INSTRUCTIONS TO VENDORS SUBMITTING BIDS

- 1. REVIEW DOCUMENTS THOROUGHLY: The attached documents contain a solicitation for bids. Please read these instructions and all documents attached in their entirety. These instructions provide critical information about requirements that if overlooked could lead to disqualification of a Vendor's bid. All bids must be submitted in accordance with the provisions contained in these instructions and the Solicitation. Failure to do so may result in disqualification of Vendor's bid.
- 2. MANDATORY TERMS: The Solicitation may contain mandatory provisions identified by the use of the words "must," "will," and "shall." Failure to comply with a mandatory term in the Solicitation will result in bid disqualification.

3. PREBID MEETING: The item identified below shall apply to this Solicitation.

All Vendors submitting a bid must attend the mandatory pre-bid meeting. Failure to attend the mandatory pre-bid meeting shall result in disqualification of the Vendor's bid. No one person attending the pre-bid meeting may represent more than one Vendor.

An attendance sheet provided at the pre-bid meeting shall serve as the official document verifying attendance. The State will not accept any other form of proof or documentation to verify attendance. Any person attending the pre-bid meeting on behalf of a Vendor must list on the attendance sheet his or her name and the name of the Vendor he or she is representing. Additionally, the person attending the pre-bid meeting should include the Vendor's E-Mail address, phone number, and Fax number on the attendance sheet. It is the Vendor's responsibility to locate the attendance sheet and provide the required

information. Failure to complete the attendance sheet as required may result in disqualification of Vendor's bid.

All Vendors should arrive prior to the starting time for the pre-bid. Vendors who arrive after the starting time but prior to the end of the pre-bid will be permitted to sign in, but are charged with knowing all matters discussed at the pre-bid.

Questions submitted at least five business days prior to a scheduled pre-bid will be discussed at the pre-bid meeting if possible. Any discussions or answers to questions at the pre-bid meeting are preliminary in nature and are non-binding. Official and binding answers to questions will be published in a written addendum to the Solicitation prior to bid opening.

4. VENDOR QUESTION DEADLINE: Vendors may submit questions relating to this Solicitation to the Purchasing Division. Questions must be submitted in writing. All questions must be submitted on or before the date listed below and to the address listed below in order to be considered. A written response will be published in a Solicitation addendum if a response is possible and appropriate. Non-written discussions, conversations, or questions and answers regarding this Solicitation are preliminary in nature and are non-binding.

Only information issued in writing and added to the Solicitation by an official written addendum by the Purchasing Division is binding.

Vendor should acknowledge receipt of all addenda issued with this Solicitation by completing an Addendum Acknowledgment Form, a copy of which is included herewith. Failure to acknowledge addenda may result in bid disqualification. The addendum acknowledgement should be submitted with the bid to expedite document processing.
- BID FORMATTING: Vendor should type or electronically enter the information onto its bid to prevent errors in the evaluation. Failure to type or electronically enter the information may result in bid disqualification.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT: Issuance of a Purchase Order signed by the Purchasing Division

 acceptance of this Contract made by and between the State of West Virginia and the Vendor. Vendor's
 signature on its bid signifies Vendor's agreement to be bound by and accept the terms and conditions
 contained in this Contract.
- 2. DEFINITIONS: As used in this Solicitation / Contract, the following terms shall have the meanings attributed to them below. Additional definitions may be found in the specifications included with this Solicitation / Contract.
 - 2.1 "Agency" or "Agencies" means the agency, board, commission, or other entity of the State of West Virginia that is identified on the first page of the Solicitation or any other public entity seeking to procure goods or services under this Contract.
 - 2.2 "Contract" means the binding agreement that is entered into between the State and the Vendor to provide the goods and services requested in the Solicitation.
 - 2.3 "Director" means the Director of the West Virginia Department of Administration, Purchasing Division.
 - 2.4 "Purchasing Division" means the West Virginia Department of Administration, Purchasing Division.
 - 2.5 "Purchase Order" means the document signed by the Agency and the Purchasing Division, and approved as to form by the Attorney General, that identifies the Vendor as the successful bidder and Contract holder.
 - 2.6 "Solicitation" means the official solicitation published by the Purchasing Division and identified by number on the first page thereof.
 - 2.7 "State" means the State of West Virginia and/or any of its agencies, commissions, boards, etc. as context requires.
 - 2.8 "Vendor" or "Vendors" means any entity submitting a bid in response to the Solicitation, the entity that has been selected as the lowest responsible bidder, or the entity that has been awarded the Contract as context requires.

Renewal Term: This Contract may be renewed upon the mutual written consent of the Agency, and the Vendor, with approval of the Purchasing Division and the Attorney General's office (Attorney General approval is as to form only). Any request for renewal must be submitted to the Purchasing Division Director thirty (30) days prior to the expiration date of the initial contract term or appropriate renewal term. A Contract renewal shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of the original contract. Renewal of this Contract is limited to 2 successive one (1) year periods. Automatic renewal of this Contract is prohibited. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Purchasing Division approval is not required on agency delegated or exempt purchases. Attorney General approval may be required for vendor terms and conditions.

Reasonable Time Extension: At the sole discretion of the Purchasing Division Director, and with approval from the Attorney General's office (Attorney General approval is as to form only), this Contract may be extended for a reasonable time after the initial Contract term or after any renewal term as may be necessary to obtain a new contract or renew this Contract. Any reasonable time extension shall not exceed twelve (12) months. Vendor may avoid a reasonable time extension by providing the Purchasing Division Director with written notice of Vendor's desire to terminate this Contract 30 days prior to the expiration of the then current term. During any reasonable time extension period, the Vendor may terminate this Contract for any reason upon giving the Purchasing Division Director 30 days written notice. Automatic extension of this Contract is prohibited. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Purchasing Division approval is not required on agency delegated or exempt purchases, but Attorney General approval may be required.

- 4. NOTICE TO PROCEED: Vendor shall begin performance of this Contract immediately upon receiving notice to proceed unless otherwise instructed by the Agency. Unless otherwise specified, the fully executed Purchase Order will be considered notice to proceed
- 5. QUANTITIES: The quantities required under this Contract shall be determined in accordance with the category that has been identified as applicable to this Contract below.
 - Open End Contract: Quantities listed in this Solicitation are approximations only, based on estimates supplied by the Agency. It is understood and agreed that the Contract shall cover the quantities actually ordered for delivery during the term of the Contract, whether more or less than the quantities shown.
 - | Service: The scope of the service to be provided will be more clearly defined in the specifications included herewith.
 - Combined Service and Goods: The scope of the service and deliverable goods to be provided will be more clearly defined in the specifications included herewith.
 - One Time Purchase: This Contract is for the purchase of a set quantity of goods that are identified in the specifications included herewith. Once those items have been delivered, no additional goods may be procured under this Contract without an appropriate change order approved by the Vendor, Agency, Purchasing Division, and Attorney General's office.
- 6. PRICING: The pricing set forth herein is firm for the life of the Contract, unless specified elsewhere within this Solicitation/Contract by the State. A Vendor's inclusion of price adjustment provisions in its bid, without an express authorization from the State in the Solicitation to do so, may result in bid disqualification.
- 7. EMERGENCY PURCHASES: The Purchasing Division Director may authorize the Agency to purchase goods or services in the open market that Vendor would otherwise provide under this Contract if those goods or services are for immediate or expedited delivery in an emergency. Emergencies shall include, but are not limited to, delays in transportation or an unanticipated increase in the volume of work. An emergency purchase in the open market, approved by the Purchasing Division Director, shall not constitute of breach of this Contract and shall not entitle the Vendor to any form of compensation or damages. This provision does not excuse the State from fulfilling its obligations under a One Time Purchase contract.
- 8. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS: All of the items checked below must be provided to the Purchasing Division by the Vendor as specified below.

The apparent successful Vendor shall also furnish proof of any additional licenses or certifications contained in the specifications prior to Contract award regardless of whether or not that requirement is listed above.

- 9. LITIGATION BOND: The Director reserves the right to require any Vendor that files a protest of an award to submit a litigation bond in the amount equal to one percent of the lowest bid submitted or \$5,000, whichever is greater. The entire amount of the bond shall be forfeited if the hearing officer determines that the protest was filed for frivolous or improper purpose, including but not limited to, the purpose of harassing, causing unnecessary delay, or needless expense for the Agency. All litigation bonds shall be made payable to the Purchasing Division. In lieu of a bond, the protester may submit a cashier's check or certified check payable to the Purchasing Division. Cashier's or certified checks will be deposited with and held by the State Treasurer's office. If it is determined that the protest has not been filed for frivolous or improper purpose, the bond or deposit shall be returned in its entirety.
- 10. ALTERNATES: Any model, brand, or specification listed herein establishes the acceptable level of quality only and is not intended to reflect a preference for, or in any way favor, a particular brand or vendor. Vendors may bid alternates to a listed model or brand provided that the alternate is at least equal to the model or brand and complies with the required specifications. The equality of any alternate being bid shall be determined by the State at its sole discretion. Any Vendor bidding an alternate model or brand should clearly identify the alternate items in its bid and should include manufacturer's specifications, industry literature, and/or any other relevant documentation demonstrating the equality of the alternate items. Failure to provide information for alternate items may be grounds for rejection of a Vendor's bid.
- 11. EXCEPTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS: The Solicitation contains the specifications that shall form the basis of a contractual agreement. Vendor shall clearly mark any exceptions, clarifications, or

other proposed modifications in its bid. Exceptions to, clarifications of, or modifications of a requirement or term and condition of the Solicitation may result in bid disqualification.

This clause shall in no way be considered exclusive and shall not limit the State or Agency's right to pursue any other available remedy.

- 13. ACCEPTANCE/REJECTION: The State may accept or reject any bid in whole, or in part. Vendor's signature on its bid signifies acceptance of the terms and conditions contained in the Solicitation and Vendor agrees to be bound by the terms of the Contract, as reflected in the Purchase Order, upon receipt.
- 14. REGISTRATION: Prior to Contract award, the apparent successful Vendor must be properly registered with the West Virginia Purchasing Division and must have paid the \$125 fee if applicable.
- 15. COMMUNICATION LIMITATIONS: In accordance with West Virginia Code of State Rules §148-1-6.6, communication with the State of West Virginia or any of its employees regarding this Solicitation during the solicitation, bid, evaluation or award periods, except through the Purchasing Division, is strictly prohibited without prior Purchasing Division approval. Purchasing Division approval for such communication is implied for all agency delegated and exempt purchases.
- 16. FUNDING: This Contract shall continue for the term stated herein, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise made available, this Contract becomes void and of no effect beginning on July 1 of the fiscal year for which funding has not been appropriated or otherwise made available.
- 17. PAYMENT: Payment in advance is prohibited under this Contract. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services. The Vendor shall submit invoices, in arrears, to the Agency at the address on the face of the purchase order labeled "Invoice To."
- 18. UNIT PRICE: Unit prices shall prevail in cases of a discrepancy in the Vendor's bid.
- 19. DELIVERY: All quotations are considered freight on board destination ("F.O.B. destination") unless alternate shipping terms are clearly identified in the bid. Vendor's listing of shipping terms that contradict the shipping terms expressly required by this Solicitation may result in bid disqualification.
- 20. INTEREST: Interest attributable to late payment will only be permitted if authorized by the West Virginia Code. Presently, there is no provision in the law for interest on late payments.
- 21. PREFERENCE: Vendor Preference may only be granted upon written request and only in accordance with the West Virginia Code § 5A-3-37 and the West Virginia Code of State Rules. A Resident Vendor Certification form has been attached hereto to allow Vendor to apply for the preference. Vendor's

- failure to submit the Resident Vendor Certification form with its bid will result in denial of Vendor Preference. Vendor Preference does not apply to construction projects.
- 22. SMALL, WOMEN-OWNED, OR MINORITY-OWNED BUSINESSES: For any solicitations publicly advertised for bid on or after July 1, 2012, in accordance with West Virginia Code §5A-3-37(a)(7) and W. Va. CSR § 148-22-9, any non-resident vendor certified as a small, women-owned, or minority-owned business under W. Va. CSR § 148-22-9 shall be provided the same preference made available to any resident vendor. Any non-resident small, women-owned, or minority-owned business must identify itself as such in writing, must submit that writing to the Purchasing Division with its bid, and must be properly certified under W. Va. CSR § 148-22-9 prior to submission of its bid to receive the preferences made available to resident vendors. Preference for a non-resident small, women-owned, or minority owned business shall be applied in accordance with W. Va. CSR § 148-22-9.
- 23. TAXES: The Vendor shall pay any applicable sales, use, personal property or any other taxes arising out of this Contract and the transactions contemplated thereby. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 24. CANCELLATION: The Purchasing Division Director reserves the right to cancel this Contract immediately upon written notice to the vendor if the materials or workmanship supplied do not conform to the specifications contained in the Contract. The Purchasing Division Director may cancel any purchase or Contract upon 30 days written notice to the Vendor in accordance with West Virginia Code of State Rules § 148-1-7.16.2.
- 25. WAIVER OF MINOR IRREGULARITIES: The Director reserves the right to waive minor irregularities in bids or specifications in accordance with West Virginia Code of State Rules § 148-1-4.6.
- 26, TIME: Time is of the essence with regard to all matters of time and performance in this Contract.
- 27. APPLICABLE LAW: This Contract is governed by and interpreted under West Virginia law without giving effect to its choice of law principles. Any information provided in specification manuals, or any other source, verbal or written, which contradicts or violates the West Virginia Constitution, West Virginia Code or West Virginia Code of State Rules is void and of no effect.
- 28. COMPLIANCE: Vendor shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances. By submitting a bid, Vendors acknowledge that they have reviewed, understand, and will comply with all applicable law.
- 29. PREVAILING WAGE: On any contract for the construction of a public improvement, Vendor and any subcontractors utilized by Vendor shall pay a rate or rates of wages which shall not be less than the fair minimum rate or rates of wages (prevailing wage), as established by the West Virginia Division of Code 21-5A-1 et seq. and available Labor under West Virginia 88 at http://www.sos.wv.gov/administrative-law/wagerates/Pages/default.aspx. Vendor shall be responsible for ensuring compliance with prevailing wage requirements and determining when prevailing wage

- requirements are applicable. The required contract provisions contained in West Virginia Code of State Rules § 42-7-3 are specifically incorporated herein by reference.
- 30. ARBITRATION: Any references made to arbitration contained in this Contract, Vendor's bid, or in any American Institute of Architects documents pertaining to this Contract are hereby deleted, void, and of no effect.
- 31. MODIFICATIONS: This writing is the parties' final expression of intent. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Contract to the contrary, no modification of this Contract shall be binding without mutual written consent of the Agency, and the Vendor, with approval of the Purchasing Division and the Attorney General's office (Attorney General approval is as to form only). No Change shall be implemented by the Vendor until such time as the Vendor receives an approved written change order from the Purchasing Division.
- 32. WAIVER: The failure of either party to insist upon a strict performance of any of the terms or provision of this Contract, or to exercise any option, right, or remedy herein contained, shall not be construed as a waiver or a relinquishment for the future of such term, provision, option, right, or remedy, but the same shall continue in full force and effect. Any waiver must be expressly stated in writing and signed by the waiving party.
- 33. SUBSEQUENT FORMS: The terms and conditions contained in this Contract shall supersede any and all subsequent terms and conditions which may appear on any form documents submitted by Vendor to the Agency or Purchasing Division such as price lists, order forms, invoices, sales agreements, or maintenance agreements, and includes internet websites or other electronic documents. Acceptance or use of Vendor's forms does not constitute acceptance of the terms and conditions contained thereon.
- 34. ASSIGNMENT: Neither this Contract nor any monies due, or to become due hereunder, may be assigned by the Vendor without the express written consent of the Agency, the Purchasing Division, the Attorney General's office (as to form only), and any other government agency or office that may be required to approve such assignments. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Purchasing Division approval may or may not be required on certain agency delegated or exempt purchases.
- 35. WARRANTY: The Vendor expressly warrants that the goods and/or services covered by this Contract will: (a) conform to the specifications, drawings, samples, or other description furnished or specified by the Agency; (b) be merchantable and fit for the purpose intended; and (c) be free from defect in material and workmanship.
- 36. STATE EMPLOYEES: State employees are not permitted to utilize this Contract for personal use and the Vendor is prohibited from permitting or facilitating the same.
- 37. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the Vendor files for bankruptcy protection, the State of West Virginia may deem this Contract null and void, and terminate this Contract without notice.

- 38. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, is available online at http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.html and is hereby made part of the agreement provided that the Agency meets the definition of a Covered entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the Vendor.
- 39. CONFIDENTIALITY: The Vendor agrees that it will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the Agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the Agency's policies, procedures, and rules. Vendor further agrees to comply with the Confidentiality Policies and Information Security Accountability Requirements, set forth in http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/privacy/default.html.
- 40. DISCLOSURE: Vendor's response to the Solicitation and the resulting Contract are considered public documents and will be disclosed to the public in accordance with the laws, rules, and policies governing the West Virginia Purchasing Division. Those laws include, but are not limited to, the Freedom of Information Act found in West Virginia Code § 29B-1-1 et seq.

If a Vendor considers any part of its bid to be exempt from public disclosure, Vendor must so indicate by specifically identifying the exempt information, identifying the exemption that applies, providing a detailed justification for the exemption, segregating the exempt information from the general bid information, and submitting the exempt information as part of its bid but in a segregated and clearly identifiable format. Failure to comply with the foregoing requirements will result in public disclosure of the Vendor's bid without further notice. A Vendor's act of marking all or nearly all of its bid as exempt is not sufficient to avoid disclosure and WILL NOT BE HONORED. Vendor's act of marking a bid or any part thereof as "confidential" or "proprietary" is not sufficient to avoid disclosure and WILL NOT BE HONORED. In addition, a legend or other statement indicating that all or substantially all of the bid is exempt from disclosure is not sufficient to avoid disclosure and WILL NOT BE HONORED. 41. LICENSING: In accordance with West Virginia Code of State Rules §148-1-6.1.7, Vendor must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, West Virginia Insurance Commission, or any other state agency or political subdivision. - 42. - 43. VENDOR CERTIFICATIONS: By signing its bid or entering into this Contract, Vendor certifies (1) that its bid was made without prior understanding, agreement, or connection with any corporation, firm, limited liability company, partnership, person or entity submitting a bid for the same material, supplies, equipment or services; (2) that its bid is in all respects fair and without collusion or fraud; (3) that this Contract is accepted or entered into without any prior understanding, agreement, or connection to any other entity that could be considered a violation of law; and (4) that it has reviewed this RFQ in its entirety; understands the requirements, terms and conditions, and other information contained herein. Vendor's signature on its bid also affirms that neither it nor its representatives have any interest, nor shall acquire any interest, direct or indirect, which would compromise the performance of its services hereunder. Any such interests shall be promptly presented in detail to the Agency.

The individual signing this bid on behalf of Vendor certifies that he or she is authorized by the Vendor to execute this bid or any documents related thereto on Vendor's behalf; that he or she is authorized to bind the Vendor in a contractual relationship; and that, to the best of his or her knowledge, the Vendor has properly registered with any State agency that may require registration.

- 44. PURCHASING CARD ACCEPTANCE: The State of West Virginia currently utilizes a Purchasing Card program, administered under contract by a banking institution, to process payment for goods and services. The Vendor must accept the State of West Virginia's Purchasing Card for payment of all orders under this Contract unless the box below is checked.
 - Vendor is not required to accept the State of West Virginia's Purchasing Card as payment for all goods and services.
- 45. VENDOR RELATIONSHIP: The relationship of the Vendor to the State shall be that of an independent contractor and no principal-agent relationship or employer-employee relationship is contemplated or created by this Contract. The Vendor as an independent contractor is solely liable for the acts and omissions of its employees and agents. Vendor shall be responsible for selecting, supervising, and compensating any and all individuals employed pursuant to the terms of this Solicitation and resulting contract. Neither the Vendor, nor any employees or subcontractors of the Vendor, shall be deemed to be employees of the State for any purpose whatsoever. Vendor shall be exclusively responsible for payment of employees and contractors for all wages and salaries, taxes, withholding payments, penalties, fees, fringe benefits, professional liability insurance premiums, contributions to insurance and pension, or other deferred compensation plans, including but not limited to, Workers' Compensation and Social Security obligations, licensing fees, etc. and the filing of all necessary documents, forms and returns pertinent to all of the foregoing. Vendor shall hold harmless the

State, and shall provide the State and Agency with a defense against any and all claims including, but not limited to, the foregoing payments, withholdings, contributions, taxes, Social Security taxes, and employer income tax returns.

- 46. INDEMNIFICATION: The Vendor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the State and the Agency, their officers, and employees from and against: (1) Any claims or losses for services rendered by any subcontractor, person, or firm performing or supplying services, materials, or supplies in connection with the performance of the Contract; (2) Any claims or losses resulting to any person or entity injured or damaged by the Vendor, its officers, employees, or subcontractors by the publication, translation, reproduction, delivery, performance, use, or disposition of any data used under the Contract in a manner not authorized by the Contract, or by Federal or State statutes or regulations; and (3) Any failure of the Vendor, its officers, employees, or subcontractors to observe State and Federal laws including, but not limited to, labor and wage and hour laws.
- 47. PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT: In accordance with West Virginia Code § 5A-3-10a, all Vendors are required to sign, notarize, and submit the Purchasing Affidavit stating that neither the Vendor nor a related party owe a debt to the State in excess of \$1,000. The affidavit must be submitted prior to award, but should be submitted with the Vendor's bid. A copy of the Purchasing Affidavit is included herewith.
- 48. ADDITIONAL AGENCY AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT USE: This Contract may be utilized by and extends to other agencies, spending units, and political subdivisions of the State of West Virginia; county, municipal, and other local government bodies; and school districts ("Other Government Entities"). This Contract shall be extended to the aforementioned Other Government Entities on the same prices, terms, and conditions as those offered and agreed to in this Contract. If the Vendor does not wish to extend the prices, terms, and conditions of its bid and subsequent contract to the Other Government Entities, the Vendor must clearly indicate such refusal in its bid. A refusal to extend this Contract to the Other Government Entities shall not impact or influence the award of this Contract in any manner.
- 49. CONFLICT OF INTEREST: Vendor, its officers or members or employees, shall not presently have or acquire any interest, direct or indirect, which would conflict with or compromise the performance of its obligations hereunder. Vendor shall periodically inquire of its officers, members and employees to ensure that a conflict of interest does not arise. Any conflict of interest discovered shall be promptly presented in detail to the Agency.
- 50. REPORTS: Vendor shall provide the Agency and/or the Purchasing Division with the following reports identified by a checked box below:

- 51. BACKGROUND CHECK: In accordance with W. Va. Code § 15-2D-3, the Director of the Division of Protective Services shall require any service provider whose employees are regularly employed on the grounds or in the buildings of the Capitol complex or who have access to sensitive or critical information to submit to a fingerprint-based state and federal background inquiry through the state repository. The service provider is responsible for any costs associated with the fingerprint-based state and federal background inquiry.

- 52. PREFERENCE FOR USE OF DOMESTIC STEEL PRODUCTS: Except when authorized by the Director of the Purchasing Division pursuant to W. Va. Code § 5A-3-56, no contractor may use or supply steel products for a State Contract Project other than those steel products made in the United States. A contractor who uses steel products in violation of this section may be subject to civil penalties pursuant to W. Va. Code § 5A-3-56. As used in this section:
 - a. "State Contract Project" means any erection or construction of, or any addition to, alteration of or other improvement to any building or structure, including, but not limited to, roads or highways, or the installation of any heating or cooling or ventilating plants or other equipment, or the supply of and materials for such projects, pursuant to a contract with the State of West Virginia for which bids were solicited on or after June 6, 2001.
 - b. "Steel Products" means products rolled, formed, shaped, drawn, extruded, forged, cast, fabricated or otherwise similarly processed, or processed by a combination of two or more or such operations, from steel made by the open heath, basic oxygen, electric furnace, Bessemer or other steel making process.

The Purchasing Division Director may, in writing, authorize the use of foreign steel products if:

a. The cost for each contract item used does not exceed one tenth of one percent (.1%) of the total

contract cost or two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00), whichever is greater. For the purposes of this section, the cost is the value of the steel product as delivered to the project; or

- b. The Director of the Purchasing Division determines that specified steel materials are not produced in the United States in sufficient quantity or otherwise are not reasonably available to meet contract requirements.
- 53. PREFERENCE FOR USE OF DOMESTIC ALUMINUM, GLASS, AND STEEL: In Accordance with W. Va. Code § 5-19-1 et seq., and W. Va. CSR § 148-10-1 et seq., for every contract or subcontract, subject to the limitations contained herein, for the construction, reconstruction, alteration, repair, improvement or maintenance of public works or for the purchase of any item of machinery or equipment to be used at sites of public works, only domestic aluminum, glass or steel products shall be supplied unless the spending officer determines, in writing, after the receipt of offers or bids, (1) that the cost of domestic aluminum, glass or steel products is unreasonable or inconsistent with the public interest of the State of West Virginia, (2) that domestic aluminum, glass or steel products are not produced in sufficient quantities to meet the contract requirements, or (3) the available domestic aluminum, glass, or steel do not meet the contract specifications. This provision only applies to public works contracts awarded in an amount more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) or public works contracts that require more than ten thousand pounds of steel products.

The cost of domestic aluminum, glass, or steel products may be unreasonable if the cost is more than twenty percent (20%) of the bid or offered price for foreign made aluminum, glass, or steel products. If the domestic aluminum, glass or steel products to be supplied or produced in a "substantial labor surplus area", as defined by the United States Department of Labor, the cost of domestic aluminum, glass, or steel products may be unreasonable if the cost is more than thirty percent (30%) of the bid or offered price for foreign made aluminum, glass, or steel products.

This preference shall be applied to an item of machinery or equipment, as indicated above, when the item is a single unit of equipment or machinery manufactured primarily of aluminum, glass or steel, is part of a public works contract and has the sole purpose or of being a permanent part of a single public works project. This provision does not apply to equipment or machinery purchased by a spending unit for use by that spending unit and not as part of a single public works project.

All bids and offers including domestic aluminum, glass or steel products that exceed bid or offer prices including foreign aluminum, glass or steel products after application of the preferences provided in this provision may be reduced to a price equal to or lower than the lowest bid or offer price for foreign aluminum, glass or steel products plus the applicable preference. If the reduced bid or offer prices are made in writing and supersede the prior bid or offer prices, all bids or offers, including the reduced bid or offer prices, will be reevaluated in accordance with this rule.

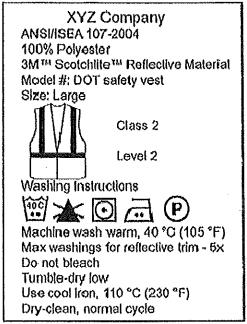
- 1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE: The West Virginia Purchasing Division is soliciting bids on behalf of the West Virginia Division of Highways (WVDOH) and any other state agency that desires to utilize this contract to establish an open-end contract for Adopt-A-Highway Safety Vests.
- 2. **DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions.
 - 2.1 "Desired Item" or "Contract Items" means the list of items identified in Section III, Subsection 1 below.
 - 2.2 "Pricing Pages" means the schedule of prices, estimated order quantity, and totals attached hereto as Exhibit A and used to evaluate the RFQ.
 - 2.3 "RFQ" means the official RFQ published by the Purchasing Division and identified as 8513C2019.
 - 2.4 "Agency" or "Agencies" means WVDOH.
 - 2.5 "Contract" means the binding agreement that is entered into between the State and the Vendor to provide the Contract Items as specified herein.
 - 2.6 "Purchasing Division" means the West Virginia Department of Administration, Purchasing Division.
 - 2.7 "State" means the State of West Virginia and/or any of its agencies, commissions, boards, etc
 - 2.8 "Vendor" or "Vendors" means the successful bidder(s).

3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

3.1 Contract Items and Mandatory Requirements: Vendor shall provide Agency with the Contract Items listed below on an open-end and continuing basis. Contract Items must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements as shown below.

- 3.1.1 Adopt-a-Highway Safety Vests, various sizes as described herein and described on the pricing page, with and without "ADOPT-A-HWY" lettering, as described herein and indicated on the pricing page.
 - 3.1.1.1 All garments must be manufactured using ANSI-107 accredited laboratory certified background and retroreflective component materials and meet all applicable ANSI-107 mandatory design requirements. The reflective material on all garments shall meet the requirements of ANSI-107 Photometric Performance Level 2. Component materials utilized to manufacture garments for this Contract shall be certified to ANSI-107 by a competent and qualified Accredited Laboratory. Accredited Laboratory certificates of compliance shall be provided.
 - 3.1.1.2 The background material utilized for all garments shall have successfully passed the testing requirements contained within "NFPA (National Fire Protection Association) 701: Standard Methods of Fire Tests for Flame Propagation of Textiles and Films" (latest version as of the Contract advertising date).
 - 3.1.1.3 Except as noted otherwise herein, all exposed vest edges shall be bound with grey nylon tricot or material identical to the background material of the vest. Exposed edges of non-woven polyester vests, if used for the "Adopt-A-Highway" vests, shall not be required to be bound. Plastic type bindings or borders are not acceptable.
 - 3.1.1.4 The retroreflective striping materials used to manufacture all garments supplied as part of this Contract shall be two (2) inches wide.
 - 3.1.1.5 Per ANSI-107, all garments shall include a label including the following information:
 - a. Manufacturer
 - b. ANSI/ISEA 107-XXXX ("XXXX" dependent on the applicable version of the ANSI/ISEA-107 specification as of the Contract advertising date)
 - c. Fabric type
 - d. Model #
 - e. Size
 - f. Pictogram showing garment class and retroreflectivity level
 - g. Care guide and maximum number of cycles

- 3.1.1.6 The manufacturer shall store, prepare, handle, and apply all garment fabrics and retroreflective materials fully in accordance with the garment fabric and retroreflective material supplier's recommendations. The manufacturer shall be responsible for verifying the compatibility of the garment and retroreflective materials to be used together.
- 3.1.1.7 All garments shall be of quality workmanship, comfortable to wear, and shall be free of ragged edges, surface blemishes, loose stitches, uneven seams or any defect which would make the vest unsuitable for their intended use.
- 3.1.1.8 All garments supplied under this Contract within any particular Section (Sections for the purpose of this Contract are defined under Section 4.3) shall vary only in size and presence of the specified lettering (when applicable). All other parameters, such as the specific type background material and reflective striping, shall be the same for all of the garments within the Section.
- 3.1.1.9 The background material used to manufacture all "Adopt-A-Highway" vests supplied as part of this Contract shall be of the manufacturer's choosing. However, the material utilized shall have a maximum weight of 3.7 oz per sq yd. Either solid or mesh

- material will be permitted. The color of the "Adopt-A-Highway" vests shall be Fluorescent red-orange.
- 3.1.1.10 Either sewn-on or heat applied retroreflective striping may be utilized for "Adopt-A-Highway" vests.
- 3.1.1.11 The striping pattern utilized shall be as shown in 3.1.1.13.

 One horizontal, 360 degree stripe shall encircle the torso. One vertical stripe shall join the torso stripe from the front to the back over each shoulder. The minimum clear distance on the back of the vests between the two vertical stripes shall be ten-inches (10").
- 3.1.1.12 These vests shall be manufactured to cover a range of sizes by utilizing side adjustments, options of which are shown in Section 3.1.1.13. The side adjustment method shall utilize hook and loop material. The hook & loop mechanism shall utilize at least two continuous horizontal one (1) inch (minimum) wide strips on each side, to be placed on the underlying face of material. These strips may be either the hook or loop portion of the hook & loop mechanism. The hook & loop adjustment mechanism shall be designed to provide the ability to adjust continuously, not incrementally, over the range of sizes provided in Section 3.1.1.14. The mate(s) on the overlying face of material to the continuous portions of the hook & loop strips described above on the underlying face of material may be either a) continuous one (1) inch (minimum) wide horizontal strips, or b) a single vertical one (1) inch (minimum) wide strip which spans over both of the horizontal strips on the opposite face of material. See Section 3.1.1.13 for drawings depicting these optional designs.
- 3.1.1.13 Manufacturing Detail Drawing:

3.1.1.14 "Adopt-A-Highway" vests shall be manufactured according to the following sizing chart and shall be available in all of the sizes listed:

<u>Size</u>	Chest Measurement
M-2XL	42" - 56"
3XL-4XL	58" - 64"

Note, the sample garment provided by the Vendor per Section 4.4.2.1 shall be checked against the above sizing chart by determining the measurement completely around the vest when adjusted to the minimum and maximum sizes allowed by the side adjustments.

- 3.1.1.15 These vests shall measure a minimum of 16 inches at the shoulder (outside of shoulder straight across to outside of shoulder) and shall be a minimum of 24 inches in length (measured from the top of the back of the neck opening).
- 3.1.1.16 The front closure provided for these vests may be vertical hook and loop as shown in Section 3.1.1.13 or may be manufactured with a front non-conductive zipper closure. If hook & loop is used, no horizontal strips shall be used, and the hook & loop mechanism shall be a minimum of one (1) inch wide by six (6) inches long.
- into the vests indicated as requiring such on the Pricing Pages. The lettering shall be made up of 1.5 inch tall letters. The font style used shall be Series B Highway Font. The text on these vests shall read "ADOPT-A-HWY". This text shall be identical in size, shape, and appearance to the drawing included as part of these specifications. - 3.1.1.18 Lettering shall be screened on the back of the vests, such that the lettering is centered horizontally between the two vertical shoulder stripes. Vertically, the lettering shall be placed such that there is a 1 inch (+ ½" / 0") clearance between the bottom of the letters and the top of the horizontal reflective stripe. All silk screened text provided on vests supplied as part of this Contract

shall be free of rough edges, smearing, running, splotches, or other visual defects.

3.1.1.19 These vests shall be in full compliance with the ANSI-107 square inches of background material requirement after the above specified lettering is applied.

4. CONTRACT AWARD:

- 4.1 Contract Award: The Contract is intended to provide Agencies with a purchase price on all Contract Items. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides the Contract Items meeting the required specifications for the lowest overall total cost as shown on the Pricing Pages.

It is recommended that the Vendor mail the items described below as soon as possible after the items have been requested in order to allow time for these items to be sent again if necessary and delivered prior to the deadline previously described (based on the date of the initial request).

- 4.4.2.1 Sample garment A sample of the garment to be provided by the Vendor shall be provided. Specific details are as follows: Size M-2XL vest with screened logo. The logo shall not be required to read "ADOPT-A-HWY"; however, the logo shall be silk screened in black using the same material the Vendor intends to use for the "ADOPT-A-HWY" logo and shall be placed in the same general location as specified previously herein. All other characteristics of the vest shall be a completely accurate representation of the vests that the Vendor intends to supply if awarded the Contract.
- 4.4.2.2 Accredited Laboratory ANSI-107 certificate of compliance for the background material to be used in manufacturing the garment,
- 4.4.2.3 Accredited Laboratory ANSI-107 Performance Level 2 certificate of compliance for the retroreflective striping material to be used in manufacturing the garment.

- 4.4.2.4 "NFPA (National Fire Protection Association) 701: Standard Methods of Fire Tests for Flame Propagation of Textiles and Films" certificate of compliance for the background material to be used in manufacturing the garment.
- 4.4.2.5 Manufacturer self-certification for the completed garment. The content and format of this self-certification shall be as described in the ANSI-107 specification.
- 4.4.3 All sample garments and documentation will be reviewed for compliance with the Contract specifications. The results of these reviews will be documented.
- 4.4.4 If necessary, the WVDOH will request additional garment samples and certifications from additional Vendors in order to determine the Vendor within each Section that can provide the garments requested at the lowest price taking into account any requested in-state Vendor preferences.

5. ORDERING AND PAYMENT:

- 5.1 Ordering: Vendor shall accept orders by regular mail, facsimile, e-mail, or any other written forms of communication. Vendor may, but is not required to, accept on-line orders through a secure internet ordering portal/website. If Vendor has the ability to accept on-line orders, it should include in its response a brief description of how Agencies may utilize the on-line ordering system. Any on-line ordering system must have the capability to restrict prices and available items to conform to the Catalog originally submitted with this RFQ. 6. DELIVERY AND RETURN:

- 6.1 Delivery Time: Delivery Time: Vendor shall deliver standard orders within thirty (30) Calendar Days after orders are received.
- 6.2 Late Delivery: The originating Agency purchasing organization placing any order under this Contract must be notified in writing if orders will be delayed for any reason. Any delay in delivery that could cause harm to an Agency will be grounds for:
 - (a) cancellation of the delayed order and obtaining the items ordered from a third party, or
 - (b) imposing of a daily (per Calendar Day) penalty at the Agency's discretion for each Calendar Day beyond the thirty (30) Calendar Days specified, until all items on the order are received in full. This penalty shall be assessed by subtracting the penalty from the original total value of the Blanket Release Order. The original total amount of the Blanket Release Order shall be substituted for the "Original Contract Amount" when using this Table.

Any Agency seeking to obtain items from a third party under this provision must first obtain approval of the Purchasing Division.

- 6.3 Delivery Payment/Risk of Loss: Standard order delivery shall be F.O.B. destination to the Agency's location. Vendor shall include the cost of standard order delivery charges in its bid pricing/discount and is not permitted to charge the Agency separately for such delivery.
- 6.4 Return of Unacceptable Items: Items that Agency deems unacceptable shall be returned to Vendor at Vendor's expense and with no restocking charge. The Vendor shall make arrangements for pickup within five (5) days of being notified that items are unacceptable. If the original packaging cannot be utilized for the return, Vendor will supply the Agency with appropriate return packaging upon request. All returns of unacceptable items shall be F.O.B. the Agency's location. The returned Items shall be replaced by the Vendor. Note, the provisions of Sections 6.1 and 6.2 shall remain in effect until the replacement Items are received by the Agency.

- 6.5 Return Due to Agency Error: Items ordered in error by the Agency will be returned for credit within 30 days of receipt, F.O.B. Vendor's location. Vendor shall also provide reports, upon request, showing the items purchased during the term of this Contract, the quantity purchased for each of those items, and the total value of purchases for each of those items. Failure to supply such reports may be grounds for cancellation of this Contract.

Vendor Inquiries which have been submitted for this RFQ and answers are as follows:

Question #1: There are some references to the Manufacturing Detail Drawing of the Adopt-A-Highway Vests in section 3.1.1.13. However, there appears to be no detail drawing. Is it possible to get a copy of that drawing so we can send it to our vendor to make sure we will be bidding on the vests you intend to purchase?

Answer #1: The detail drawing was inadvertently left out of the RFQ. The drawing is attached to this addendum.

Question #2: What is the previous amount paid for this Item/contract?

Answer #2: Pricing for the most recent contract for Adop-A-Highway vests can be found on Contract Number 859C2O10.

Question #3: Can a minimum order quantity be set?

Answer #3: The RFQ specifications do not set a minimum order size. However, Vendors are advised that typically these vests are ordered by the ten WVDOH District storerooms. The storerooms do not place multiple orders for these vests over the course of the year. Typically, the storerooms attempt to place an order in the spring to cover their needs for the entire season. In some cases, this order may need to supplement this order with one additional smaller one during the season.

Question #4: Per clause 4.2, can you please forward a Microsoft Excel doc for the Pricing Pages so we can prepare the pricing electronically?

Answer #4: The Excel electronic version of the pricing page has been posted along with the electronic version of the RFQ on the state purchasing bulletin website.

Question #5: Section 3.1.1.2 states the background fabric shall meet the NFPA 701. The updated ANSI 107 – 2010 does not recognize the NFPA 701. The ANSI 107-2004 standard does. Please let us know if WVDOH still wants the vest background fabric to meet the NFPA 701 requirement. If yes, the vests will be labeled meeting ANSI 107-2004 & NFPA 701. If no, the vests will be labeled ANSI 107-2010. Will WVDOH extend the bid opening to allow time to make adjustments after an addendum is issued?

Answer #5: The vests are to meet the NFPA 701 requirement as specified. Technically, this information would not be required to be included on the label. Only the information described in Section 3.1.1.5 is required to be included on the label. The Vendor will be required to submit the certification described in Section 4.4.2.4 relating to the NFPA 701/requirement. The Purchasing Division buyer will advise if the bid opening date is to be extended.

Question #6: I was not able to access the web address listed showing in the bid documents. Can you send the table that the liquid dated damages are calculated on?

Answer #6: A printout of the webpage which includes the subject table is attached to this addendum.

Question #7: Before we move forward with this bid, can you please confirm that the sample requirement is asking for 8 total samples; M-2XL for the class 2, and M-2XL for the class 3 vest?

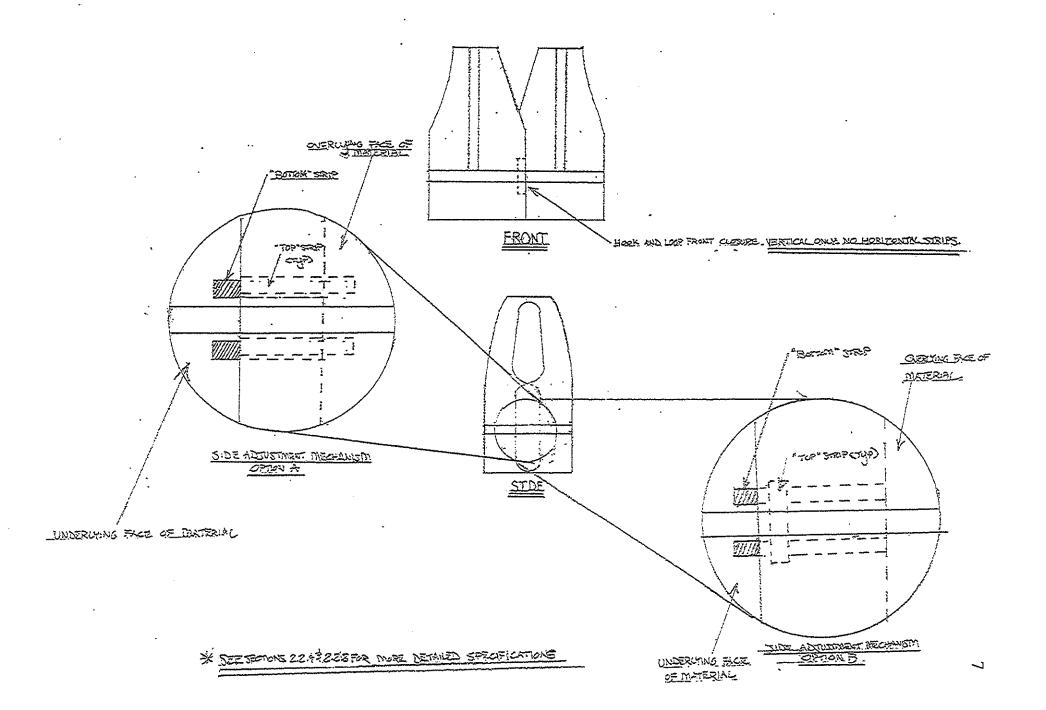
Answer #7: One sample vest is required. This is described in Section 4.4.2.1. Specifically, one size M-2XL vest with a screened logo is required. This should not be interpreted as meaning one size M vest, one size L vest, one size XL vest, and one size 2XL vest. The vest is intended to cover the entire size range from M through 2XL by way of the adjustment mechanism built into the vest. Review Sections 3.1.1.12 through 3.1.1.14 specifically in regards to this. The sample would be required to meet Class II. All vests to be supplied under this Contract are to be Class II. The manufacturer detail drawing does not include sleeves necessary to meet the Class III requirement.

Question #8: What is the current pricing for all four vests?

Answer #8: See Answer #2 above.

Question #9: What are the current makes/models being used?

Answer #9: The vests that were supplied previously under Contract # 859C2010 were Lohmann & Rauscher model number 400997.

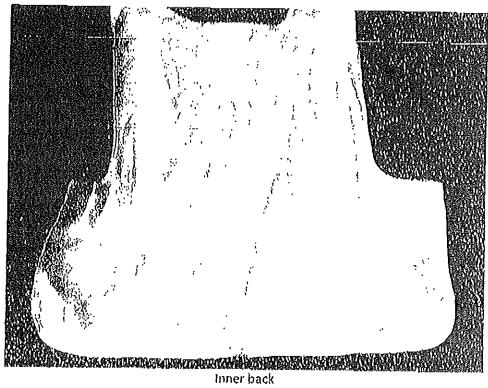
