


### REQUESTED MODIFICATIONS

- I. Vendor requests the following modifications be made to the General Terms and Conditions provided by the State of West Virginia.
  - A. Section 20 of the General Terms and Conditions entitled "Governing Law" is modified to include the following:

Notwithstanding the application of West Virginia law, nothing herein shall be deemed a waiver of, and Vendor expressly reserves, any rights and defenses available to it under the laws of the State of Utah.

B. Section 30 of the General Terms and Conditions entitled "Privacy, Security, and Confidentiality" is modified to include the following:

Agency acknowledges that Vendor is a governmental entity subject to the Utah Government Records Access and Management Act, Utah Code Ann., Section 63G-2-101 et seq., as amended ("GRAMA"); that certain records within Vendor's possession or control, including without limitation, the agreement (but not including (i) proprietary software, (ii) materials to which access is limited by the laws of copyright or patent, or (iii) personal health information), may be subject to public disclosure; and that Vendor's confidentiality obligations shall be subject in all respects to compliance with GRAMA. Pursuant to Section 6G3-2-309 of GRAMA, any confidential information provided to Vendor that Agency believes should be protected from disclosure must be accompanied by a written claim of confidentiality and a concise statement of reasons supporting such claim.

C. Section 36 of the General Terms and Conditions entitled "Indemnification" is modified to include the following:

Vendor is a Utah state governmental entity under the Governmental Immunity Act of Utah, Utah Code Ann., Section 63G-7-101 et seq., as amended (the "Act"). As necessary, Vendor will assert any protections, rights, or defenses applicable to Vendor under the Act, including without limitation, the provisions of Section 63G-7-604 regarding limitation of judgments. Any indemnity obligations of Vendor contained in the General Terms and Conditions are subject to the Act and further limited to the negligent acts or omissions of Vendor or its personnel.

- II. Vendor requests the following modifications be made to the HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (the "BAA") provided by the State of West Virginia.
  - A. The fourth paragraph of Section 4.1. of the BAA entitled "Notification of Breach" is replaced with the following:

All reasonable costs incurred by Agency in response to a Security Incident, Breach, or unauthorized use or disclosure of PHI or confidential data by Associate shall be borne by the Associate; notwithstanding the foregoing the parties agree to negotiate in good faith to determine what actions are reasonable in response to a Security Incident or Breach or incident involving unauthorized used or disclosure of PHI or confidential data.

B. Section 4.m. of the BAA entitled "Assistance in Litigation or Administrative Proceedings" is replaced with the following:

The Associate shall make itself and any subcontractors, workforce or agents assisting Associate in the performance of its obligations under this Agreement, reasonably available to the Agency at no cost to the Agency to testify as witnesses, or otherwise, in the event of litigation or administrative proceedings being commenced against the Agency, its officers or employees based upon claimed violations of HIPAA by Associate, or claimed violations by Associate of HIPAA regulations or other laws relating to security and privacy, which involve inaction or actions by the Associate, except where Associate or its subcontractor, workforce or agent is named as an adverse party.

### STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA Purchasing Division

## PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

**MANDATE:** Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

**EXCEPTION:** The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

#### **DEFINITIONS:**

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (*W. Va. Code* §61-5-3) that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.

- 3. Qualifications: Rocky Mountain Cancer Data Systems (RMCDS) has been in business since 1968 and has been providing Cancer Registry Software since 1986. Our Director, Barbara Nicole Aagaard has been a Certified Tumor Registrar (CTR) since 1997. RMCDS staff have been working in cancer registry for over 70 years combined.

#### 4. Mandatory Requirements:

4.1.1 This agreements will include one (1) central registry site license and (20) twenty site licenses for hospitals who use the software to abstract cancer cases for submission to the West Virginia State Cancer Registry.

The hospital software and central registry software have the ability to import and export data in the record layout specified by the North American Association of Central Cancer Registries (NAACCR).

4.1.1.1 The system will be fully operational on or before October 31, 2016. This includes the ability to abstract cancer data and warehousing the existing data and online user training for WVCR and hospital staff to use the software. On-site training will be scheduled.

RMCDS provides software updates to RMCDS users when necessary for NAACCR record layout updates, as well as NAACCR, CDC (NPCR) annual data submissions.

- 4.1.2 RMCDS software is compatible with Windows 7 and newer operating systems, Pentium 450 HZ, 64MB RAM with no additional third party software needed. The data warehouse runs on New Technology File System (NTFS) without additional party software or database needed.
- 4.1.3.1 RMCDS has the ability to receive and store NAACCR format records, check for duplicate source records, determine if the source record is for a new or existing patient,



assign a central tumor registry number to the source records, determine source records to consolidate, perform single record edit checks on source records, and edit data extracts.

- 4.1.4 RMCDS is capable of extracting abstract level ("pristine" or consolidated") cases compromising approximately 400,000 consolidated records from the existing dataset and load both the abstract level and consolidated cases into the RMCDS software system within fifteen (15) business days of receiving a Notice to Proceed letter. RMCDS follows the NAACCR data standards and data dictionary standards for Cancer Registries.
- 4.1.5 RMCDS will ensure that the cancer registry system will be up and operational to abstract cancer data to include the migration of all legacy data in the current system within fifteen (15) business days of the Notice to Proceed letter.
- 4.1.6 RMCDS will attend at least 2 meeting via teleconference and provide technical direction with the agency and subsequent Vendor should the contract be terminated.
- 4.1.7 RMCDS provides customer support via telephone from 11:00 am 7:00 pm Eastern Standard Time (EST), Monday through Friday excluding State Holidays.
- 4.1.8 RMCDS provides system documentation and help files. RMCDS will provide a minimum of two (2) days onsite training in the West Virginia Cancer Registry for a minimum of three (3) WVCR staff on all functionality of the RMCDS system. Schedule will be mutually agreed upon and located at the WVCR, 350 Capitol St., Charleston, WV 25301.
- 4.1.9 See attached documentation 'Requested Modifications'.

#### **4.2 System Tools/Features**

- 4.2.1 The RMCDS software interface creates subsets of data for both internal and external use within the system. RMCDS software exports subsets as either American Standard Code for Information Interexchange (ASCII) comma delimited format files or in NAACCR format file.
- 4.2.1.1 RMCDS software has a variety of options available for subsets to include: creating, sorting, hand picking, combining, displaying, and deleting data elements and/or complete subsets. Our subsets are equal to Exhibit 1.
- 4.2.2 RMCDS software accommodates the addition of custom abstracting variables that can be in subset selection and queried. For example, RMCDS software can incorporate NDI Linkage, NDI death year linked and linkage status variables.
- 4.2.3 RMCDS software generates frequency, cross tab, two-way and three-way cross tab, listing, listing with variables, chosen variable listing, summary, survival and



Kaplan Meier survival, incidence observed and expected, age-specific incident, and age-adjusted incident report types.

- 4.2.4 RMCDS software includes reporting features that allow the user to select any and all fields in the Data Warehouse, including custom variables.
- 4.2.5 RMCDS software contains utilities maintain a physician file. Equal to exhibit\_2.
- 4.2.6 RMCDS software provides menu level software backups and restores. Equal to exhibit 3.
- 4.2.7 RMCDS software contains menu driven, automatic processing of an external ASCII file of death linkage (death certificate file). This is a custom program and is normally updated annually.
- 4.2.7.1 While processing, RMCDS software determines true matches using name, social security number, and date of birth and automatically updates the database with the information in the death file (vital stats, date of death, cause of death, autopsy, state of birth, country of birth, state of death, country of death, death certificate number, follow-up source, occupation code, and industry code).
- 4.2.7.2 During processing, RMCDS software determines possible matched and writes out the possible matches on a report for manual case review.
- 4.2.7.3 RMCDS software determines non-matched cases and writes out the non-matched death certificate data on a separate report to be used during Death Clearance follow-back activities. Equal to Exhibit 4.
- 4.2.8 RMCDS software performs menu driven, automatic software updates via connection through secure File Transfer Protocol site and automatically downloads and processes the update files. Equal to Exhibit 5.
- 4.2.9 RMCDS software performs menu driven, automatic processing of records according to the NAACCR Duplicate Protocol. During Processing, the central registry must compare the entire dataset to itself to identify potential duplicate records of the same tumor. The central registry has the ability to select a minimum of 15 sets of match criteria. Equal to Exhibit\_6.
- 4.2.10 RMCDS software provides a minimum of two types of role based security, administrator and abstractor.
- 4.2.11 RMCDS software maintains privacy of all information through access control where only authorized users can access the system. This is in conjunction with the users network security.



- 4.2.12 RMCDS software tracks and creates a HIPAA report to identify anyone who has made changes to patient data and when within the scope of 24 previous months. Equal to Exhibit\_7.
- 4.2.13 RMCDS software displays when users log into and out of the system with the last 24 months.

### 4.3 Implementation and Transition


- 4.3.1 RMCDS software will be fully operational and performing properly upon implementation; including any system software or services that will be required to facilitate the implementation and management of the software.
- 4.3.2 RMCDS software does not require Information Technology State Staff to support the system once it is implemented.
- 4.3.2.1 RMCDS software has been created to utilize State Cancer Registry Staff, including CTRs. RMCDS does not train for CTR certification.
- 4.3.3 RMCDS staff will accept testing of the system with RMCDS technical staff to provide assistance in demonstrating the functions of the system.
- 4.3.4 RMCDS will provide weekly status updates during the implementation via teleconferencing using agreed upon reporting format and meeting times.
- 4.3.5 RMCDS staff members will sign a HIPPA and/or Business Associate form.
