### **PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT**

MANDATE: Under W. Va. #### EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

#### Section 1: Understanding of Requirements

The West Virginia, Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR) owns and operates Pipestem State Park. The DNR is requesting expressions of interest related to the evaluation, design, and replacement of the 10,000 gallon per day, extended aeration wastewater treatment plant which has served 25 cabins for the past 40 years. Blue Mountain, Inc. (BMI) and Ashco-A-Corporation (Ashco) will work together as a team to consider alternative technologies and changes in the contributing waste sources to obtain a treatment system that is both effective and economical.

#### Section 2: Qualifications and Experience

Tasks related to the above mentioned project will be performed by BMI and Ashco as a team. Regular meetings, teleconferences, and status reporting will enable the two companies to work together seamlessly and provide the most efficient and productive options to the owner. Both BMI and Ashco have rich histories of completing a myriad of projects on time and within budget requirements for the past several decades.


