No person can represent more than one bidder.

# 2012 SCHOOL BUS SPECIFICATION ADDENDUM

All school buses shall be set for a maximum speed of 65mph and in the economy mode prior to delivery. County Transportation Directors may apply for a waiver to the West Virginia Department of Education's Executive Director of School Transportation.

Gear ratios shall be determined for the most economical mode and verified with the West Virginia Department of Education's Executive Director of School Transportation.

A maximum idle time shall be set at 10 minutes.

### BRAKES

- B. ABS automatic traction control system shall be standard on units with air brakes
- B. 1. d.Be protected by a desiccant typed air dryer, with an ADIP or equal spin-on replaceable filter.
- B.2.g. A Schrader valve to charge the school bus air system in the event of a compressor failure shall be provided
  - h. Park brake release shall not be affected by any electrical failure.
  - i.. Have at least 7" X 16 1/2" brake blocks.
  - j.. Be equipped with MGM long stroke welded clevis air chambers or equivalent.

Two metal compartments of adequate strength and capacity for storage of tire chains, tow chains, and such tools as may be necessary for minor repairs shall be provided. Such storage compartment shall The dimensions of this compartment shall be be located outside passenger compartment. approximately 25" long, 16" wide and 12" high, mounted below the floor.

# WINDSHIELD AND WINDOWS

F. Latch shall be designed to latch positively and securely.

### WIRING

There shall be a manual noise suppression switch installed in the control panel. The switch shall be labeled and alternately colored. This switch shall be an on/off type and shall not be momentary type that de-activates body equipment that produces noise, including at least, the AM/FM radio, heaters, air conditioners, fans and defrosters. This switch shall not de-activate safety systems, such as windshield wipers or lighting systems.

# **PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT**

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

**EXCEPTION:** The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (West Virginia Code §61-5-3), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.

# SBUS12 Question(s) and Answer(s)

### Question #1:

As stated on page 69 of the bid there are actually two classifications for the Type A and two classifications for the Type B buses depending on the GVWR of the vehicle. However on price page 74 the Type B does not limit the bid to a B1 or B2 but the Type A limits the bid to a Type A1 with no provision to bid a Type A2. Our request is that the Type A1 on the bid price page be changed from Type A1 to Type A with no limitation of A1 or A2. This change would pertain to both the 24 and 30 passenger Type A buses.

### 2012 SCHOOL BUS SPECIFICATION ADDENDUM

All school buses shall be set for a maximum speed of 65mph and in the economy mode prior to delivery. County Transportation Directors may apply for a waiver to the West Virginia Department of Education's Executive Director of School Transportation.

Gear ratios shall be determined for the most economical mode and verified with the West Virginia Department of Education's Executive Director of School Transportation.

A maximum idle time shall be set at 10 minutes.
