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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, is available online at www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm and is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
- 14. CONFIDENTIALITY: The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures, and rules. Vendor further agrees to comply with the Confidentiality Policies and Information Security Accountability Requirements, set forth in http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/privacy/noticeConfidentiality.pdf.
- 15. LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, and the West Virginia Insurance Commission. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entitles.
- 16. ANTITRUST: In submitting a bid to any agency for the State of West Virginia, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted the bidder will convey, sell, assign or transfer to the State of West Virginia all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of West Virginia for price fixing and/or unreasonable restraints of trade relating to the particular commodities or services purchased or acquired by the State of West Virginia. Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.

SECTION 1: DEFINITIONS

- A. The "Agency" shall be defined as The Department of Administration, General Services Division, State Capitol Complex, Building 1, Room MB-60, Charleston, West Virginia 25305.
- B. "Contractor" shall be defined as the successful bidder or vendor.
- C. The "Contract" shall be defined as the binding agreement that is entered into between the State of West Virginia and the Contractor to provide the services as herein specified.
- D. "Preventative Maintenance" shall be defined as the scheduled inspections and the replacement of parts, components, and materials on HVAC equipment prior to the failure or wear-out period of the parts, components or materials. The planned inspections and replacements shall be in accordance with the equipment manufacturer's specifications and recommendations. No Preventative Maintenance shall be performed without authorization from the Agency, in the form of an approved release order.
- E. "Corrective Maintenance" shall be defined as maintenance performed on an as-requested basis to correct a malfunction or failure in an HVAC system. No

Corrective Maintenance shall be performed without authorization from the Agency in the form of an approved release order.

- F. "Competent Mechanic" shall be defined as a mechanic, technician, or other employee of Contractor who meets the minimum qualifications necessary to perform work under this Contract as outlined in Section 3.
- G. "Agency Representative" shall be defined as the person designated by the Director of the General Services Division as having authority to act on behalf of the General Services Division.
- H. "Holidays" shall be defined as days designated by W.Va. Code §2-2-1 as legal holidays (i.e. new Year's Day, Martin Luther King's Birthday, President's Day, Memorial Day, West Virginia Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, Lincoln's Day, Election Days, and Christmas Day).
- I. "Testing" shall be defined as a function test upon the completion of ordered Corrective Maintenance, Preventative Maintenance, and Overhaul services to ensure equipment is returned to normal operating mode or to determine if additional repairs are required.
- J. "Overhaul" shall be defined as the detailed inspection of equipment and any maintenance or repair identified in that inspection or prescribed by the manufacturers schedule.
- K. "Cost for Parts" shall be defined as the actual, documented cost of the parts as purchased by the Contractor.

SECTION 2: SCOPE OF WORK

The Contractor shall provide (1) Preventative Maintenance, (2) Corrective Maintenance, (3) Testing, and (4) Overhaul service of the heating, cooling, and air conditioning systems (HVAC) in buildings owned and operated by the West Virginia Department of Administration. Preventative Maintenance, Corrective Maintenance, Testing and Overhaul service must be conducted in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications to keep all equipment operating in accordance with manufacturer's specifications. Examples of work include but are not limited to:

- 1. The annual Overhaul of a variety of chillers up to 1200 ton.
- 2. Troubleshoot a variety of problems in the field with diagnostic devices to return equipment to service.
- 3. Repair or replace broken components of various HVAC units including, but not limited to, motors, fans, blowers, controllers, relays, valves, control wiring, Freon recapture or

- other parts or components of the system, to return heating or cooling function to the building.
- Contractor shall connect to and fully utilize the digital control systems currently used, which include but are not limited to, Tracer, Andover, Metasys and ASI, to monitor equipment and troubleshoot the main components of the HVAC units included in this contract.
- 5. Repair distribution systems of air flow which may be damaged or not functional.

The resulting contract shall not cover the addition of new HVAC equipment to existing HVAC systems which increases the size, type or extent of the system.

2.1 Required Services:

The Contractor shall provide Overhaul, Preventative Maintenance, and Testing services as scheduled by the Agency. Any exception from the established maintenance schedule shall be authorized by the Agency in writing to the Contractor. Failure to obtain written authorization may result in the non-payment for work performed.

The Contractor shall also provide Corrective Maintenance and Testing services on an on-call basis. Contractor must respond to a request and be on site for Corrective Maintenance service calls within 4 hours of notification unless otherwise scheduled by the Agency. The deadline to respond on-site may only be waived or extended by written approval of the Agency.

All Preventative Maintenance, Corrective Maintenance, Testing, and Overhaul Services performed hereunder shall be billed to the Agency at a single hourly rate regardless of the date and time such services are performed.

Labor Warranty: The Contractor will furnish a warranty of 12 months for all labor performed under this Contract.

2.2 Parts:

The Contractor shall provide and install all parts, components and materials to keep equipment operating in accordance with manufacturer's specifications. The Contractor shall supply all tools, tool accessories, personal safety equipment, and supplies necessary to execute the responsibilities of this Contract at no cost to the Agency. Non-reusable parts, components, and materials used in the scope of performing under this Contract shall be supplied by the Contractor at no cost to the Agency. Such items may include grease, cleaning supplies, rags, etc.

Freight: The Contractor shall be responsible for all freight charges incurred as a result of the purchase of replacement parts under this Contract. For Corrective Maintenance service parts orders where expedited delivery is requested and authorized by the Agency,

the Contractor may invoice for freight charges provided that it be given as a pass through cost to the Agency. No mark up shall be permitted for expedited delivery. (See Section 4.2 for more information).

Parts Warranty: The Contractor shall provide a copy of the manufacturer's warranty on parts with the invoice.

2.3 Telephone Service:

Contractor shall maintain a continuous 24-hour telephone service for receipt of maintenance service calls, 365 days a year. Contractor shall provide the Agency with alternative contacts should the 24-hour telephone service become temporarily unavailable.

2.4 Facility Access:

The Agency will permit access to the facilities and will allow the Contractor to utilize shop facilities. Access keys will be provided to the Contractor and inventoried by the Agency. The Contractor must sign for all access keys and return them upon expiration of this Contract.

2.5 Reports

Upon performing Preventative Maintenance, Corrective Maintenance, Testing, or Overhaul Service of HVAC equipment, the Contractor will develop comprehensive reports of findings with recommendations for operational changes, which would reduce costs, extend equipment life and/or improve conditioning of the workplace environment. These reports shall be submitted to the Operations Maintenance Manager after every service call.

The Contractor shall have the ability to interface with the existing control system which utilizes Crystalview diagnostic software. The Contractor shall have the ability to configure set point and current limit. The Contractor shall provide, within 24 hours after requested, a Crystalview report of equipment status, set point and operating log to the Agency. The Contractor shall also provide, within 24 hours after requested, a web-based report, via DDC control system, of real-time energy usage, operational cost comparisons and benchmark performance to the Agency.

2.6 Costs

The Contractor will be responsible for all mileage and travel costs, including travel time, associated with the performance of this Contract.

2.7 Facilities

The list of facilities for which Contractor is required to provide services is attached as Attachment B and specifically incorporated herein by reference. There is no guarantee

that Contractor's services will be required and the Agency reserves the right to not request service in any of the facilities listed on Attachment B. Facilities throughout the state may be added to the list on Attachment B during the life of the Contract only by mutual agreement of both the Agency and the Contractor, through formal change order. The Contractor shall service added buildings under the same terms and conditions contained herein.

SECTION 3: MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

The Contractor shall have the minimum qualifications outlined below to perform Preventative Maintenance, Corrective Maintenance, Testing, and Overhaul services under this Contract. The Contractor shall provide the Agency all documentation of the qualifications in lines 1 and 2 prior to award of the Contract.

- 1. The Contractor shall provide a copy of the Contractor's factory authorization to provide repair and warranty service for Mammoth, Trane, Carrier and York HVAC equipment including chillers up to 1,200 ton capacities (see Attachment B for other potential manufacturers of equipment which could require service during the life of the contract). In lieu of said factory authorization, the Contractor must provide letters of reference for at least three (3) distinct contracts or projects documenting the successful completion of repair and warranty services to HVAC systems of the types and makes currently serving the Agency's facilities and equipment. To indicate sufficient capabilities to manage the size and scope of the Agency's needs, each of the references must be projects or contracts which covered HVAC systems serving a multiple building campus.
- 2. The Contractor shall provide a copy of the Contractor's factory authorization to provide DDC repair service and warranty service for Johnson Controls and/or Trane Tracer hardware and software, the systems currently serving the predominant portion of the Agency's facilities and equipment; in lieu of said factory authorization, the Contractor must provide letters of reference for at least three (3) distinct contracts or projects documenting the successful completion of repair and warranty services to DDC systems of the types and makes currently serving the Agency's facilities and equipment. To indicate sufficient capabilities to manage the size and scope of the Agency's needs, each of the references must be projects or contracts which covered DDC systems serving a multiple building campus.

Work under this Contract may only be performed by a Competent Mechanic who has first provided documentation of certifications and or licensure for the following:

- 1. Electricians- WV Master Electricians License
- 2. Plumbers- WV Master Plumbers License

3. HVAC- EPA 608 Certification and Apprentice Certification or Completion of HVAC Vocational Program prior to January 1, 2006

SECTION 4: ORDERING AND INVOICING

4.1 Release Orders

NO INDIVIDUAL JOB IN EXCESS OF \$25,000.00 (PARIS AND SERVICE) SHALL BE PERMITTED UNDER THIS CONTRACT. Issuance of multiple release orders to circumvent this requirement is strictly prohibited

The Agency shall define the scope of each job to be performed under this Contract. Prior to beginning any work, the Contractor shall be required to provide a cost estimate detailing the intended scope of work, itemized by time and materials to the Agency. If approved, the Agency will issue a written release order to the Contractor. This release order shall have a unique number and reference the master contract number for the master contract. The release order shall indicate the scope of work for the job for which the release is issued. Issuance of the release order to the Contractor shall be considered authorization to begin work. No work other than that specified on the individual release order shall be undertaken by the Contractor.

Changes: Any alteration to a release order must be facilitated by revised release order. No revision shall be issued nor work performed which causes an individual job's total cost to exceed \$25,000.00.

The Contractor shall provide the Agency with valid email addresses and fax numbers to which release orders may be communicated.

4.2 Invoices

Invoices shall be submitted to the Agency for payment monthly (in arrears) and must include the following information:

- Copies of all service orders or inspection reports signed and dated by the Agency Representative (prior to their submittal with invoices for payment).
- 2. Copy of suppliers' price list or invoice for each part, component, or material provided. Freight charges must be in accordance with Section 2. Any expedited delivery charges for Corrective Maintenance service calls must be clearly indicated on the invoice and must be submitted to the Agency as a pass through cost. If third party freight, the Contractor must provide a copy of the freight

invoice in order to receive payment.

- 3. The Contractor's Cost for Parts for each individual part, the markup applied, the total charge being requested, and the supplier's invoice number or page number of the attached price list. Copies of supplier's price list or invoices must match, in the order by which parts appear on the Contractor's invoice.
- Complete address of Contractor, release order number, and master contract number.

Invoices shall be mailed to the following address:

Should the Contractor be requested by the Agency or volunteer to submit invoices electronically, invoices must meet the digital requirements of the WV State Auditor's Office.

SECTION 5: ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

5.1: The relationship of the Contractor to the State of West Virginia shall be that of an independent contractor and no principal-agent relationship or employer-employee relationship is contemplated or created by the parties to this Contract. The Contractor, as an independent contractor, is solely liable for the acts and omissions of its employees and agents. The Contractor will be responsible for selecting, supervising, and compensating any and all individuals employed pursuant to the terms of this Contract. Neither the Contractor nor any employees or sub-contractors of the Contractor shall be deemed to be employees of the State for any purposes whatsoever. The wages and salaries, taxes, withholding payments, penalties, fees, fringe benefits, professional liability insurance premiums, contributions to insurance and pension or other deferred obligations, and licensing fees, etc., and the filing of all necessary documents, forms and returns pertinent to all of the foregoing are the Contractor's responsibility.

The Contractor shall hold harmless the State of West Virginia and the Agency and shall provide the State of West Virginia and the Agency with a defense against any and all claims including but not limited to, the foregoing payments, withholdings, contributions, taxes, social security taxes and employer income tax returns.

The Contractor shall not assign, convey, transfer, sub-contract, or delegate any of its responsibilities and obligations under this Contract to any person, corporation, partnership, association, or entity without express written consent of the Agency. Subcontracted work shall be limited to highly specialized repairs (including, but not limited to, motor rewinding, etc.) that are not within the Contractor's abilities to perform. Subcontracted work of this type shall be billed to the Agency at Contractor's cost and shall have all of the documentation requirements specified herein apply to it when being invoiced.

- 5.2: Indemnification: The Contractor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the State and the Agency, their officers, and employees from and against (1) any claims or losses for services rendered by any subcontractor, person or firm performing or supplying services, materials, or supplies in connection with the performance of the Contract; (2) any claims or losses resulting to any person or entity injured or damaged by the Contractor, its officers, employees, or subcontractors by the publication, translation, reproduction, delivery, performance, use, or disposition of any data used under the Contract in a manner not authorized by the Contract, or by federal or state statutes or regulations; and (3) any failure of the Contractor, its officers, employees or sub-contractors to observe state and federal laws, including but not limited to labor and wage laws.
- 5.3: The Contractor further agrees to comply with the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all other applicable federal, state, and local government regulations.
- 5.4: All work, materials, and equipment shall comply with the rules and regulations of all codes and ordinances of local, state and federal authorities. At a minimum, the services and repairs shall comply with the current editions in effect 30 days prior to receipt of bids of the following codes:
 - 1. National Electric Code (NEC)
 - 2. International Building Code (IBC)
 - 3. International Mechanical Code (IMC)
 - 4. Underwriters Laboratories: Products shall be UL-916-PAZX listed.
 - 5. ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 135-2004 (BACnet)
 - 6. ANSI/EIA/CEA-709.1 (LonTalk)
 - 7. NFPA (National Fire Protection Association)
- 5.5: The Contractor shall procure all necessary permits and licenses to comply with all applicable laws, federal, state, or municipal, along with all regulations, and ordinances of any regulating body.
- 5.6: The Contractor shall pay any applicable sales, use, or personal property taxes arising out of this Contract and the transactions contemplated thereby. Any other taxes levied upon this Contract, the transaction, or the equipment, or services delivered pursuant hereto shall be borne by the Contractor. It is clearly understood that the State of West Virginia is exempt from any taxes regarding performance of the scope of work of this Contract.

SECTION 6: AWARD CRITERIA

The State of West Virginia shall award this Contract according to the following award criteria. Failure to list the hourly rate on the Bid Form will result in disqualification of the Contractor's bid. If the Contractor fails to list the markup % and Multiplier, the parts will be provided at Contractor cost. The amounts of hours and the aggregate expenditure of supplied parts are estimates, used only as a basis for award of the Contract. Actual amounts required during the life of the Contract may be greater or lower.

The following formula shall be used to award the Contract: A+B=C (Total Bid)

Following is a sample bid tabulation for reference only. The award shall be based on the lowest combination of hourly rate total and parts markup total per the attached bid scenario.

NOTE: The multiplier listed below is derived by taking the parts percentage markup and converting it to a multiplier factor. For example, a 25% markup would equal a multiplier of 1.25.



"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
