GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
12. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

- Item 2: Q - What size pipe is specified for the underdrains, 8" or 12"? (Specs. said one size, and drawings showed a different size.)
A - Twelve inches (12"). The specifications for underdrains (Section 10.0) should be changed to 12" pipe.
- Item 3: Q - What size rock is required for the conveyance channel?
A - AML standard of $D_{50} = 12"$.
- Item 4: Q - Is stone type specified? (Calcareous vs. Non-calcareous.)
A - Channel stone can be either. Drainage uses (underdrains /mine seals) is non-calcareous. (See Specifications sections 7.2.1, 9.2.2 and 10.2.2.)
- Item 5: Clarification: - On Sheet E-E27, on the Bat Gate Horizontal Bar Detail, the dimension between horizontal bars is 5.75 inches. (The drawing is correct).

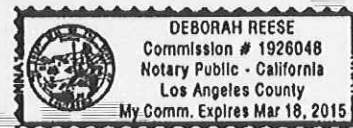
