DESCRIPTION OF BID ITEMS**

Bid Item 1, 2, 3: **Mobilization/Demobilization/ General Administration / Bonding and Insurance**

Unit: Lump Sum (LS)

Description: The work shall consist of activities including, but not limited to; construction preparatory operations, including the movement of personnel, equipment, and materials to and from the project site, preparation of storage areas, all bonding requirements and maintaining required insurance premiums. It will also include performing the construction administrative duties associated with managing the construction of the Project as stated in Division 1 and throughout the Specifications, providing construction layout, providing temporary utilities for the site until 100% acceptance of the project by the OWNER, and administration and maintenance of all required permits for the project, including permit fees.

Measurement: Measurement will be based on completion of the work described, prorated from lump sum amount according to the Basis of Payment below. **Maximum limit of Mobilization/Demobilization/ General Administration / Bonding and Insurance will be 10% of base bid.**

Payment: Payment for item will be in three installments. The first payment of 80 percent of the lump sum price will be made on the first estimate following partial mobilization including the placement or erection of the Contractor's office and storage facilities and the initiation of construction work. The remaining 20 percent will be paid upon demobilization and satisfactory restoration of the contractor's staging and work area and final completion of the Project.

Phase IA: Bus Loop

Bid Item 4: **Selective Site Demolition, Clearing and Grubbing**

Unit: Lump Sum (LS)

Description: This work shall consist of saw cutting, demolition and removal (and salvage where indicated) of all structures and pavements and associated appurtenances as shown on the plans, salvaging specified material and legally disposing of all other demolished materials off site in an approved landfill or other approved disposal facility. Work shall further include clearing and grubbing of all other vegetation, tree stumps within the limits of disturbance. This pay item also covers the removal and capping of existing utilities (as applicable). This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work. **Burning will not be permitted on site.**

Measurement: There will be no direct measurement of materials, labor, and services provided by the contractor in completing this item.

Payment: Payment shall be made on a percent complete basis based on percentage of total demolition and site clearing and grubbing completed.

Bid Item 5: Sediment and Erosion Control

Unit: Lump Sum (LS)

Description: This item shall consist of furnishing, installing, maintaining and subsequent removal of necessary temporary storm water structures, best management practices, and other work required to prevent escape of sediment from disturbed areas of the project site. This pay item includes all temporary erosion and sediment controls indicated on the plans. Contractor shall also include all necessary supplemental controls they feel necessary to protect adjacent inlets, culverts, and waterways from sedimentation. This might include intermediate sediment sumps, sediment traps, temporary seeding not specifically listed in the drawings but necessary to meet the intent of issued permits. This pay item includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: There will be no direct measurement of materials, labor, and services provided by the contractor in completing this item.

Payment: Payment shall be made on a percent complete basis based on percentage of total sediment and erosion control activities completed.

Bid Item 6: Underground Electrical Conduit

Unit: Linear Foot (LF)

Description: This work shall consist of trench excavation and backfill, vaults, conduit, concrete, and pull ropes required for the installation of underground secondary between the transformer and the proposed building pad. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Measurement shall be based on linear feet of duct bank in place, completed, and accepted by the OWNER. It shall be measured along the centerline and shall include all fittings, and appurtenances associated with the duct bank.

Payment: Payment shall be made at the contract unit price per linear foot.

Bid Item 7: Electric Pull Boxes

Unit: Each (EA)

Description: This work shall consist of furnishing and installing electric pull boxes as indicated on the Plans. These prices shall fully compensate the Contractor for providing pull boxes and all appurtenances necessary for proper installation and connection. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Measurement shall be based units installed in place, completed, and accepted by the OWNER. It shall be measured along the centerline and shall include all fittings, and appurtenances associated with the duct bank.

Payment: Payment shall be made at the contract unit price per linear foot.

Bid Item 8: Miscellaneous utility adjustments (rim elevations, relocation)

Unit: Lump Sum (LS)

Description: This work consists of the adjustment of existing utilities on an at-need basis as required by the Plans. This item includes, but is not limited to, the adjustment of rim elevations to conform to proposed finished grades, and relocation of surface and subsurface utilities. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Measurement shall be based on each required utility adjustment, completed, and accepted by the OWNER.

Payment: This item shall be paid for at the contract price once completed.

Bid Items 9: Storm Sewer Line (12")

Unit: Linear Foot (LF)

Description: This work consists of the furnishing and completing the installation of high density polyethylene pipe for storm drainage. Pipe, bedding, excavation (including over-excavation and controlled fills), backfill, fill, fittings, and pavement repairs, are included in this item. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Shall be measured by the linear foot in place, the measurement being made along the centerline of each pipe installed. Branch connections, tees, wyes, and elbows shall be measured along their centerlines and these lengths included in the total lengths of the appropriate conduit. Wyes, tees, and other branch connections shall be measured along the centerlines to points of intersection. The portion of pipe extending through to the inside face of headwalls of all types, manholes, inlets, boxes, or other structures shall be included in the measurement.

Payment: Payment shall be made at the contract unit price per linear foot.

Bid Item 10: Existing storm inlet adjustments (rim elevations)

Unit: Each (EA)

Description: This work consists of the adjustment of existing storm sewer drain inlet rim elevations as required by the Plans. This item includes the adjustment of rim elevations to conform to proposed finished grades. This includes performing all

work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Measurement shall be based on each inlet rim adjustment, completed, and accepted by the OWNER.

Payment: This item shall be paid for at the contract price once completed.

Bid Items 11: Storm Inlets (Type-B)

Unit: Each (EA)

Description: This work shall consist of installing pre-cast or cast-in-place concrete inlets for storm drainage. Pipe connection, bedding, excavation and backfill, fittings, and pavement repairs, are included in this item. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Measurement shall be based on each drain inlet in place completed, and accepted by the OWNER.

Payment: Payment shall be made at the contract unit price per each.

Bid Items 12: Pole Lights (Proposed)

Unit: Each (EA)

Description: This work shall consist of installing cast-in-place light pole bases and light poles. Conduit connection, excavation, backfill, fittings, and pavement repairs, are included in this item. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Measurement shall be based on each unit installed in place completed, and accepted by the OWNER.

Payment: Payment shall be made at the contract unit price per each.

Bid Item 13: Concrete Sidewalk, Truncated Domes, and Integral Curbing

Unit: Square Foot (SF)

Description: This work shall include, but is not limited to, the construction of cast-in-place concrete sidewalk, curbing and truncated domes at the locations specified on the Plans, or as directed by the OWNER. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Shall be measured along the outside perimeter of the section at the finish grade elevation.

Payment: Payment shall be made at the contract unit price per square foot of accepted concrete sidewalk, truncated domes, and integral curbing.

Bid Item 14: Full-Depth Concrete Curb

Unit: Linear Foot (LF)

Description: This work shall include, but is not limited to, the construction of full-depth concrete curb at the locations specified on the Plans, or as directed by the OWNER. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Measurement shall be based on linear feet of full-depth curb in place, completed, and accepted by the OWNER. It shall be measured along the centerline.

Payment: This item shall be paid for at the contract price per linear foot.

Bid Item 15: Asphalt Paving

Unit: Square Foot (SF)

Description: This work shall include, but is not limited to, the construction of asphalt paving at the locations specified on the Plans, or as directed by the OWNER. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Shall be measured along the outside perimeter of the section at the finish grade elevation.

Payment: Payment shall be made at the contract unit price per square foot of accepted asphalt paving.

Bid Item 16: Concrete Paving

Unit: Square Foot (SF)

Description: This work shall include the construction of paved concrete surfaces at the locations specified on the Plans, or as directed by the OWNER. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Shall be measured along the outside perimeter of the section at the finish grade elevation.

Payment: Payment shall be made at the contract unit price per square foot of accepted concrete pavement.

Bid Item 17: Pavers on Concrete

Unit: Square Foot (SF)

Description: This work shall include, but is not limited to, the construction of cast-in-place concrete, concrete pavers, joints, sealants, and all appurtenances necessary for the installation at the locations specified on the Plans, or as directed by the OWNER. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Shall be measured along the outside perimeter of the section at the finish grade elevation.

Payment: Payment shall be made at the contract unit price per square foot of accepted pavers on concrete.

Bid Item 18: Pavement Striping

Unit: Lump Sum (LS)

Description: This work shall consist pavement striping of specified size in locations specified on the plans and all appurtenances or as directed by the OWNER. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: There will be no direct measurement of materials, labor, and services provided by the contractor in completing this item.

Payment: This item shall be paid for at the contract price once completed.

Bid Item 19: Limestone Veneer Seatwall (+/- 24" – Single Side Veneer)

Unit: Linear Foot (LF)

Description: This work shall include, but is not limited to, the construction of single side limestone veneer seatwall at the locations specified on the Plans, or as directed by the OWNER. Unit:	Each (EA)

Measurement:	Measurement shall be based on each column in place, completed, and accepted by the OWNER.
Payment:	Payment shall be made at the contract unit price per each.
Bid Item 22:	Landscaping
Unit:	Lump Sum (LS)
Description:	This work shall consist of landscaping of the site to include but not limited to all trees, shrubs, ground cover, perennials, annuals, shredded hardwood mulch, soil amendments, topsoil as-needed, and reseeded within the limits of disturbance and in locations specified on the plans or as directed by the OWNER. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.
Measurement:	There will be no direct measurement of materials, labor, and services provided by the contractor in completing this item.
Payment:	Payment shall be made on a percent complete basis from the contract lump sum price, based on percentage of total contract completion.

Bid Items 23: **Trash Receptacles**

Unit: Each (EA)

Description: This work shall consist of installation of trash receptacles of specified size in locations specified on the Plans and all appurtenances. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Measurement shall be based on each trash receptacle in place completed, and accepted by the OWNER.

Payment: Payment shall be made at the contract unit price per each.

Bid Item 24: **Bus Shelters**

Unit: Each (EA)

Description: This work shall consist of installation of bus shelters in locations specified on the Plans and all appurtenances. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Measurement shall be based on each bus shelter in place completed, and accepted by the OWNER.

Payment: Payment shall be made at the contract unit price per each.

Phase IB: Governor's Mansion / Greenbrier Street

Bid Item 25: **Selective Site Demolition, Clearing and Grubbing**

Unit: Lump Sum (LS)

Bid Item 26: Underground Electrical Conduit

Unit: Linear Foot (LF)

Description: This work shall consist of trench (including over-excavation and controlled fills), and backfill, vaults, conduit, concrete, and pull ropes required for the installation of underground secondary between the transformer and the proposed building pad. This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work.

Measurement: Measurement shall be based on linear feet of duct bank in place, completed, and accepted by the OWNER. It shall be measured along the centerline and shall include all fittings, and appurtenances associated with the duct bank.

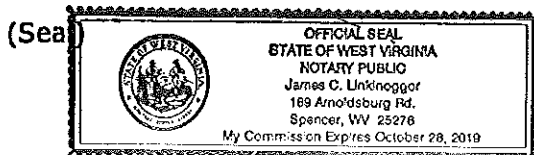

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

MANDATE: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.
