



- 1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE: The West Virginia Purchasing Division is soliciting bids on behalf of WV Department of Agriculture to establish a contract for the one time purchase of a 2015 or newer Class 8 Day Cab Tandem Tractor.
- 2. **DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions.
 - 2.1 "Contract Item" means 2015 or newer Class 8 Day Cab Tandem Tractor. 2016 Mark
 - 2.2 "Pricing Page" means the pages upon which Vendor should list its proposed price for the Contract Items in the manner requested. The Pricing Page is either included on the last page of this RFQ or attached hereto as Exhibit A. Vendors may also submit bids using the VSS/WV Oasis website and insert pricing on the commodity lines.
- 2.3 "RFQ" means the official request for quotation published by the Purchasing Division.
 - 3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:
- Mandatory Contract Item Requirements: Contract Item must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements listed below.

4. CONTRACT AWARD:

4.1 Contract Award: The Contract is intended to provide Agencies with a purchase price for the Contract Items. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides the Contract Items meeting the required specifications for the lowest overall total cost as shown on the Pricing Pages or on the commodity lines if bid electronically via the VSS system.

4.2 Pricing Page: Vendor should complete the Pricing Page by listing the equipment make, model and cost along with any additional equipment fees. Vendor should complete the Pricing Page, or commodity lines in full as failure to complete in its entirety may result in Vendor's bid being disqualified.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Purchasing Division may correct errors as it deems appropriate.

5. PAYMENT:

5.1 Payment: Vendor shall accept payment in accordance with the payment procedures of the State of West Virginia.

6. DELIVERY AND RETURN:

- 6.1 Shipment and Delivery: Vendor shall ship the Contract Items immediately after being awarded this Contract and receiving a purchase order. Vendor shall deliver the Contract Items within 180 Days working days after receiving the purchase order. Contract Items must be delivered to Agency at 4496 Cedar Lakes Road, Ripley, WV 25271.
- 6.2 Late Delivery: The Agency placing the order under this Contract must be notified in writing if the shipment of the Contract Items will be delayed for any reason. Any delay in delivery that could cause harm to an Agency will be grounds for cancellation of the Contract, and/or obtaining the Contract Items from a third party.

Any Agency seeking to obtain the Contract Items from a third party under this provision must first obtain approval of the Purchasing Division.

- 6.3 Delivery Payment/Risk of Loss: Vendor shall deliver the Contract Items F.O.B. destination to the Agency's location.
 - 6.4 Return of Unacceptable Items: If the Agency deems the Contract Items to be unacceptable, the Contract Items shall be returned to Vendor at Vendor's expense and with no restocking charge. Vendor shall either make arrangements for the return within five (5) days of being notified that items are unacceptable, or permit the Agency to arrange for the return and reimburse Agency for delivery expenses. If the original packaging cannot be utilized for the return, Vendor will supply the Agency with appropriate return packaging upon request. All returns of unacceptable items shall be F.O.B. the Agency's location. The returned product shall either be replaced, or the Agency shall receive a full credit or refund for the purchase price, at the Agency's discretion.
- 6.5 Return Due to Agency Error: Items ordered in error by the Agency will be returned for credit within 30 days of receipt, F.O.B. Vendor's location. Vendor shall not charge a restocking fee if returned products are in a resalable condition. Items shall be deemed to be in a resalable condition if they are unused and in the original packaging. Any restocking fee for items not in a resalable condition shall be the lower of the Vendor's customary restocking fee or 5% of the total invoiced value of the returned items.


