PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

MANDATE: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. "Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (*W. Va. PROPOSAL NARRATIVE

Jackson & Coker's Company Mission

Jackson & Coker believes that all hospitals, clinics, physician practices and patients should have access to a physician, whether for a day, a lifetime, or any of life's changes in between.

UNDERSTANDING THE NEED

The State of West Virginia Purchasing Division intends to award a contract to one or more responsible, reputable vendors of temporary medical services. In particular, there is anticipated staffing needs in the area of OB/GYN at Welch Community Hospital (WCH).

The contract to be awarded will be in effect for one year from date of award, with the possibility of three one-year extensions. Contract extensions will depend upon continuation of the staffing need, satisfactory performance of the Contractor, and availability of encumbered funding.

As an incumbent contractor providing OB/GYN coverage at Welch Community Hospital, Jackson & Coker is well aware of what is involved in placing highly qualified physicians who make a valuable contribution to health care delivery.

- ✓ If not board certified, education and training are verified via AMA/.AOA an ECFMG (if applicable). If education is not verified on the AMA/.AOA we will verify the education directly from the institution.
- ✓ 5-year work history (from CV and application)
- ✓ Professional peer references at least 2 references.
 If any derogatory information is found, it is reviewed by our inhouse Risk Management Department for approval.

NOTE: Jackson & Coker re-credentials providers every two years to promote ongoing Quality Management. This is in contrast to many physician recruitment firms that only credential providers once, at the time they register with the agencies.

Provider Monitoring

Our locum tenens OB/GYN physicians are not direct employees of Jackson & Coker. Rather, they are independent contractors who receive year-end 1099-Misc. Forms for tax purposes.

Our meticulous credentialing procedures – which include a careful qualification verification process – assure that our locum tenens physicians are able to perform the work responsibilities without any difficulty.

STAFFING PLAN

Jackson & Coker has a well-designed staffing plan to meet the specific requirements of this RFQ. Here are the main elements of that plan.

To fulfill the terms and conditions of this contract with Welch Community Hospital, it will not be necessary to utilize the services of any subcontractor entity.

Our database is sufficiently large, and our recruiters are adequately experienced to "make a good fit" of qualified providers with this appealing practice opportunity.






