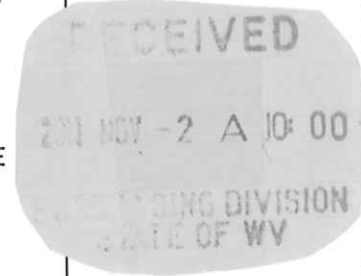

**Request for Quotation for a Prescription Drug Contract**

The West Virginia State Police are soliciting competitive bids from recognized pharmacies in all fifty states of the United States to provide prescription medication to retired members who have been disabled by a job related injury while employed by the WV State Police. This would also include members who are still employed that have been injured while on duty in their capacity of a West Virginia State Trooper.

**GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS:**

The vendor awarded this contract should be a recognized pharmacy (i.e: Rite-Aid, Wal-Mart, CVS, or equal) in all states. Since there is no residency restriction on retired members, it is imperative that the member be able to have a prescription filled in the State where the member resides.

The following are requirements that **must** be met by the vendor awarded this contract:

Agency will provide each retired disabled member a pharmacy card, issued by the winning vendor(s), which is name specific to that member. The member must be able to go to any pharmacy in the United States that is owned/controlled by the winning vendor(s) to have a legitimate prescription filled. The vendor must recognize this card when filling prescriptions.

**Billing:**

The winning vendor(s) will not charge the member at the time the prescription is filled, but will direct bill the West Virginia State Police for each prescription on a monthly basis. This billing will list the following:

- A) Name of person for whom prescription was filled.
- B) Date prescription was filled
- C) Type and quantity of medicine prescribed.
- D) Discounted price to the agency and regular price before discount.

All billing shall be submitted to the West Virginia State Police, 123 Academy Drive, Dunbar WV 25064 ATTENTION: Medical Unit

**Shipping:**

If shipping of medication becomes necessary, the vendor will include in their mark up over actual cost bid price, freight/shipping cost of the medication. Vendor will agree to mail prescription medicines to members who opt to have their prescriptions delivered via mail.

**Evaluation & Award:**

Vendor will provide a current list cost price per unit for the items listed on the attached bid forms, with a percentage mark-up shown and bid price in the appropriate columns. Estimated quantities are for bidding purposes only; more or less may be purchased by the agency.

The award of this contract will be made to lowest bidder(s) that can cover the United States. Should a vendor disclose they cannot cover certain areas of the U.S., then multiple awards will be issued to ensure coverage.

Pricing will apply to all current and future drugs that are offered by the pharmacy and/or may be prescribed.

**Contract Duration:**

This contract will be a twelve (12) month period; with the option to renew two (2), twelve (12) month periods.

**Audit:**

The agency, state auditor's office, and any government agency that may purchase from this contract, may at any time, audit the winning vendor's invoices from the suppliers, to verify cost compared to cost on invoices charged to the agency. The vendor must make all documents available within 2 hours of a notice of intent to audit.

**Alternate Pick Up:** The vendor will be provided, by the West Virginia State Police, the name of one alternate, per retired member (spouse, or other family member ), for pick-up of prescriptions on their behalf; in the event that the members' disability would prohibit his or her travel to a pharmacy. *No other prescriptions other than for the person designated by the West Virginia State Police, will be able to have prescriptions filled under this program.*

**Generic Drugs:** Whenever possible generic drugs will be provided first instead of a name brand drug. Only when a licensed physician provides the pharmacist in writing that a generic drug will not treat the symptom that the medicine was prescribed will a name brand drug be issued. The pharmacy shall provide this information with the billing.

**Quantity of Drugs:** will be a ninety (90) day supply unless other wise directed by a licensed physician.

**Number of Members:** The number of person(s) utilizing this contract should not exceed 250 per contract term; although, this is not a guaranteed minimum or maximum, and more or less may apply.

**Inability to Fill Prescriptions:** If a vendor is unable to fill a prescription, due to the unavailability of the drug, the vendor will immediately contact the Medical Unit of the WV State Police. The Agency will then, on a case by case basis, make arrangements for this prescription to be filled by other contract holders, if applicable, or by other means necessary.

**PIGGYBACKING:**

(Does not apply to construction contracts). *West Virginia Code*, §5A-3-37, provides an opportunity for qualifying vendors to request (at the time of bid) preference for their residency status. 2. **Application is made for 2.5% resident vendor preference for the reason checked:**  
 Bidder is a resident vendor who certifies that, during the life of the contract, on average at least 75% of the employees working on the project being bid are residents of West Virginia who have resided in the state continuously for the two years immediately preceding submission of this bid; or,
3. **Application is made for 2.5% resident vendor preference for the reason checked:**  
 Bidder is a nonresident vendor employing a minimum of one hundred state residents or is a nonresident vendor with an affiliate or subsidiary which maintains its headquarters or principal place of business within West Virginia employing a minimum of one hundred state residents who certifies that, during the life of the contract, on average at least 75% of the employees or Bidder's affiliate's or subsidiary's employees are residents of West Virginia who have resided in the state continuously for the two years immediately preceding submission of this bid; or,
4. **Application is made for 5% resident vendor preference for the reason checked:**  
 Bidder meets either the requirement of both subdivisions (1) and (2) or subdivision (1) and (3) as stated above; or,

Bidder understands if the Secretary of Revenue determines that a Bidder receiving preference has failed to continue to meet the requirements for such preference, the Secretary may order the Director of Purchasing to: (a) reject the bid; or (b) assess a penalty against such Bidder in an amount not to exceed 5% of the bid amount and that such penalty will be paid to the contracting agency or deducted from any unpaid balance on the contract or purchase order.

By submission of this certificate, Bidder agrees to disclose any reasonably requested information to the Purchasing Division and authorizes the Department of Revenue to disclose to the Director of Purchasing appropriate information verifying that Bidder has paid the required business taxes, provided that such information does not contain the amounts of taxes paid nor any other information deemed by the Tax Commissioner to be confidential.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (*West Virginia Code*, §61-5-3), Bidder hereby certifies that this certificate is true and accurate in all respects; and that if a contract is issued to Bidder and if anything contained within this certificate changes during the term of the contract, Bidder will notify the Purchasing Division in writing immediately.

**PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT**

**West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states:** No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

**DEFINITIONS:**

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

**EXCEPTION:** The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
