- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.

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The State of West Virginia, Department of Health and Human Resources (DHHR), Bureau for Public Health (BPII), Office of Laboratory Services (OLS), Newborn Screening (NBS) is seeking vendor quotations for providing a Newborn Screening integrated instrument system per the following specifications and requirements.

PURPOSE

The WV Newborn Screening laboratory has been approved to add Severe Combined Immunodeficiency to the Newborn Screening Panel. The assay is a CDC-developed method and requires the use of the following equipment:

• Agilent Stratagene Mx3005 QPCR System 110V including a notebook computer and Beta Actin Install Plate, or equal.

VENDOR SPECIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

AGREEMENT ADDENDUM FOR SOFTWARE

In the event of conflict between this addendum and the agreement, this addendum shall control:

- DISPUTES Any references in the agreement to arbitration or to the jurisdiction of any court are hereby deleted. Disputes arising out of the agreement shall be presented to the West Virginia Court of Claims.
- HOLD HARMLESS Any provision requiring the Agency to indemnify or hold harmless any party is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- 3. GOVERNING LAW The agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of West Virginia. This provision replaces any references to any other State's governing law.
- 4. TAXES Provisions in the agreement requiring the Agency to pay taxes are deleted. As a State entity, the Agency is exempt from Federal, State, and local taxes and will not pay taxes for any Vendor including individuals, nor will the Agency file any tax returns or reports on behalf of Vendor or any other party.
- 5. PAYMENT Any references to prepayment are deleted. Fees for software licenses, subscriptions, or maintenance are payable annually in advance. Payment for services will be in arrears.
- 6. INTEREST Any provision for interest or charges on late payments is deleted. The Agency has no statutory authority to pay interest or late fees.
- NO WAIVER Any language in the agreement requiring the Agency to waive any rights, claims or defenses is hereby deleted.
- 8. FISCAL YEAR FUNDING Service performed under the agreement may be continued in succeeding fiscal years for the term of the agreement, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being available for this service. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for this service, the agreement shall terminate without penalty on June 30. After that date, the agreement becomes of no effect and is null and void. However, the Agency agrees to use its best efforts to have the amounts contemplated under the agreement included in its budget. Non-appropriation or non-funding shall not be considered an event of default.
- STATUTE OF LIMITATION Any clauses limiting the time in which the Agency may bring suit against the Vendor, lessor, individual, or any
 other party are deleted.
- 10. <u>SIMILAR SERVICES</u> Any provisions limiting the Agency's right to obtain similar services or equipment in the event of default or non-funding during the term of the agreement are hereby deleted.
- FEES OR COSTS The Agency recognizes an obligation to pay attorney's fees or costs only when assessed by a court of competent jurisdiction.

 Any other provision is invalid and considered null and void.
- 12. ASSIGNMENT Notwithstanding any clause to the contrary, the Agency reserves the right to assign the agreement to another State of West Virginia agency, board or commission upon thirty (30) days written notice to the Vendor and Vendor shall obtain the written consent of Agency prior to assigning the agreement.
- 13. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY The Agency, as a State entity, cannot agree to assume the potential liability of a Vendor. Accordingly, any provision limiting the Vendor's liability for direct damages to a certain dollar amount or to the amount of the agreement is hereby deleted. Limitations on special, incidental or consequential damages are acceptable. In addition, any limitation is null and void to the extent that it precludes any action for injury to persons or for damages to personal property.
- 14. RIGHT TO TERMINATE Agency shall have the right to terminate the agreement upon thirty (30) days written notice to Vendor. Agency agrees to pay Vendor for services rendered or goods received prior to the effective date of termination. In such event, Agency will not be entitled to a refund of any software license, subscription of maintenance fees paid.
- 15. TERMINATION CHARGES Any provision requiring the Agency to pay a fixed amount or liquidated damages upon termination of the agreement is hereby deleted. The Agency may only agree to reimburse a Vendor for actual costs incurred or losses sustained during the current fiscal year due to wrongful termination by the Agency prior to the end of any current agreement term.
- 16. RENEWAL Any reference to automatic renewal is deleted. The agreement may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 17. INSURANCE Any provision requiring the Agency to purchase insurance for Vendor's property is deleted. The State of West Virginia is insured through the Board of Risk and Insurance Management, and will provide a certificate of property insurance upon request.
- 18. RIGHT TO NOTICE Any provision for repossession of equipment without notice is hereby deleted. However, the Agency does recognize a right of repossession with notice.
- 19. ACCELERATION Any reference to acceleration of payments in the event of default or non-funding is hereby deleted.

Mx3000P and Mx3005P QPCR System and MxPro QPCR Software Specifications

Agilent is the sole manufacturer of the Mx3000P and Mx3005P QPCR System and MxPro QPCR Software.

High-Performance 96-well Block Thermal System

- The real-time quantitative PCR (QPCR) instrument must support a 96-well plate format that loads from the front of the instrument in landscape orientation. This is the standard for plate orientation and provides the optimal condition for setup and analysis. It also provides optimal interaction with all standard 96 well bench tools such as pipettes, racks, and other consumables.
- The QPCR instrument thermal system must be optimized for 25 μ l reactions and support 10 60 μ l reactions. The instrument should be optimized and tested at the most common reaction volume of 25 μ l but support volumes of 10 60 μ l for flexibility.

- The QPCR instrument must have four or five (4 for Mx3000P, 5 for Mx3005P) narrow band-pass excitation filters and four or five (4 for Mx3000P, 5 for Mx3005P) narrow band-pass emission detection filters to eliminate fluorescence signal contamination during multiplex and which are user-selected at time of QPCR system purchase. The filter design specifically accommodates 4- to 5-color multiplexing without dye interference.
- Excitation and emission detection filters are available for common commercially available dyes including: FAM, SYBR Green, TET, HEX, JOE, VIC, CAL Fluor Orange 560, Cy3, TAMRA, Texas Red,

- ROX, Cy5, Quasar 670, Atto425, and Alexa Fluor 350. A large variety of filters are available to provide the flexibility of dye choice in any QPCR application required by the user.
- The QPCR instrument must use coaxial fiber optic bundles to simultaneously deliver excitation light
 and detect fluorescence emission light from the dye/sample thus minimizing signal loss and

 corrective factors on the data measurements.
