3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division

- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.

ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Various Legislative acts passed in the 2012 session require inclusion of certain provisions in all state contracts. Accordingly, this addendum will add the three provisions listed below to the solicitation and resulting contract entered into between the State of West Virginia and the vendor. In the event that the solicitation is not for construction or architectural/engineering work, sections 2 and 3 below will not apply.

1. BACKGROUND CHECK: In accordance with W. Va. Code § 15-2D-3, the Director of the Division of Protective Services may require any service provider whose employees are regularly employed on the grounds or in the buildings of the Capitol complex or who have access to sensitive or critical information to submit to a fingerprint-based state and federal background inquiry through the state repository.

After the contract for such services has been approved, but before any such employees are permitted to be on the grounds or in the buildings of the Capitol complex or have access to sensitive or critical information, the service provider shall submit a list of all persons who will be physically present and working at the Capitol complex to the Director of the Division of Protective Services for purposes of verifying compliance with this provision.

The State reserves the right to prohibit a service provider's employees from accessing sensitive or critical information or to be present at the Capitol complex based upon results addressed from a criminal background check.

- 2. SUBCONTRACTOR LIST SUBMISSION: In accordance with W. Va. Code § 5-22-1, The apparent low bidder on a contract for the construction, alteration, decoration, painting or improvement of a new or existing building or structure valued at more than \$500,000.00 shall submit a list of all subcontractors who will perform more than \$25,000.00 of work on the project including labor and materials. This provision shall not apply to any other construction projects, such as highway, mine reclamation, water or sewer projects.
 - a. Required Information. The subcontractor list shall contain the following information:
 - i. Bidder's name
 - ii. Name of each subcontractor
 - iii. License numbers as required by W. Va. Code § 21-11-1 et. seq.
 - Notation that no subcontractors will be used if the bidder will perform the work

- b. Submission. The completed subcontractor list shall be provided to the Purchasing Division within one business day of the opening of bids for review. Failure to submit the subcontractor list within one business day after the deadline for submitting bids shall result in disqualification of the bid.
- c. Substitution of Subcontractor. Written approval must be obtained from the Purchasing Division before any subcontractor substitution is permitted. Substitutions are not permitted unless:
 - i. The subcontractor listed in the original bid has filed for bankruptcy;
 - ii. The subcontractor in the original bid has been debarred or suspended; or
 - The contractor certifies in writing that the subcontractor listed in the original bill fails, is unable, or refuses to perform his subcontract.
- 3. GREEN BUILDINGS MINIMUM ENERGY STANDARDS: In accordance with § 22-29-4, all new building construction projects of public agencies that have not entered the schematic design phase prior to July 1, 2012, or any building construction project receiving state grant funds and appropriations, including public schools, that have not entered the schematic design phase prior to July 1, 2012, shall be designed and constructed complying with the ICC International Energy Conservation Code, adopted by the State Fire Commission, and the ANSI/ASHRAE/IESNA Standard 90.1-2007: Provided, That if any construction project has a commitment of federal funds to pay for a portion of such project, this provision shall only apply to the extent such standards are consistent with the federal standards.

SCOPE OF WORK

The purpose of this contract is to provide to the Division of Highways parts for use in repair/replacement to the Cass System Cable Guardrail, or equal to, currently in place on West Virginia roadways. Actual quantity of each part will be specified on an Agency Release at the time of need.

2. BIDDING INSTRUCTIONS

Any vendor that can provide Cass System Cable Guardrail, or equal to, repair/replacements parts are eligible to bid. Vendor bidding "or equal" parts, MUST guarantee that their parts will integrate completely with the existing Cass System in place and will NOT void the existing warranty. Copy of this guarantee MUST accompany the vendor's bid.

Vendors may bid on any or all parts listed on the Bid Schedule. Vendors should be cautioned as the quantities listed on the bid schedule are estimates only. It is understood and agreed that the contract shall cover the quantities actually ordered for delivery, by an Agency Release, whether more or less than the quantities shown on the bid schedule.

Any qualification of bids or any modification of the specifications or conditions governing the bids, by the vendor, may be cause for their rejection.

3. CONTRACT AWARD

Qualified Vendors who submit a valid bid will be awarded a contract for those parts for which their bid is low. The State of West Virginia reserves the right to make multiple awards on this contract when it is in the best interest of the State.

In the event a Vendor fails to conform to the requirements set out in this contract document, the Agency Release or the governing specifications, the Purchase Order Contract may be cancelled and awarded to the next low bidder.

4. <u>DELIVERY</u>

Materials under this contract are to be shipped prepaid FOB delivery to Division of Highways District Storerooms as follows:

District One Charleston District Two Huntington District Three Parkersburg District Four Clarksburg District Five Burlington District Six Moundsville District Seven Weston District Eight Elkins District Nine Lewisburg District Ten Princeton

Materials should be shipped to the location and in the quantity specified on the Agency Release within thirty (30) days after receipt of the Agency Release.

5. VENDOR'S INVOICE

Vendor's invoices must be submitted in original and one (1) copy and contain the following:

- a. Division of Highways' Agency Release number, and this contract number.
- b. Total quantity and unit price of each part

NOTE: Under no circumstances will the Division of Highways accept, or pay for, quantities of material in excess of the quantity stated on the Agency Release.

6. PURSHASING CARD ACCEPTANCE

The State of West Virginia currently utilizes a VISA Purchasing Card Program which is issued through a bank. The successful vendors must accept the State of West Virginia VISA Purchasing Card for payment of all orders placed by any state agency for orders as a condition of award.
