Project Approach

Phase 1

BAI/MSES will provide the comprehensive building code, life-safety and MEC Evaluation report of including analysis and recommendations. The report will also address phasing of the work, including geotechnical and surveying services. The firm will include analysis and recommendations of existing site conditions, space planning, life safety, data/communications, mechanical, electrical, fire suppression/fire alarm/smoke control systems, and construction phasing. The firm will be responsible for verifying, coordinating and documenting building components across all disciplines.

Phase 2

During the second phase of the project, BAI/MSES will provide a comprehensive design with development of construction documents, support during bidding analysis and construction observation. Once bids are accepted by the State of West Virginia Purchasing for the project, BAI/MSES will proceed with the necessary Standard AIA Contracts and work with the contractor to establish construction schedules to meet the time guidelines of the project. This second phase may be provided in multiple design packages, as may be required by DNR. Project captains in the various disciplines required for the project will make regular site visits during the Construction Administration Services phase. With offices in Huntington, the BAI/MSES firm has the additional advantage of site proximity.

Use of Project Websites and Electronic Communication

BAI/MSES creates project websites used by owners and reviewing agencies during the schematic and design development phases. Initial design websites are used to feature project updates, renderings and floor plans for review, as well as preconstruction site photography and site plans. The review phase for construction documents used to take weeks, where now reviewing agencies can download the most up-to-date documents immediately upon completion and provide comment. The use of electronic communication, FTP document transfer and secure document downloading saves time and money for all parties involved in the project. This technology has also been proven to increase the interest of contractors and suppliers during bidding. Many years ago BAI/MSES implemented a plan to allow free bid document downloads to contractors, vendors and suppliers during the bidding phase. During construction, the website features site progress photographs and panoramas for Owner access from their offices.

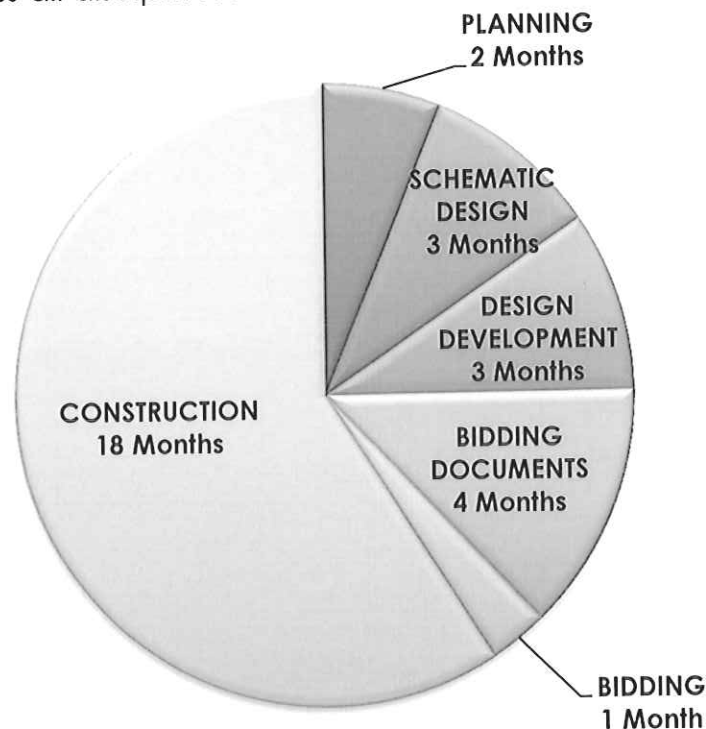

Project Approach

Estimated Construction Schedule

BAI/MSES will provide all services necessary to complete the Beech Fork Lodge Project with scope provided in the EOI using the following proposed schedule and phases of work. The firm will include analysis and recommendations, space planning, life safety, data/communications, mechanical, electrical, fire suppression/fire alarm/smoke control systems, and construction phasing. The firm will be responsible for verifying, coordinating and documenting building components across all disciplines.



Experience with COE Outgrant License Process

While our firms have experience in this process, we have not directly provided Market Study or Feasibility Study services for similar projects. Our firms do provide Conceptual Review, Field Surveying, Geotechnical Investigations, and additional licensing services required. The Stonewall Resort Lodge Conference Center project did require COE approval for the various phases stated due to proximity to Stonewall Lake, a similar situation faced by the Beech Fork Lodge project. In addition, the recently completed \$12.6 million Donel Kinnard Memorial State Veterans Cemetery, located on 350 acres in Institute, WV, received state and federal funding and required the COE Outgrant License Process with ARPA permits. Sample project:

Renovations to Fairmont Senior High School

Fairmont, West Virginia - Marion County Schools

Building is on National Register of Historic Places and the existing style and historical character of the building was maintained.

The total renovation cost using several funding sources (QZAB, Local, SBA and Federal Stimulus) and programs will be in excess of \$11.0 million. 30-50 years of additional life will be put back into the original structure, constructed in the 1920's.



Work currently under construction includes:

- Removal of existing windows, guards, blinds, & window A/C units.
- Removal and replacement of HVAC system.
- Installation of new windows, guards and blinds.
- Removal and replacement of lighting.
- Removal and replacement of fire alarm system and installation of sprinklers.

The third phase of the project will feature the renovation and adaptive reuse of an originally unused courtyard space in the center of the school into a new state-of-the-art media/library resource center featuring insulated translucent skylights overhead.

The Stonewall Resort Lodge and Conference Center in Lewis County, West Virginia was a \$20 million Construction Management project. This was made possible through a public / private collaboration of McCabe-Henley-Durbin, LP, a Charleston-based property development firm, and the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. G.A. Brown and Son, Inc. of Fairmont was the project Construction Manager. This was the first project delivery system for this type of project in West Virginia incorporating both public and private monies.

The 175,000 square foot structure is oriented on a peninsula embracing Stonewall Jackson Lake. The facility utilizes 21st century design technology

with a style reminiscent of the Arts and Crafts Movement. The lodge is divided into the following areas: the two story lodge proper, conference center, spa/pool complex and the three story guest wings. Upon arrival, the heavy timbered porte cochere invites you into the light flooded lobby which overlooks the lake. You may check into a room at the front desk, warm yourself by the stone fireplace or indulge yourself in an exciting novel at the library. The central stair leads down to fine dining in the 250 seat restaurant which extends to the outdoor patio. For a more leisurely dining experience, guests may visit the pub/lounge adjacent to the restaurant.

Stonewall Resort & Conference Center Lewis County, WV

The conference center houses eight meeting rooms, three large conference rooms, one board room and a conference hall. All are served by break-out areas adjacent to outdoor gathering spaces overlooking the golf course. Conference facilities can accommodate over 1600 people. In the spa complex guests may enjoy a relaxing massage, work out in the fitness room, visit the steam baths and saunas or take a swim in the 2300 S.F. all-season indoor/outdoor pool with built-in hot tubs. The pool is flanked by a large fenced-in patio with magnificent views in all directions. The north and south guest wings provide 198 rooms including six double sized suites and fifteen sleeping rooms accessible to the disabled. The guest rooms can accommodate over 750 occupants. The Stonewall Resort offers over 3.5 acres of floor area to welcome both local patrons and long distance travelers.

The Harrison County Commission had a dilemma. Their existing facilities, a collection of additions to the original barn, were old and nearly worn-out. Yet the building was used several times every week by a variety of community and private groups. The Commission decided to get professional input. They selected BAI and MSES to perform a detailed study. 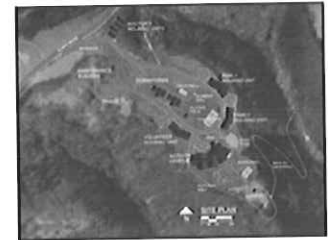
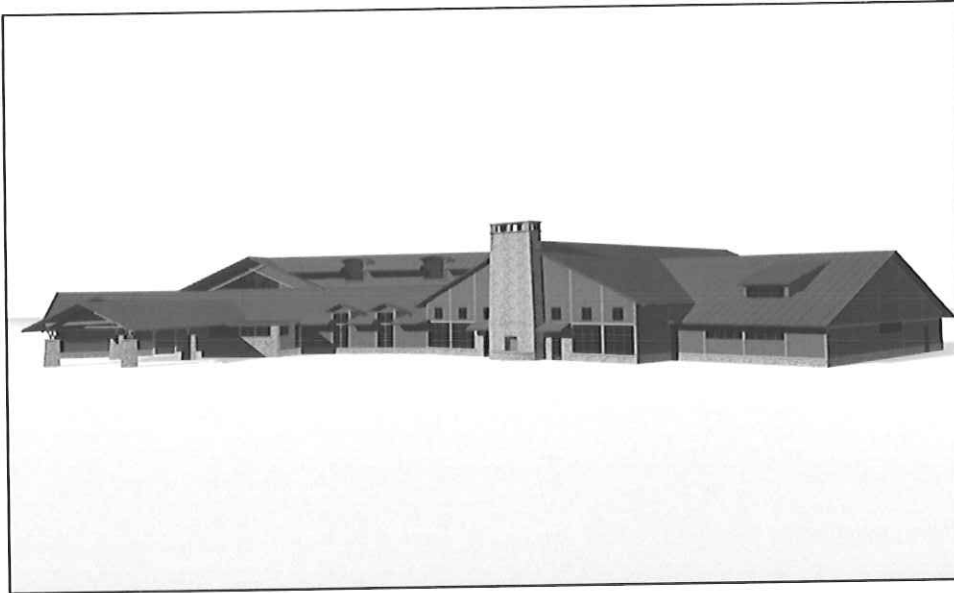
Ultimately the Commission decided that the existing facilities did not provide adequate flexibility for future needs and asked that BAI/MSES develop schematic planning for a new building. The new proposed building would set on a site adjacent to the existing building - allowing the continued use of the existing building and maintaining an important revenue stream. Upon approval of the schematic design BAI/MSES created interior and exterior virtual reality models and animations. The Commission had the opportunity to "see" their new building, inside and out, before any work commenced.

The project has completed construction with a construction cost of \$3,240,000.

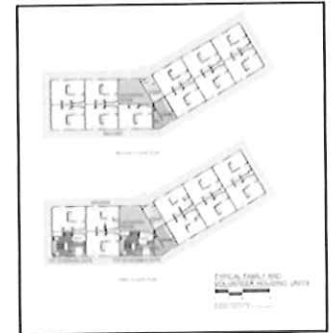
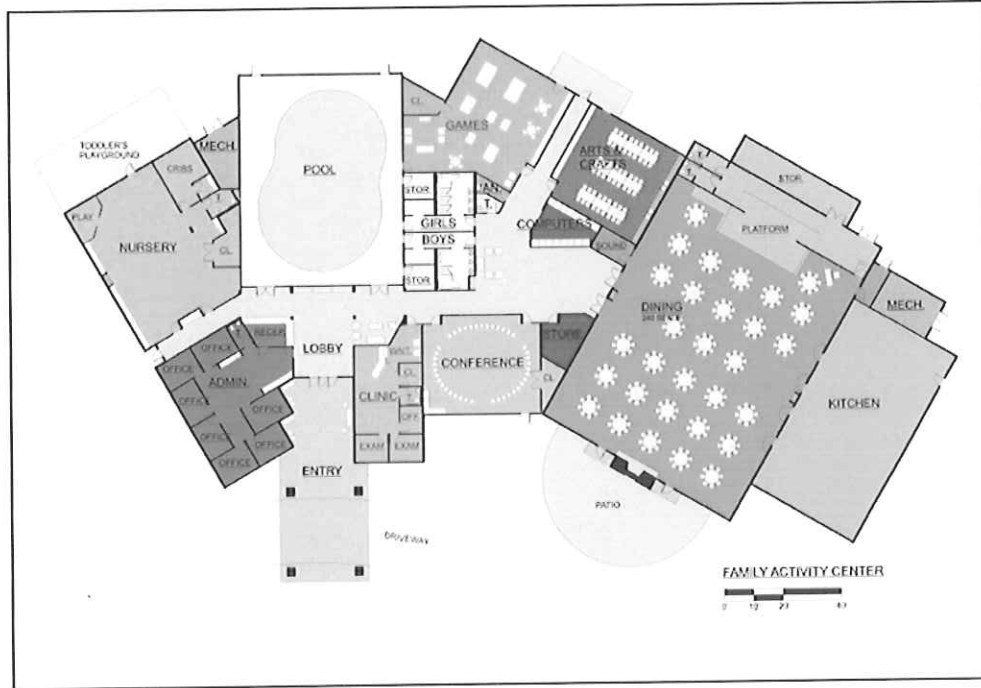
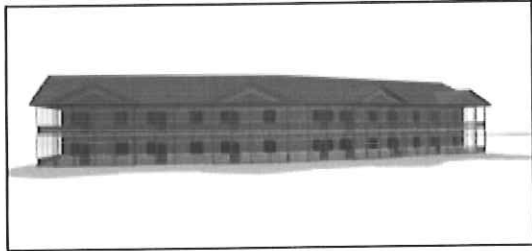

Braxton County, WV

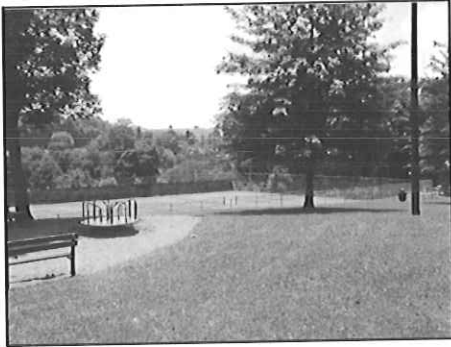

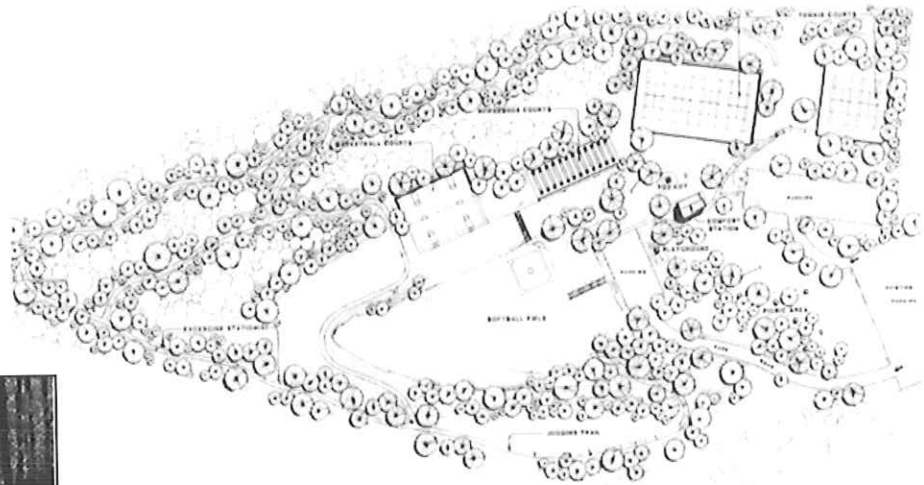

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

MANDATE: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

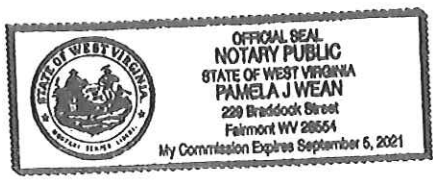
