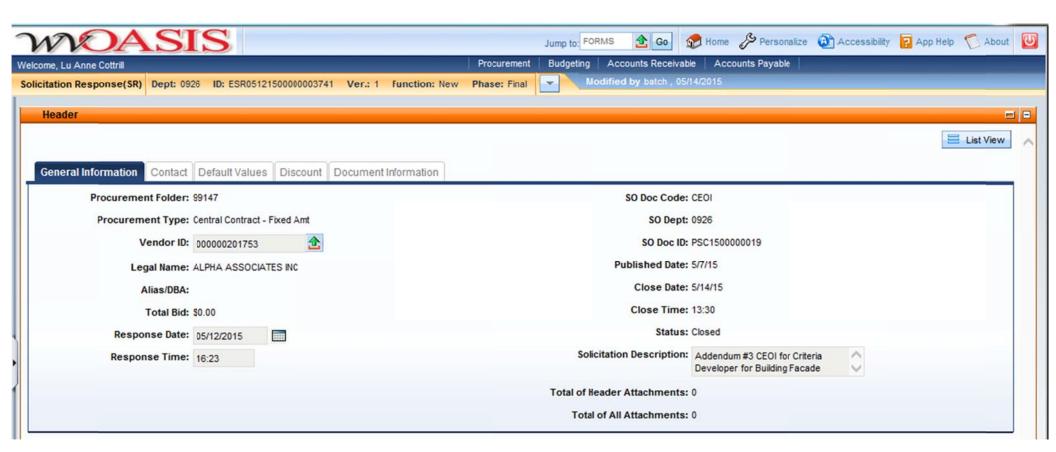

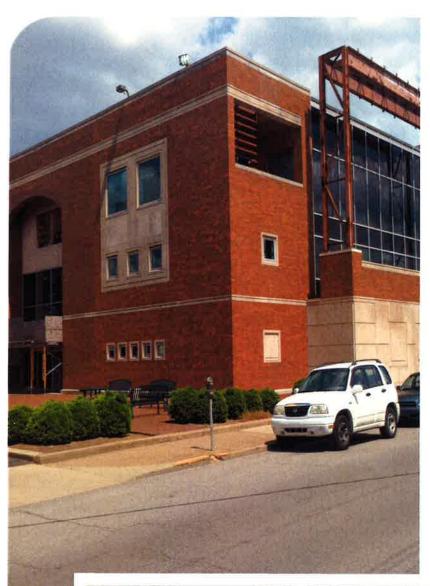

# APPROACH AND METHODOLOGY

#### Our understanding of the project:

Design Criteria for the Façade Replacement has been previously developed by the firm of Swanke, Hayden and Connell. The new Criteria Developer is to complete the project from where they left off.

The assumption has been made for this EOI that the former firm has released all copyrighted information so that a new "criteria developer" can utilize the previously distributed information.

The Design Criteria RFP Manual was released to the previously qualified firms for development of Qualitative & Cost proposals on February 9, 2015. Currently the Qualitative and Cost Proposals are due on June 22, 2015, with an anticipated Construction Start Date of July 2015.

The following is Alpha's anticipated Project Approach for the Public Service Commission Criteria Developer Building Façade Project:

### Two week review period after Notice to Proceed:

- 1. Meet with owner's team to determine if the Structural and Engineering groups that are listed in the RFP Manual released February 9, 2015 are still part of the project.

  - b) Arrange for compensation of previous consulting engineers if still part of the project.
- 2. Review of existing documents by both in house Structural Engineers and Architects, as submitted to the Design Build Teams
  - a) Existing record drawings of existing building.
  - b) Existing Design Criteria Drawings
  - c) Report of Emergency Masonry Demolition
  - d) Existing RFP Manual and specifications
- 3. Suggest any modifications to Design Criteria RFP Manual to owner if deemed necessary.
  - a) Allow additional weeks for modifications if necessary.





#### Design Build Development Period (per schedule determined by Design Build Board)

- Develop answers to any and all questions from Design Build Teams while they
  are developing their Qualitative and Cost Proposals, with the PSC Technical
  Review Committee.
- 2. Submit answers and/or supplemental documents and/or drawings to the purchasing dept. for distribution to the Design Build Teams.

#### Bid Evaluation Period: (per schedule determined by Design Build Board)

- 1. Evaluate Design Build Teams Qualitative submissions, along with the PSC Technical Review team. Utilize existing Qualitative Proposal Rating System as contained within the Design Criteria RFP Manual.
- 2. Evaluate Design Build Teams Cost Proposal submissions, utilizing existing Rating Score Sheet as contained within the Design Criteria RFP Manual.
- 3. Make recommendations to Owner's representative and Design Build Board for contract award.

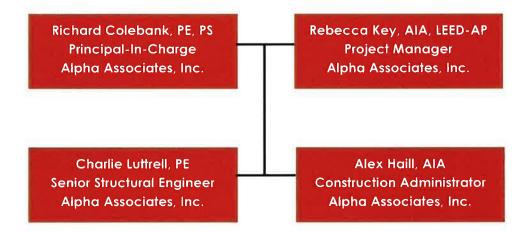

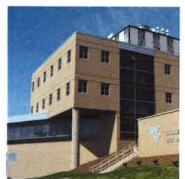

# **Architectural Case Study**

**West Virginia University - Engineering** Sciences Building Façade Replacement Morgantown, WV

Alpha Associates provided architectural and structural engineering design services for the evaluation and solution of the deteriorating brick façade at the Engineering Sciences Building.

The solution replaced the existing brick façade with a pre-engineered panelized material.

The existing façade consisted of three wythes of masonry units: an outer glazed brick, a middle tile unit, and an interior tile unit. The design included the removal of the outer two wythes of masonry.

The replacement façade consisted of 6" steel studs with kraft paper faced batt insulation supporting synthetic panels and thermal glazed aluminum windows and aluminum louvers.

The project was completed in two phases. Phase I consisted of removing the East Façade and Phase II consisted of removal of the remaining three sides. Phase I was an emergency situation that required immediate action. Phase II is awaiting future funding.
