GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
12. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

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Specifications

Purpose: To establish an open end contract to provide the West Virginia Division of Highways with channelizer cones.

1.0 DEFINITIONS

- A. The "Agency" shall be defined as the West Virginia Division of Highways
- B. The "Vendor" shall be defined as the successful bidder.
- C. The "Contract" shall be defined as the binding agreement that is entered into between the State of West Virginia and the Vendor to provide the services as herein specified.
- D. "Release Order" shall be defined as order placed against the Contract by the Agency.
- E. Mandatory Requirements: The terms "must", "will", "shall", "minimum", "maximum", or "is/are required" identify a mandatory item or factor. Decisions regarding compliance with any mandatory requirements shall be at the sole discretion of the State.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The successful Vendor shall provide Flexible Plastic Channelizer Cones, including bases, with sheeting pre-applied, and replacement cones and bases, as needed.

2.1 Technical Requirements:

2.1.1: The Channelizer Cones supplied as part of this Contract shall be a model on the WVDOH Approved Products Listing (APL), and shall meet any additional requirements specified in this Contract.

2.1.2 All Channelizer Cones shall be supplied with horizontal, circumferential, alternating orange and white retroreflective stripes 6-inches wide. Channelizer Cones shall have a minimum of two orange and two white stripes with the top stripe being orange. Any non-retroreflectorized spaces between the horizontal orange and white stripes shall not exceed 1-inch.

2.1.3 Sheeting used on Channelizer Cones shall be TYPE ASTM-III - HIGH INTENSITY GRADE. The sheeting used by the supplier shall be a Type ASTM-III material, approved for use on Channelizer Cones, listed on the WVDOH Approved Products List for Retroreflective Sheatings.

2.2 Freight

2.2.1 All shipments are to be FOB Destination.

2.3 Delivery

2.3.1 This Contract may be utilized by multiple recipients statewide, each having a unique delivery address. Typically, deliveries will be to one of the Agency (WVDOH) District Sign Shops shown on the list included as an attachment to this RFQ.

2.3.2 Release Orders shall be delivered in full within thirty (30) Calendar Days ARO. If the Vendor is unable to deliver in full within the applicable time frame, the Vendor shall be subject to a daily (per Calendar Day) penalty at the purchasing organizations discretion for each Calendar Day beyond thirty (30) Calendar Days ARO until the order is received in full. This penalty shall be assessed by subtracting the penalty from the original total value of the Release Order. The penalty shall not exceed the original total amount of the Release Order. The penalty shall be calculated based on the Table shown at the following address:

The original total amount of the Release Order shall be substituted for the "Original Contract Amount" when using this Table.

2.3.3 All components shall be shipped adequately secured on pallets for ease in unloading. Any material delivered not meeting the above requirement shall be subject to being returned to the Vendor at the Vendor's expense. In this case, the Vendor shall be responsible for the shipment of the returned materials back to the purchasing organization, packaged as specified above. In addition, the provisions of 2.3.2 shall remain in effect. The order shall be considered "delivered in full" at the time of delivery of the returned materials back to the purchasing organization. Furthermore, the number of days for completion of the order shall be calculated as specified in 2.3.2.

2.3.4 Delivery is an integral part of this contract and failure to comply will be cause to initiate a WV-82, Vendor Performance Form. This form will officially notify the West Virginia Division of Purchasing and the Vendor of unsatisfactory performance in the execution of this contract and the requirements herein.

3.0 MATERIAL SPECIFICATIONS

3.1 Approved Products

3.1.1 The Approved Products Lists referenced below establish a list of products that meet the acceptable level of quality and is not intended to reflect a preference or favor any particular brand or vendor. Any fabricator meeting the established level of quality may become an approved fabricator and be added to the approved fabricator's list in accordance with the approval procedures found in MP 700.00.55 Guidelines for Establishing Approved Lists of Materials and Sources. The state reserves the right to waive minor irregularities in bids or specifications in accordance with section 148-1-4(F) of the West Virginia Legislative Rules and Regulations.

3.1.2 The product bid for items 1-3 is a model listed within the "approved for use on roadways with a normal posted speed limit of 55 mph or less" section of the APL and manufactured of low density polyethylene. High Density Polyethylene shall not be allowed.

3.1.3 The product bid for items 4-6 shall be a model listed within the "approved for use on all roadways" section of the APL, and having a maximum base weight of 20lb, and manufactured of low density polyethylene. High Density Polyethylene shall not be allowed.

3.2 Hot Stamping

3.2.1 Each Channelizer Cone shall be permanently hot stamped in a prominent location with the letters "WVDOH", a minimum of 1" in height.

3.3 Channelizer Cone Manufacturer Sheeting Application Certification

3.3.1 Each Vendor bidding on this Contract shall be required to submit a copy of a letter(s) specific to the Contract, by reference of the Contract number in the letter(s), stating that the Channelizer Cone manufacturer has been certified by the sheeting manufacturer(s) to apply the series sheeting(s) intended for use by the Channelizer Cone manufacturer to the model Channelizer Cone to be supplied. This letter(s) shall be addressed from the sheeting manufacturer(s) to the Channelizer Cone manufacturer and should

be included with the Vendor's bid package. If, during the life of the Contract, the manufacturer intends to begin utilizing an alternative approved sheeting for which a letter as described above was not originally submitted, the Vendor shall make this request in writing along with a letter as previously described.

4.0 ORDERING AND INVOICING

4.1 Release Orders: For all orders, the Agency will issue to the Vendor a WV-39 Release Order. Issuance of the Release Order shall contain the type of merchandise to be purchased and shall serve as the authorization to process the order.

4.1.1 Minimum Order Size: Each order shall include a minimum total of 25 ea. channelizer cones, with or without bases.

4.2 Payment

4.2.1 The State of West Virginia currently utilizes a VISA purchasing card program which is issued through a local bank. The Vendor must accept the State of West Virginia purchasing card for payment of all orders placed against this Contract.

4.2.2 The Vendor must supply a credit card receipt, sales receipt, or cash register receipt. In addition, all orders shall be shipped with an itemized packing list(s). The packing list(s) shall show all items included in the shipment as well as items on backorder. Charges must not be applied until all merchandise on the WV-39 Release Order is received in full by the Agency.

5.0 AWARD

- 5.1 Contract Sections: This Contract shall be divided into two "Sections" for bid evaluation and award purposes. "Section I" shall include items 1-3 and "Section II" shall include items 4-6. Each Section shall be evaluated independently with award to be made to separate Vendors if required.

The award for each Section will be based on the sum of the values in the Extended Total Amount column within each Section. In case of any discrepancy between the value in the Extended Total Amount column for a particular item and the unit bid price multiplied by the estimated quantity, the unit bid price shall prevail. Vendors are cautioned that the quantities on the bid schedule are estimates and only used for evaluation purposes.

The state of West Virginia reserves the right to make multiple awards on this contract when it is in the best interest of the state to do so.

BID SCHEDULE

Quantities listed in this RFQ are approximations only. It is understood and agreed that the contract shall cover the quantities actually ordered for delivery during the term of the contract, whether more or less than the quantities shown.

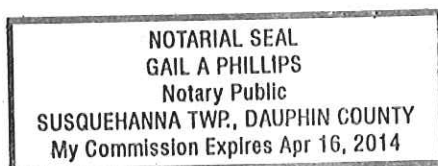
