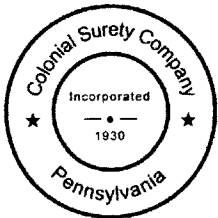

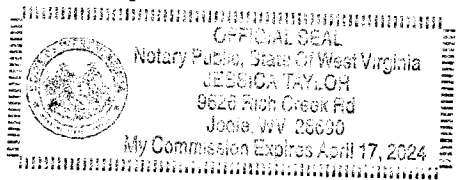

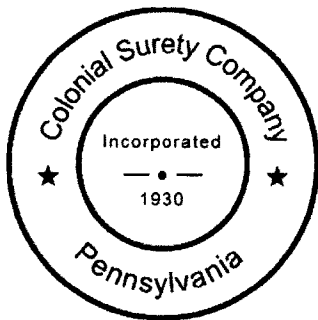

**MANDATE:** Under W. Va. 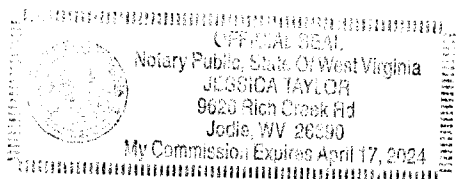




