### **SPECIFICATIONS**

- 1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE: The West Virginia Purchasing Division is soliciting bids on behalf of West Virginia Department of Agriculture to establish a contract for a Freezer Racking System.
- 2. DEFINITIONS: The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions.
  - 2.1 "Contract Services" means providing materials and installation of freezer racking system.
  - 2.2 "Pricing Page" means the pages upon which Vendor should list its proposed price for the Contract Services. The Pricing Page is either included on the last page of this RFQ or attached hereto as Exhibit A.
  - 2.3 "RFQ" means the official request for quotation published by the Purchasing Division and identified as AGR###.
  - 2.4 DRIVE-IN [2] and drive-thru (sometimes spelled Drive-thru) are storage rack configurations that allow the forklift to drive directly into the lane of stacked rows (called a bay). The difference between a drive-in and a drive-thru pallet rack system is simply whether the bays have an entry at only one end, or at both ends. Drive-in rack systems use a common entry and exit, while drive-thru systems have entry points at either end of the bay. Because a drive-in racking system has only one entrance, it uses what is called a LIFO (last in, first out) storage method. With only one entrance, the last pallet put into a row is necessarily the first one to be taken out. A drive-thru storage system, with two different entry points, can also use a FIFO (first in, first out) storage method. With a FIFO system, pallets are loaded in one end and are pushed back to the other end, where they are then at the front of the tow on the opposite side. The first pallet put into such a row is the first one taken out at the other end. This system is advantageous for material with an expiration date or wherever shelf life is a major concern.
- 3. QUALIFICATIONS: Vendor shall have the following minimum qualifications:
  - 3.1. State of West Virginia Contractors license.
  - 3.2. All bonding and insurance requirements that are mandatory for project scope.

#### 4. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

4.1 Mandatory Contract Services Requirements and Deliverables: Contract Services must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements listed below.

### 4.1.1 Freezer and Warehouse Racking System

- 4.1.1.1 Freezer and Warehouse Racking System must be completed in 120 Days.
- 4.1.1.2 All prices quoted will be for the Drive-In Racking System fully installed, usable, and will include, but not be limited to, all materials including anchors and shims, any and all freight charges, labor, and install time.
- 4.1.1.3 Floor channel guides w/bull nose to keep pallets aligned and protect uprights from damage to the entire depth of each rack section / row.
- 4.1.1.4 The Department of Agriculture has broken this project into five areas and may award in whole or in part. Pricing is required for each individual section as shown on the attached diagram and pricing sheet.
- 4.1.1.5 Minimum Yield Strength 55,000 PSI Maximum 75,000 PSI Minimum Tensile Strength 75,000 PSI Maximum 100,000 PSI, load limits for pallet racks.
- 4.1.1.6 At the head of each rack section/row double-thick, double-strength, diaphragmed box sections with slant-back frames to provide resistance to impact damage of upright rack storage columns. All rows must accommodate a Yale Narrow Aisle Life, Model NR-040DANM24T-E101.
- 4.1.1.7 Cooler #1 (see drawing) 3 rows, 7 deep of drive-in pallet racking 4 levels high & in the middle 3 rows, 4 deep rows of drive-in racking

- 4 levels high approximate opening range for 63" high pallets @ minimum 3000 pounds each.
- 4.1.1.8 Cooler #2 (see drawing) 3 rows, 7 deep drive-in pallet racking, 4 levels high approximate opening range for 63" high pallets @ minimum 3000 pounds each.
- 4.1.1.9 Cooler #3 (see drawing) 7 rows, 4 deep of drive-in pallet racking 5 levels high 4 foot tall, approximate opening range for 63" high pallets @ minimum 3000 pounds each.
- 4.1.1.10 Freezer #1 (see drawing) 16 rows, 9 deep of drive-in pallet racking 3 levels high approximate opening range for 84" high pallets @ minimum 3000 pounds each.
- 4.1.1.11 Freezer #2 (see drawing) 16 rows, 9 deep & 12 rows, 10 deep drive-in pallet racking 4 levels high approximate opening range for 63" high pallets @ minimum 3000 pounds each.
- 4.1.1.12 Dry Storage (see drawing) 27 rows, 11 deep drive-in pallet racking 4 levels high-approximate opening range for 63" & 84" high pallets @ minimum 3000 pounds.
- 4.1.1.13 Successful vendor will work with the Warehouse staff on moving the product around within the freezer. Freezer WILL NOT be shut down nor will the temperature change in any way.
- 4.1.1.14 Successful vendor will be provided at least a 12 hour day shift, Monday thru Friday, with the option of working on Saturday and Sunday.
- 4.1.1.15 Successful vendor is responsible to supply their own material handling equipment and charging station such as a generator. Vendor will be provided a space out back of the warehouse in the gated area to store their materials and equipment.

- 4.1.1.16 Successful vendor deliveries must be scheduled twentyfour hours in advanced and must be delivered during normal
  working hours M-F 6:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m.
- 4.1.1.17 Pallet dimensions, 42" x 48"
- 4.1.1.18 Based on truck dimensions it is understood that the first rail level will not be higher than 91". We will be using narrow aisle trucks. Will be 7' on 3 high openings and 5'3" on 4 high openings.
- 4.1.1.19 The various clear heights in the freezers and coolers shall be 21'
- 4.1.1.20 The heaviest pallet to be stored will be no more than 3,000 lbs.
- 4.1.1.21 Pallets will be stored at 42" wide.
- 4.1.1.22 There are minimal drawings available. Contractor doing own measurements is HIGHLY recommended.
- 4.1.1.23 There will be NO double stacking of pallets.
- 4.1.1.24 The ceiling clear height to be used is 21'.
- 4.1.1.25 An inspection of concrete floor is attached.

#### 5. CONTRACT AWARD:

- 5.1 Contract Award: The Contract is intended to provide Agency with a purchase price for the Contract Services. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides the Contract Services meeting the required specifications for the lowest overall total cost as shown on the Pricing Pages.
- 5.2 Pricing Page: Vendor should complete the Pricing Page by Filling in the appropriate spaces for each section. Vendor should complete the Pricing Page

in full as failure to complete the Pricing Page in its entirety may result in Vendor's bid being disqualified.

Vendor should type or electronically enter the information into the Pricing Page to prevent errors in the evaluation.

- 6. PERFORMANCE: Vendor and Agency shall agree upon a schedule for performance of Contract Services and Contract Services Deliverables, unless such a schedule is already included herein by Agency. In the event that this Contract is designated as an open-end contract, Vendor shall perform in accordance with the release orders that may be issued against this Contract.
- 7. PAYMENT: Agency shall pay once job is completed, as shown on the Pricing Pages, for all Contract Services performed and accepted under this Contract. Vendor shall accept payment in accordance with the payment procedures of the State of West Virginia.
- 8. TRAVEL: Vendor shall be responsible for all mileage and travel costs, including travel time, associated with performance of this Contract. Any anticipated mileage or travel costs may be included in the flat fee or hourly rate listed on Vendor's bid, but such costs will not be paid by the Agency separately.
- 9. FACILITIES ACCESS: Performance of Contract Services may require access cards and/or keys to gain entrance to Agency's facilities. In the event that access cards and/or keys are required:
  - 9.1. Vendor must identify principal service personnel which will be issued access cards and/or keys to perform service.
  - 9.2. Vendor will be responsible for controlling cards and keys and will pay replacement fee, if the cards or keys become lost or stolen.
  - 9.3. Vendor shall notify Agency immediately of any lost, stolen, or missing card or key.
  - 9.4. Anyone performing under this Contract will be subject to Agency's security protocol and procedures,
  - 9.5. Vender shall inform all staff of Agency's security protocol and procedures.


#### 10. VENDOR DEFAULT:

  - 10.1.4. Failure to remedy deficient performance upon request.
- 10.2. The following remedies shall be available to Agency upon default.
  - 10.2.1. Cancellation of the Contract.
  - 10.2.2. Cancellation of one or more release orders issued under this Contract.
  - 10.2.3. Any other remedies available in law or equity.

Contract Manager: During its performance of this Contract, Vendor must designate and maintain a primary contract manager responsible for overseeing Vendor's responsibilities under this Contract. 

Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.
