

The original language in contract will be listed first with question and answer to follow below.

1. 3.1.2.1 Overall width shall be:

C. Option # 3 – 8 ½ foot plow shall be polyethylene sheet with snow deflector mounted at top.

Question: We don't make 8 ½ foot poly plows that are compatible with many of your pickup trucks. Ours are 8 ½ foot 11 gauge steel with baked-on epoxy primer and red polyester powder coating, will you accept?

Question: Will you accept AR400?

Answer: We will accept stainless steel for the 8 ½' plows or AR400.

2. 3.1.2.3 Formed steel plow shoes shall be provided, height adjustable.

Question: Our plows have two full rotation, height adjustable ductile iron disc shoes, which are more than equal to "formed steel shoes" will you accept?

Answer: Yes

3. 3.1.5.1 Lift frame shall have options for out front hydraulics and light kit.

Question: This appears to imply that these items are only options and not necessarily included with the plows. I suggest that the words "options for" be deleted. Will you accept this statement?

Answer: We will delete option, it will now read: **3.1.5.1 Lift frame shall have out front hydraulics and light kit.**

4. 3.1.5.3 Lift frame shall be two (2) piece construction, and lower lift frame must include drive in alignment horns.

Question: All vendors except one: Our lift frames are now the heavier duty one-piece design, one solid continuous piece. Will you accept?

Answer: No

5. **3.1.7.1** Shall have dual beam halogen headlamps plus combination park and turn signals mounted in combination with plow unit.

Answer: We will be changing this to read: **3.1.7.1** Shall have dual beam LED headlamps plus combination park and turn signals mounted in combination with plow unit.

6. **6.1 Delivery:** 30 working days for pilot and 90 working days for remainder of order.

Question: All vendors would like to see this changed to 45 working days for pilot and 90 working days for remainder of order.

Question: Will the WVDOH be furnishing a truck to the winning bidder to mount the plow on if a pilot model is requested?

Answer # 1: We will change to 45 working days for pilot and 90 working days for remainder of order.

Answer # 2: Vendor will be instructed at the time order is placed what truck the plow will be installed on.

7. **6.6** We understand that all of plows, not just the test plow will be delivered to the Equipment Division, Buckhannon, WV?

Answer: Yes that is correct.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.
