## **GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS** REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.

3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division

and have paid the required \$125 fee.

- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, is available online at www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.html and is hereby made part of the agreement provided that the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
- 14. CONFIDENTIALITY: The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures, and rules. Vendor further agrees to comply with the Confidentiality Policies and Information Security Accountability Requirements, set forth in http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/privacy/noticeConfidentiality.pdf.
- 15. LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, and the West Virginia Insurance Commission. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.
- 16. ANTITRUST: In submitting a bid to any agency for the State of West Virginia, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted the bidder will convey, sell, assign or transfer to the State of West Virginia all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of West Virginia for price fixing and/or unreasonable restraints of trade relating to the particular commodities or services purchased or acquired by the State of West Virginia. Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.

## SCOPE OF WORK

The successful bidder shall provide appropriate equipment, materials, labor and any technical services needed for the scope of work as described in this contract. The General Performance Standards (GPS) shall apply to all items in Scope of Work. --

Sludge pumping will be from treated acid mine drainage settling ponds through 6 inch diameter high density polyethylene piping, which has been permanently installed beside the pond, to sludge drying cells. The sludge pipe connections are fitted with cam and groove adaptors for quick connection to a pump. Most sludge drying cells are 120 feet or less in height above the treatment settling ponds (ponds require approximately 20 feet of suction lift). Some treatment sites require two 6 inch sludge pumps in a series or use of a high-head pump due to pumping heights greater than 120 feet. The pumping distance varies from site to site, but is normally less than 1,000 feet. All pumps shall be in good operable condition and be readily available to be used at as many as four different locations at any given time. Some sludge removal sites will require continuous pumping from start-up to finish. Any trailer-mounted pumps specified shall meet Department of Transportation (DOT) approval for highway travel.

Pumping on an individual settling pond shall be considered complete when more than ninety five (95%) of the volume of the pond has been restored.

## **Questions and Answers**

- Q. 1. DEP14150 also included snow removal. Just needed to know for sure that DEP number 15743 does or does not include snow removal.
- A.1 Contract does not include snow removal. Contract is for pumping only.
- Q.2. Need for 3 & 6 inch pumps multiple jobs at one time?

- A.2. Yes
- Q.3. How many ponds & how often do they need cleaned? est 3.
- A.3 The total number of permits DEP Office of Special Reclamation currently maintains is 42. The frequency of pumping ponds varies depending on precipitation and the conditions that are specific to that site. For example, Viking Coal UO-519 in Preston County typically requires pumping monthly. Delta Mining, permit U-2024-87 in Upshur County, typically requires pumping every eighteen to twenty-four months. Bidders should keep in mind the majority of the work covered in this contract is in Preston County and eastern Monongalia County.
- Q.4. How far apart are the drying cells located from ponds?
- A.4. Distance varies. Some sites require high head pumps or double pumping due to distance and difference in elevation. The majority only require a pump that meets the minimum specifications defined in line item 3.
- Q.5. Average size of ponds
- A.5. Average size does vary. Typical size is fifty by two hundred feet.
- Q.6. Is it possible to see ponds before bid is placed?
- A.6. Yes. Bidders may call Scott McElwayne at 304-203-4048 or Greg Phillips at 304-516-9668 to schedule an appointment to review sites that are a representation of the work.
- Q.7. Is Bid based on a 40 week minimum & if so do overtime rates apply
