Response to Specifications

American Ecotech is providing clarification to certain specifications in the State of West Virginia Solicitation # DEP16166 for Sulfur Dioxide Analyzers. The analyzer meets any of the specifications not mentioned in this response. Also, included in this response is a brochure which highlights the Serinus 50 capabilities.

3.1.2.3 Must have multiple user-selectable ranges, 0-50ppb to 0-20ppm.

The Ecotech Serinus 50 utilizes an auto range feature which makes user-selectable ranges obsolete. The instrument simply needs to be calibrated across the largest possible expected range. The capabilities of the instrument remain the same regardless of the range that the instrument is operating.

3.1.2.4 Must have dual ranges and auto ranging.

The Ecotech Serinus 50 includes auto-ranging which makes dual ranging unnecessary.

3.1.2.8 Must have front Panel USB connections for peripheral devices and firmware upgrades.

The Serinus 50 features two USB connections on the analyzer, and a USB flash drive which enables quick updates of firmware. Peripheral devices are not necessary for operation of the instrument; however a Bluetooth connection is available for use with Android operating systems such as tablets or smartphones. This allows for a remote interface with the unit.


