PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

MANDATE: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (W. Va. Code §61-5-3) that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.

History -

CHP Energy Solutions is an Interstate Renewable Energy Council (IREC) Accredited Training Provider™ for its Quality Control Inspector, Energy Auditor, Crew Leader, and Retrofit Installer Technician courses.

In June 2012, CHP Energy Solutions became the first training center in the nation to obtain IREC accreditation for an energy efficiency program. The training center earned this distinction for its Retrofit Installer Technician course.

Subsequently, in May 2013, CHP Energy Solutions became an IREC Accredited Training Provider™ for its Quality Control Inspector and Energy Auditor training programs, and in December 2013, it earned IREC accreditation for its Crew Leader training program.

- **3.1.5** CHP Energy Solutions has the capacity to host class sizes of up to 12 people.
- 3.1.6 CHP Energy Solutions provides to its students certificates upon passing the CHP Energy Solutions Preparatory Courses, however BPI will be responsible for administering certificates upon passing the BPI HEP QCI written and field exams.
- 3.1.7 CHP Energy Solutions has include in its price all costs associated with trainers, books and materials, and expenses incurred at the training site.
- 3.1.8 CHP Energy Solutions has three training and testing houses within its facility that have been BPI approved for QCI training and testing.

3.2 Quality Control Inspector Course and Testing

- 3.2.6 CHP Energy Solutions will ensure that students have the appropriate documentation to attend the course and testing per BPI.

The agency is responsible for registering all students in the course through CHP Energy Solutions' Learning Management System (LMS) located here https://lms.chplearning.org/app/register prior to the students attending the training or testing.

The WV Office of Economic Opportunity agrees to reimburse and pay CHP Energy Solutions for the training and testing as outlined in this agreement. This cost covers CHP Energy Solutions' staff time for preparation, instruction, travel, lodging, per diem, binders/handouts, and trainer during the training and other costs directly related to the training as well as technical assistance provided before and after the training sessions.
