RFQ#6614C014 Wildflower Seeds

To answer Vendor posed questions.

- Question #1 In looking at the newly added (which we do commend you for adding a pollinator mix) I find no percentages required by species in the seed mixture. Are the percentages by weight or seed count available somewhere?
- Response #1 Yes, please see attached revised Exhibit A, Pricing Page for item #14, Honey Bee Seed Mix adding weight/seed count formula.
- Question #2 To the best of my seedsman's knowledge there is no Strawberry clover – trifolium fragiferum produced for seed in the United States.
- Response #2 Although Strawberry Clover is now present in 19 US states; since it is not of United States origin, as required by Section 3.1.2 of the specification, WVDOH will remove this item from the Honey Bee Seed Mix, Item 14. Please see attached revised pricing page for item #14, Honey Bee Seed Mix.
- Question #3 Can we bid for quantities less than the sollicitaion states? Especially for mixes, the quantities of seed requested are larger (15,000 lbs total) and risk of committing and not selling is greater. For instance, could we bid a maximum of 1500 lbs of each of the mixes? In order to cap risk as well as being more in line with actual demand.
- Response #3 No, Vendors may not bid less than the quantities requested on the Pricing Pages. Section 4.2 states that the estimated purchase volume for each item represents the approximate volume of anticipated purchases only. No future use of the Contract or any individual item is guaranteed or implied. Vendors are cautioned that the quantities on Exhibit A, Pricing Pages are estimates only and are intended for bid evaluation purposes only.
- To further explain the estimated quantities requested, with new Wildflower Plots established each year, it is not known what individual species and/or mixes will work best for certain areas until after we have tested/etc. Also, dependent on how the previous years' growing season of certain Wildflower Plots will determine the quantity required.
- Taking the question into consideration, the WVDOH has replaced Exhibit A. Pricing Pages with the attached, adjusting the estimated quantities requested.
- Question #4 Could you share percent by weight for each specie of the bee mix?
- Response #4 Please see Response #2.
- Comment #5 I have asked whether we can cap our risk by bidding lesser quantities more in line with experienced actual demand, but I would also suggest that West Virginia would be doing bidders and itself a service if it matched the sollicitation quantities closely to demand.
- Response #5 Please see Response #3; however, the WVDOH can only request estimated quantities as the RFQ and contract are issued as an Open-End contract purchasing more than or less than the estimated bid quantites.

VENDOR PREFERENCE CERTIFICATE

Certification and application* is hereby made for Preference in accordance with West Virginia Code, §5A-3-37. (Does not apply to construction contracts). West Virginia Code, §5A-3-37, provides an opportunity for qualifying vendors to request (at the time of bid) preference for their residency status. Such preference is an evaluation method only and will be applied only to the cost bid in accordance with the West Virginia Code. This certificate for application is to be used to request such preference. The Purchasing Division will make the determination of the Resident Vendor Preference, if applicable.

- 1. Bidder understands if the Secretary of Revenue determines that a Bidder receiving preference has failed to continue to meet the requirements for such preference, the Secretary may order the Director of Purchasing to: (a) reject the bid; or (b) assess a penalty against such Bidder in an amount not to exceed 5% of the bid amount and that such penalty will be paid to the contracting agency or deducted from any unpaid balance on the contract or purchase order.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

MANDATE: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (W. Va. Code §61-5-3) that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.

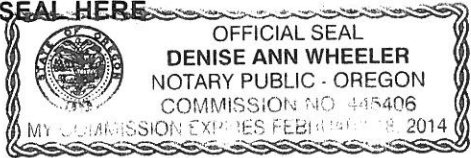
