The objective of this Request for Quotations ("RFQ") is for contractor to provide all materials and equipment and perform all labor required to install complete and operable Shower Exhaust System as indicated on Architects drawings as specified and as required by code.

ELECTRICAL SPECIFICATIONS

1- GENERAL

I.CODES

- A. All Equipment wiring and the entire installation shall be in accordance with the applicable provisions of the latest edition of the National Electric Code (NEC), OSHA Requirements, Life Safety Code and all applicable Local and State Laws and Ordinances.

II.ROUGH-IN

- A. Verify final locations for rough-ins with shop drawings, Field measurements, and with the requirements of the actual equipment to be connected prior to rough-in.

III.INSTALLATION

- A. All materials are to be installed in a neat and first class manner, level and plumb and securely supported.
- B. All wiring shall be in conduit. The use of E.N.T., BX, NM, ETC. or pre-manufactured cable assemblies or aluminum wire will not be permitted.

2- PRODUCTS

I. RACEWAYS

1. Conduit shall be sized for conductors in accordance with the N.E.C.
2. The routing and method of installation of all conduit shall be coordinated so as not to interfere with other equipment installations and shall meet with the complete satisfaction of DJS representative.
3. The use of electrical non-metallic tubing (ENT), armored cable (AC), metal clad cable (MC) or manufactured cable assemblies shall not be incorporated into the work.

A. Types of raceways specified in this section include the following:

1. Electrical Metallic tubing (EMT); Minimum trade size $\frac{1}{2}$ "
2. Flexible metal conduit. Minimum trade size $\frac{3}{4}$ "
3. Liquid-tight flexible metal conduit (SEALTIGHT) Minimum trade size $\frac{3}{4}$ "

B. FITTINGS

1. Fittings for EMT shall be steel set screw or compression type with factory installed insulated throat connectors, die cast or pot metal fillings are not acceptable.
2. Fittings for flexible conduit shall be steel or cast iron.

II. INSTALLATION OF RACEWAYS

- A. All conduit shall be installed concealed.
- B. A separate grounding conductor shall be installed in all branch circuits and feeders. The conductors shall be sized as indicated in the N.E.C. All grounding conductors shall have a green outer covering or green marking tape over their entire exposed lengths.
- C. Mechanically fasten together metal conduits, enclosures, and raceways for conductors to form a continuous electrical conductor. Connect to electrical boxes, fittings and cabinets to provide electrical continuity and firm mechanical assembly.
- D. Avoid use of dissimilar metals through system to eliminate possibility of electrolysis.
- E. CONDUIT INSTALLATION

1. Use E.M.T. for all interior concealed and for exposed work not subject to mechanical injury.
2. Use liquid -tight flexible conduit for final 24" connection to items where subjected to one or more of the following conditions:
 - a. Exterior location
 - b. Moist or humid atmosphere where condensate can be expected to accumulate.
 - c. Final connection to rotating or vibrating equipment
3. Cut conduits straight, properly ream and cut threads for heavy wall conduit deep and clean.
4. Field bend conduit with benders designed for the purpose so as not to distort nor vary internal diameter.

III.CONDUCTORS

- A. All wire shall be copper with THWN insulation
- B. The use of Armored Cable, BX, NM or any manufactured cable assembly shall not be incorporated into the work.
- C. All wiring shall be in conduit.
- D. Color Coding of conductors shall be as follows:
 1. 120/208V systems
 - A. Phase A- Black
 - B. Phase B- Red
 - C. Phase C- Blue
 - D. Neutral- White
 - E. Ground- Green

IV.WIRE CONNECTIONS

- A. All branch wiring connections shall be 3M scotch lock connectors or the equivalent.
- B. Where cable connections require insulation, Scotch # 33, electrical tape shall be used for wrapping.

V. BOXES AND FITTINGS

- A. Extent of Electrical Box and associated fitting work is indicated by drawing and schedule.
- B. Outlet Boxes
 1. Ceiling: 4" square, 2-1/8" deep for exposed or furred work.
 2. Wall: 4" square, 2-1/8" deep boxes: Provide extension rings or covers of sufficient depth to bring covers flush with the finished surface.

3. Masonry: For flush mounted boxes in exposed masonry or tile, provide covers with square corners on the raised portion and with sufficient depth to trim out flush with exposed surface.

4. Exposed: Provide FS or FD boxes with suitable weatherproof covers.

C. Junction and Pull Boxes

1. Provide boxes where required to facilitate the pulling of wires or cables.

D. Accessories

1. Provide corrosion resistant knockout closures, conduit locknuts and malleable iron conduit brushings, offset connectors, of types and sizes to suit respective installation requirements and applications.

E. Installation of Boxes and Fittings

1. Fasten Electrical boxes firmly and rigidly to substrates or structural surfaces to which attached or solidly embed electrical boxes in concrete or masonry.

VI. CONNECTIONS FOR EQUIPMENT

A. General: For each electrical connection indicated provide complete assembly of materials, including but not necessarily limited to, pressure connectors, terminals (lugs), electrical insulating tape, heat – shrinkable insulating tubing, cable ties, solderless wire- nuts, and other items and accessories as needed to complete splices and terminations of types indicated.

VII. WIRING DEVICES

A. Provide wiring devices which are U.L. listed and labeled.

VIII. MOTOR DISCONNECTS

A. Disconnect switches

1. General Duty Switches: Provide surface mounted sheet steel enclosed switches, of types, sizes and with electrical characteristics indicated, incorporating quick-make quick-break type switches.

2. Switch blade shall be visible in "OFF" position with the door open. Equipment with operating handle which is integral part of enclosure base and whose operating position is clearly indicated.

3. Construct current carrying parts of high-conductivity copper and silver-tungsten type switch contacts. Provide NEMA type 3R only.

VENTILATION

3. GENERAL

I. DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK:

- A. The contractor shall furnish and install equipment as indicated on the drawings. Items not listed or detailed, but required for installation of a complete, fully functional ventilation system shall be furnished and installed by the contractor.
- B. The extent of the mechanical work is indicated on the drawings. The contractor shall be responsible for installing factory provided accessories.
- C. The entire installation shall be in accordance with the drawings, specifications, applicable requirements of the manufacturers of the equipment and local codes requirements, and in accordance with SMACNA standards and the latest editions of the State Bldg. Codes, NFPA-90A, and NFPA-101.
- D. **Roof: Refer to EF-2, EF-4, and EF-5, roof mounted exhaust fans. Existing roof is precast concrete. Contractor shall coordinate penetration of precast concrete with existing conditions. Transition ductwork is required for penetration. It shall be the contractor's responsibility to maintain the integrity of the roofing system.**

II. SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Noise and Vibration; equipment shall operate quietly and the design of the supports shall be such that the operation of the equipment shall cause no perceptible vibration, or cause directly or indirectly, vibration or objectionable noise in any other portion of the building and/or in the building structure itself.
- B. Flashing; all flashing required for penetration of roof surfaces by ventilation system shall be included under the contractor's scope of work and shall be in accordance with the recommendations of the roofing manufacturer.

4 -PRODUCTS

- I. Sheet Metal Work. Note: The installation of the ventilation system, including but not limited to, Exhaust Drops, Trunk Lines, Branch Lines and Grilles shall be completed in such a manner to present a system suitable for the intended purpose. Any part of the system not conforming to the above purpose shall be removed and replaced by this contractor.

- A. Supply galvanized sheet metal sheet metal work in accordance with ASHRAE or SMACNA standards. Size of duct indicated on drawings is finished inside dimension.
- B. Provide offsets, elbows and transitions in ductwork where necessary, whether or not shown.
- C. Use weights, bracing, joints and all details in accordance with SMACNA.
- D. Make interior of duct smooth and joints air tight. Where necessary to ensure tightness, caulk joints. Make the entire installation rigid with ductwork free from rattles and air noises when in operation.
- E. Make elbows with inside radius equal to the width of the duct except where otherwise specified or necessitated by unavoidable space conditions. Where inside radius is less than $3/4$ (three fourths) the duct width.
- F. Include angle of divergence for enlargement not to exceed 15 degrees where space conditions permit. Included angle of convergence for contracting not to exceed 30 degrees.
- G. Install grilles as indicated.
- H. All taps into main duct line for branch lines shall be made with spin-in fittings with dampers.

II. Grilles

- A. All Exhaust Grilles shall be equal as scheduled on drawings with off-white baked on enamel finish.

5- EXECUTION

I. Supervision of Electrical Work

- A. This contractor shall be responsible for the supervision of all wiring (including control wiring) of equipment include in this section and shall furnish all necessary diagrams required, including control wiring diagrams. This contractor shall mount or supervise mounting of all control devices.

II. Painting

- A. All touch up painting shall be included. Color shall match adjacent surface.
- B. All masonry damage during installation of system shall be repaired as required to match adjacent surface.

III. Cleaning and Adjustments

- A. Upon completion of work, clean, oil and grease all fans, and make certain that all such apparatus and mechanisms are in proper working order and made ready for test.

6. INSPECTION:

- I. Contractor shall inspect existing conditions governing this work during pre-bid site inspection to determine conditions and extent of work required. No allowance will be made subsequently on behalf of the contractor for any error or negligence on his part in connection with this requirement.

7. COORDINATION OF WORK:

- I. The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions to protect the interior of the building from debris, dust or any residue occurring from the scope of work.
- II. The Contractor shall provide the Owner with a schedule of work seven calendar days prior to the start of the work. The Owner shall be notified of any variances to the work schedule two (2) working days prior to the change.

8. WARRANTY

- I. Furnish a one (1) year warranty on all equipment and materials.

9. PERMITS:

- I. The Vendor shall secure and pay for the building permit and for all other permits, governmental fees and licenses which are necessary for the proper execution and completion of the work as specified.

10. CLEAN UP:

- I. The Vendor shall keep the work area as clean as possible during the entire progress of work, and shall be responsible to remove from the site, the packaging materials from his products and other debris as it accumulates.
-

11. WAGE RATES:

- I. The Vendor and any sub-vendors shall pay the higher of the U.S. Department of Labor Minimum wage rates or of the West Virginia Department of Labor wage rates as established for KANAWHA COUNTY pursuant to West Virginia Code 21-5-1, et seq. West Virginia Department of Labor Wage Rates are available at website:

12. PAYMENT:

- I. Payment will be made upon full completion of the project
- II. The Owner reserves the right to refuse payment in the event the completed work is not in accordance with industry standards or sub-standard in any way.

13. TERM OF WORK:

- I. All work shall be complete within 60 calendar days from award.

14. DELAYS AND EXTENSION OF TIME:

- I. If the Vendor is delayed at any time in the progress of the work by any act or neglect of the Owner or by any employee of the Owner, or by any separate vendor employed by the Owner, or by changes in the work, or by labor disputes, fire, unusual delay in transportation, adverse weather conditions not reasonably anticipated, unavoidable casualties, or any other cause which the Owner determines may justify the delay, then the contract time may be extended by written approval of the Owner.

15. DAMAGES:

- I. Any damages occurring to the building or property resulting from the vendor's performance of this work shall be the responsibility of the vendor to repair at his expense, either by using his own forces or that of an approved sub-vendor. The repair method and finished product will be subject to the approval of the owner.

16. SCHEDULE OF BID RESPONSES:

- I. Bidders shall submit one lump-sum bid for all the work under all the terms and conditions as described herein.

- II. Bidder shall sign a WV-96 Agreement Addendum to remove any conflicts in terms and conditions of the vendor's warranty.
 - III. Before the Purchase order is processed, the successful bidder must provide to the Owner, a valid copy of their Business licenses through the Secretary of State's Office.
17. **SECURITY**: The successful Contractor awarded the bid will follow the security requirements set forth in the **pre-bid meeting**. See the attached **Facility Construction and Contractor Security Standards**.

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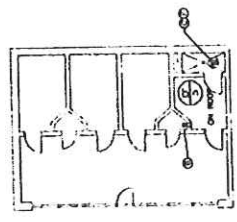
**Partial Second Floor Plan

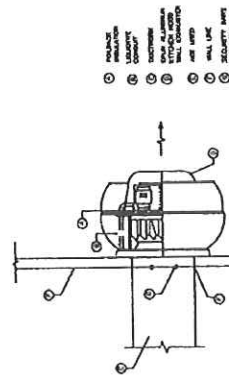

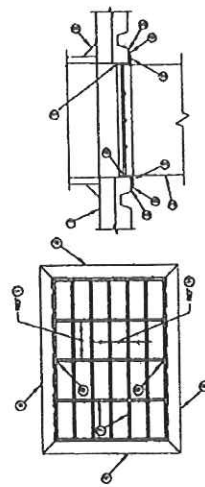

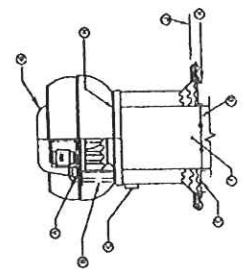

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Facility Construction and Contractor Security Standards

Attachment C

Because new construction or major renovation projects may substantially disrupt the normal routine of a facility, and potentially hazardous materials, tools and equipment may be introduced by civilian workers and contractors who are not experienced with correctional facility security, the following rules are to be in effect for workers performing tasks in any Juvenile Services Facility.

1. General Security Procedures

Prior to the beginning of any construction or renovation project, all contractors who will be doing work in the secure perimeter of the facility will submit a list of employees to the facility Superintendent or Director for a background check. Approved workers will also sign a certificate of understanding concerning the Division of Juvenile Services confidentiality policy.

2. Tool Control

The introduction of tools by the contractor will be managed and controlled on a daily basis. Rules will be established for tool control at the facility to include at a minimum, the inventory of all tools entering the secure perimeter and ensuring that all tools are accounted for at the end of the day.

3. Key Control

All keys, to include vehicles, construction equipment or personal keys of construction employees brought into a facility will be strictly controlled and managed by the Facility Superintendent or Director.

4. Chemical Control

All flammables, toxics and caustic substances brought into the facility will be controlled and stored in accordance with established procedures for each facility.

5. Contraband Issues

Contraband will be defined by the Facility Superintendent or Director and will be strictly enforced. It is against state law to bring a Firearm or intoxicating substance into a correctional facility.

6. Compliance Checklist

Facility staff will develop a checklist to monitor compliance with this document. The checklist will be completed on a weekly basis or more often if deemed necessary by the Superintendent or Director during the course of the project. This checklist will include at a minimum the following;

- A) Check for unauthorized or inappropriate use of and storage of tools, such as ladders wire cutters etc.
- B) Ensure construction vehicles, machinery and equipment has keys removed, fuel tanks locked and that the machinery has been disabled when not in immediate use.
- C) Construction site visits during normal workdays and after hours to ensure the site is secure, with locked gates if appropriate, and security concerns such as visibility issues, safety hazards and environmental issues that could cause staff and resident health problems are corrected.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
