

We can quote estimated delivery times after the repairs are evaluated. Can this section be updated or removed from the contract?
- A.1 Section 6 applies to ordering and delivering of miscellaneous parts for maintenance/repairs done by the Agency at their facility. Refer to 3.1.1.1 paragraph 2 for inspection/repairs timeline for maintenance/repairs/inspections performed by the Vendor at their facility.
