1. SPECIFICATIONS

The following sections of the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways Standard Specifications Roads and Bridges, adopted 2010 as modified by the January 1, 2011 Supplemental Specifications shall apply to the administration of this contract: Sections 101, 102.4, 102.5, 105.1, 105.3, 105.4, 105.10, 105.11, 105.12, 105.13, 106.3, 106.4, 106.5, 106.6, 106.7, 106.9, 107.1, 107.2, 107.3, 107.14, 107.19, 107.20, 108.8, 109.1, 109.2 and 109.20.

The requirements of the West Virginia Department of Transportation; Division of Highways, Standard Specifications Section 109.20, PRICE ADJUSTMENT FOR LOAD LIMIT VIOLATIONS shall apply to all material supplied under this contract. This will include material loaded by the vendor into Division of Highways owned and/or rented trucks.

The terms "Contractor" and "Vendor" used in the above specifications of this contract are interchangeable. Contractor shall mean Vendor and Vendor shall mean Contractor.

Sodium Chloride shall conform to the requirements of ASTM D632-83 and Type I, Grade 1 and shall be delivered in bulk.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

The purpose of this contract is to provide for the delivery of Sodium Chloride to the various locations listed in Section 12, Bid Schedule. Actual quantities to be delivered to each location will be specified in an Agency Release, which will be issued by the Division of Highways at the time delivery is required.

3. ACCEPTANCE AND DELIVERY GUARANTEE

The Division of Highways guarantees acceptance of eighty percent (80%) of the total estimated quantity awarded to an individual vendor. However, conditions may dictate adjustment of the actual quantities delivered to specified sites.

The Vendor shall guarantee delivery, as requested by the Division of Highways, of one hundred and twenty percent (120%) of the total estimated award quantity stated in this contract. Quantities purchased F.O.B. Vendor's Storage Site will not be included in the acceptance and delivery guarantee.

All guaranteed deliveries shall be completed prior to March 15, 2012.

4. <u>BIDDING INSTRUCTIONS</u>

Vendors submitting bids for a specific county shall bid all of that county's locations - one unit price - for the county sites listed in Section 12, Bid Schedule. This shall apply to the listed Interstate and Corridor sites as well.

Any qualification of bids or any modification of the specifications or conditions governing the bids may be cause for their rejection.

CONTRACT AWARD

All qualified Vendors who submit a valid bid for "FOB Division's Storage Site", Section 12, Bid Schedule will be awarded a contract for those locations for which their bid is low.

All qualified Vendors who submit a valid bid for "FOB Vendor's Storage Site", in Section 13, Bid Schedule will be awarded a contract for this item.

6. <u>DELIVERY</u>

An Agency Release for delivery to Division of Highways Storage Sites, Section 12, Bid Schedule, will be issued to the awarded Vendor at the time delivery is needed.

When an Agency Release is issued to an awarded Vendor, from December 1, 2011 through March 15, 2012, a delivery date of <u>four (4) working days</u> shall be established by the Division of Highways and provided on the Agency Release; however, the Division of Highways shall have the option of accepting an alternative delivery schedule provided by the awarded Vendor which shall be established at the time of the Agency Release.

Inability to Deliver:

If delivery has not been received at the Division of Highways site after <u>five (5)</u> <u>working days</u> and an alternative delivery schedule has not been established for this delivery, the Division of Highways reserves the right to cancel the Agency Release and proceed to obtain the required quantity of Sodium Chloride from an alternate economical source.

At the discretion of the Division of Highways, the first alternate economical source shall be the next low bidder, if that bidder has availability; or secondly, may obtain pricing on the Open Market.

The quantity, required to fulfill the canceled Agency Release obtained through an alternate source, whether by the next low bidder or the Open Market, will be deducted from the awarded Vendor's 80% guaranteed minimum quantity.

If the alternate economical source chosen to fulfill this request is a Vendor which has also been awarded a contract for other Division of Highways

storage sites, this quantity shall be included in that Vendor's 80% guaranteed minimum quantity.

The Division of Highways will also invoice the awarded Vendor the difference in cost from the awarded Vendor's price and the alternate obtained source's price. In addition to the difference in cost, the Division of Highways may include, but not limited to, any additional transportation charges associated with this delivery to fulfill the need of the canceled Agency Release.

Original delivery tickets for each delivered load to the Division of Highways' storage sites must be signed and retained by a Division of Highways employee at the delivery location.

7. SAMPLING AND TESTING

Upon award of contract, the Vendor shall provide the Division of Highways with the proposed source of supply. Acceptance shall be based on suppliers' certification of quality and gradation. This information shall be directed to:

The Division of Highways may conduct sampling and testing to verify material quality or gradation.

8. WEIGHING MATERIALS DELIVERED BY TRUCK

Material delivered by truck shall be weighed in accordance with Section 308.5 of the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways Standard Specifications Roads and Bridges adopted 2010 as modified by the January 1, 2011 Supplemental Specifications.

9. <u>SUPPLYING OTHER ORGANIZATIONAL ENTITIES</u>

In accordance with Chapter 5A, Article 3, Section 9 of the Code of West Virginia the commodities or services contracted for herein shall be available to all local governmental bodies in accordance with the same prices, terms and conditions afforded to the State of West Virginia.

In the event any Vendor does not wish to extend the prices, terms and conditions of his bid and subsequent contract to all political sub-divisions of the State, he must so indicate in a clear and unambiguous manner in his bid. This indication does not prejudice the award of the contract. If a Vendor does not indicate his refusal to extend the prices, terms and conditions of his bid to other entities of the State, he is bound to extend them upon issuance of a purchase order by these entities.

Other organizational entities using this provision of the contract shall do so without any involvement of the

Response: The term "locations" should read "county locations".

5. "Are the 0 tons for the locations listed on the bid schedule page for pricing, considered place holders?"

Response:

Even though the Division of Highways does not list an estimated quantity to be delivered to some county locations, we do not want to remove these county locations in case of a need for Road Salt at that county location. 


