We would like to request consideration of modifying the solicitation to the following which we can meet.

Contract Item #2-Front Loader

3.1.2.2 Front loader must have a minimum lift capacity of 3,060 lbs.

Agency Response: Change specification From: Front loader must have a minimum lift capacity of 3,400 lbs. To: Front loader must have a minimum lift capacity now changed to 3,060 lbs.

3.1.2.4 Explanation of minimum reach at ground level.

Agency Response: Reach at ground level is measuring from the center of the front tires to the bottom front edge of the bucket while sitting level on the ground.

3.1.2.4 Front loader must have a minimum reach of 85 inches at ground level, and a minimum lift height of 116 inches.

Agency Response: (No Change in Specification) a minimum height of 116" inches is 17" inches shorter, and nearly 1.5 feet difference resulting in a much smaller front loader than needed to load and transport dirt and logs onto other equipment.

Contract Item #3-Backhoe

3.1.3.1 Backhoe must have a minimum digging depth of 7ft 10 inches

SPECIFICATIONS

1. **PURPOSE AND SCOPE:** The West Virginia Purchasing Division is soliciting bids on behalf of the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources, Parks and Recreation Section to establish a contract for the one time purchase of a four wheel drive utility tractor with front loader and backhoe for Holly River State Park, 680 State Park Road, Hacker Valley, WV. 26222.

2. **DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions.
 - 2.1 **“Contract Item”** means utility tractor, front loader and backhoe as more fully described by these specifications.

 - 2.2 **“Pricing Page”** means the pages, contained in wvOASIS or attached as Exhibit “A”, upon which Vendor should list its proposed price for the Contract Items.

 - 2.3 **“Solicitation”** means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with goods or services that is published by the Purchasing Division.

 - 2.4 **“Three-point hitch”:** A 3 point hitch is composed of three movable arms. The two lower arms—the hitch lifting arms—are controlled by the hydraulic system, and provide lifting, lowering, and even tilting to the arms. The upper center arm—called the top link—is movable, but is usually not powered by the tractor's hydraulic system. Each arm has an attachment device to connect implements to the hitch.

 - 2.5 **“Category 2, 3 Point Hitch”:** This category is usually intended for tractors 55-95 Horsepower with top link Pins 1" diameter and lift Arm Pins are 1 1/8" diameter.

 - 2.6 **“DUAL MID VALVES”:** Dual mid valves is used for equipping and controlling the front loader on the tractor.

 - 2.7 **“Power Shuttle”:** A power shuttle is an additional unit used in transmissions and is generally used in agricultural tractors. While the vehicle is moving forwards, the driver can pull a lever that makes it stop and go backwards at the same speed. Power Shuttles are also known under various trade names including Power Reverser.

3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

3.1 Mandatory Contract Item Requirements: Contract Item must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements listed below.

3.1.1 Contract Item #1 - Four (4) Wheel Drive Utility Tractor

- 3.1.1.1 Must be a four wheel drive.
- 3.1.1.2 Engine horsepower must a minimum of (55) fifty-five to a maximum of (75) seventy-five horsepower (HP).
- 3.1.1.3 Must have power take off (PTO) with a minimum of (45) forty-five HP to a maximum of (65) sixty-five HP.
- 3.1.1.4 Must have a diesel engine with a minimum of (3) three cylinders.
- 3.1.1.5 Must have power steering.
- 3.1.1.6 Must include a (3) three point hitch with a minimum rating of Category 2 and minimum lift capacity of 3,100 lbs.
- 3.1.1.7 Must be equipped with a Roll-Over Protection System.
- 3.1.1.8 Must be equipped with dual mid-valves with joystick control.
- 3.1.1.9 Must have 6-ply Agricultural (non-turf) weight loaded tires.
- 3.1.1.10 Engine transmission must feature a Power Shuttle.

3.1.2 Contract Item #2 - Front Loader

- 3.1.2.1 Minimum width of front loader must be 70 inches.
- 3.1.2.2 Front loader must have a minimum lift capacity of 3,400 lbs.
- 3.1.2.3 Front loader must have a mechanical self-leveling feature.
- 3.1.2.4 Front loader must have a minimum reach of 85 inches at ground level, and a minimum lift height of 133 inches.
- 3.1.2.5 Front loader must be installed on and integrate with the utility tractor Item 3.1.1 above.

3.1.3 Contract Item #3 - Backhoe

- 3.1.3.1 Backhoe must have a minimum digging depth of 8 feet.
- 3.1.3.2 Backhoe must have a minimum reach of 10 feet and a minimum undercut of 1 foot.
- 3.1.3.3 Backhoe bucket must be a minimum of 18”.
- 3.1.3.4 Backhoe must have a minimum boom lift capacity of 800 lbs.
- 3.1.3.5 Backhoe must have a minimum bucket digging force of 3,500 lbs.
- 3.1.3.6 Backhoe must be installed on and integrate with the utility tractor, Item 3.1.1 above.

4. CONTRACT AWARD:

4.1 Contract Award: The Contract is intended to provide Agencies with a purchase price for the Contract Items. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides the Contract Items meeting the required specifications for the lowest TOTAL BID AMOUNT as shown on the Pricing Page.

4.2 Pricing Page: Vendor should complete the Pricing Page by filling in the lump sum unit cost and extended cost for the Utility Tractor including the Front Loader and Backhoe. Vendor should complete the Pricing Page in full as failure to complete the Pricing Page in its entirety may result in Vendor's bid being disqualified.

5. PAYMENT:

5.1 Payment: Vendor shall accept payment in accordance with the payment procedures of the State of West Virginia.

6. DELIVERY AND RETURN:

6.1 Shipment and Delivery: Vendor shall ship the Contract Items immediately after being awarded this Contract and receiving a purchase order. Vendor shall deliver the Contract Items within ten (10) calendar days after receiving a Purchase Order. Contract Items must be delivered to Agency at Holly River State Park, 680 State Park Road, Hacker Valley, WV 26222, contact Superintendent Ben McCune 304-777-7737 for delivery arrangements.

Equipment is to be delivered in accordance with Manufactures ready for delivery and operational condition per the Manufactures recommendations. This includes but is not limited to:

1. Engine Oil level checked and ok
2. Steering housing fluid level ok
3. Battery fluid ok
4. Radiator coolant level ok
5. Belt tensions ok
6. Hydraulic lines, fittings, connections and components checked for leaks
7. Hydraulic reservoirs are filled to correct operating levels.
8. As required by the Manufacture for delivery to the customer

6.2 Late Delivery: The Agency placing the order under this Contract must be notified in writing if the shipment of the Contract Items will be delayed for any reason. Any delay in delivery that could cause harm to an Agency will be grounds for cancellation of the Contract, and/or obtaining the Contract Items from a third party.

Any Agency seeking to obtain the Contract Items from a third party under this provision must first obtain approval of the Purchasing Division.

6.3 Delivery Payment/Risk of Loss: Vendor shall deliver the Contract Items F.O.B. destination to the Agency's location.

6.4 Return of Unacceptable Items: If the Agency deems the Contract Items to be unacceptable, the Contract Items shall be returned to Vendor at Vendor's expense and with no restocking charge. Vendor shall either make arrangements for the return within five (5) days of being notified that items are unacceptable, or permit the Agency to arrange for the return and reimburse Agency for delivery expenses. If the original packaging cannot be utilized for the return, Vendor will supply the Agency with appropriate return packaging upon request. All returns of unacceptable items shall be F.O.B. the Agency's location.
