete Box Culverts

9 Each of 4.0 FT. Sections with a span of 16 feet and a rise of 8 feet with 1 foot thick walls

2.1.2 All Precast Concrete shall be manufactured in accordance with AASHTO Standard Specifications Designation M273-94, except that all welded wire reinforcement and reinforcing steel bars where allowed shall be coated in accordance with AASHTO M284-91 (epoxy coating).

2.1.3 Administration of this Purchase Order shall meet the requirements of West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways, Standard Specifications for Roads and

2.1.4 Cracks developing in a unit may be cause for rejection of the unit. Cracks that are not detrimental to the structural integrity of the bridge unit as determined by the Division of Highways may be accepted under the following conditions.

- 1) Cracks of 0.004 inch or less shall be treated with a SECOND Coat of a DOH approved concrete sealer.
- 2) Cracks of greater than 0.004 inch shall be treated by a DOH approved epoxy injection method. All concrete and epoxy injections required for acceptance shall be performed at no additional cost to the Division of Highways

2.1.5 Shop drawing and design calculations must be approved by Division of Highways prior to the manufacture of any Bridge Units.

2.2 Delivery

- 2.2.1 Culverts are to be delivered to Bridge NO. S324-12/11-0.01 near War in McDowell County, WV
- 2.2.2 All Bridge Units shall be delivered to the specified delivery site within ninety (90) calendar days after Vendors receipt of approved shop drawings.
- 2.2.3 Notification is required twenty-four (24) hours prior to delivery, call (304) 487-5243. Failure to provide proper notification may result in a delay in acceptance of material. All deliveries shall have proper mill certifications included with bill of lading.

The requirements of the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways Specifications for Roads and Bridges, Section 109.20---Price Adjustment FOR LOAD LIMIT VIOLATIONS shall apply to all materials supplied under this order.

Application is made for 2.5% resident vendor preference for the reason checked: Bidder is a nonresident vendor employing a minimum of one hundred state residents or is a nonresident vendor with an affiliate or subsidiary which maintains its headquarters or principal place of business within West Virginia employing a minimum of one hundred state residents who certifies that, during the life of the contract, on average at least 75% of the employees or Bidder's affiliate's or subsidiary's employees are residents of West Virginia who have resided in the state continuously for the two years immediately preceding submission of this bid; or,

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
