"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, fallure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or fallure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

Lone Star Auctioneers is driven by our own high standards and is more than capable of performing to the highest standards required by the State of West Virginia. We commit the service of courteous, competent and friendly staff to maximize revenues, maintain immaculate records and minimize

problems from all our activities. We will designate and make key personnel available to perform the requirements of this contract throughout their employment. We will recruit and train additional staff as volume demands.

All current Lone Star Auctioneers employees have undergone thorough background checks through the United States Marshals Service and the Dallas and Fort Worth Police Departments including the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) and the Texas Crime Information Center (TCIC) as well as The Integrity Center. All future employees will undergo rigorous background checks prior to their employment and utilization under this and our other contracts.

Experience with Asset Types & Services Similar to the Requirements of the RFQ

Lone Star Auctioneers has been performing the exact same turn-key services i.e., transporting, storing and selling unclaimed and seized valuables for federal and state agency clients for 28 years in either live, webcast or online auctions. We have sold over fifty four and a half million dollars (\$54,500,000) in forfeited and unclaimed jewelry, gemstones, precious metals, collectibles and other valuables including the contents of safe deposit boxes. With this level of experience, Lone Star Auctioneers may have more specific knowledge and experience with unclaimed, seized, forfeited and abandoned jeweiry and valuables than any other auction company in the USA.

Almost without exception, Lone Star achieved in excess of 100% of appraised value for each auction ranging from 104% to 185%. It is important to note that the assets sold in these auctions were appraised by independent, certified appraisers contracted primarily by the selling agency. Lone Star does not have appraisers on staff, but we work with a number of qualified independent appraisers. We will therefore subcontract these responsibilities to asset specific appraisers, as necessary.

We have many years of experience identifying appropriate appraisal professionals and arranging for appraisals on behalf government agencies for a variety of assets. The assets appraised have varied from jewelry and gemstones, numismatic coins, stamps, sports cards and memorabilia, fine wines, pre-Columbian textiles, a 16th century Greek folio, and other exotic and esoteric items.

Lone Star staff has been responsible for lotting, tagging, photographing, secure packaging and sealing of each lot for each auction of unclaimed or forfeited assets. We have also been responsible for the audio and video recording of all these processes from the opening of the original shipped package, throughout the intake, inventory and appraisal processes in our secure, dedicated appraisal room.

Initial inventory and appraisal oversight includes all tagging, packaging, sealing and preparation for secure vault storage. Our staff has worked closely with independent certified appraisers while overseeing appraisal in our facility.

We have been responsible for all aspects of the physical security of all assets under every unclaimed or forfeited assets contract. This includes secure, insured transportation of assets, security for assets in our Class II bank vault and security in our appraisal room. Lone Star has been solely responsible for the security of all assets during all live auction previews, overnight storage at the sale site and during auction periods.

Our staff has been responsible for delivering all purchased assets to the respective buyers at live auctions and for shipping assets to the successful bidders in our online auctions. Lone Star has never lost an asset nor has the accounting ever been off by even one penny for either buyer or seller.

Recent and comparable contracts which Lone Star currently holds or has held include the following:

NOTE: The services we provide for State of West Virginia Unclaimed Property are the same as those performed for the states of Alabama, Montana, Utah, and South Carolina. The states of California, Texas and Colorado had appraisals done by their appraisers without our involvement. California and Colorado shipped their unclaimed property to Lone Star Auctioneers to store, photograph and prepare for auction. We then shipped their assets to the sale sites in Beverly Hills and Denver for each auction. We were on premises at the auction venue to receive the shipments from Brinks Armored Car service immediately prior to preview and auction days. We picked Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts unclaimed property up in Austin and transported it under guard to auction venues in Austin, Houston, Fort Worth/Dallas and San Antonio to be sold.

Services we provide for West Virginia include:

Receipt, custody and secure vault storage and online auctions of unclaimed contents from safe deposit boxes;

Asset verification and identification of assets which warrant appraisal; appraisal facilitation and oversight;

Lotting and photography of assets for ongoing weekly online auctions;

Advertising and promotion of auctions;

Website design, creation of auction links and submission for approval prior to posting; upload and conduct the auctions;

Provide technical support for buyers and seller;

Register and screen bidders for previous negative purchase history (block bidders permanently for non-payment); Monitor and close the auction;

Send email notifications to successful bidders;

Collect auction proceeds,

Contact slow-pays;

Send receipt-of-payment notifications to buyers and seller;

Balance auction transactions and submit reports and net auction proceeds after auction payments are due;

ACH monthly gross proceeds and corresponding reports;

Invoice W VA STO; and

Ship purchases to buyers.

THE PROPOSED WORK PLAN

When packages are received they will be opened under recorded audio and video surveillance in our sterile appraisal room. All assets will be removed under the camera, and the asset packets placed in sequence according to the manifest. All packets will be verified and recorded, the Property ID numbers verified and recorded, and the assets will be verified.

Using the shipping manifest and spreadsheet provided by the STO, the valuables are removed from original packaging, counted and verified. Physical assets are verified against descriptions and exceptions, if any, to the manifest are noted. This provides an opportunity for us to discover any lots of exceptional character or value which might have been overlooked previously. The Treasurer's representative would be notified of any discrepancies immediately for resolution.

After asset verification, the assets would be examined by our unclaimed property staff, testing stones, checking hallmarks, metallurgical stamps, manufacturers' marks, etc. Our staff would determine which assets warranted evaluation by professional appraisers experienced in those types of assets. Once sufficient assets were accumulated for appraisal, staff would make arrangements with the appropriate appraisers. All evaluations and appraisals would be performed at our expense and at our location.

Packets which contain items or groups of items that need to be more thoroughly evaluated will be opened and a more detailed examination will be made by an appraiser. Possible metals stamped with indicia such as 14K, bars and ingots will be tested for content and purity, etc. Possible gemstones will be tested and described. Watches will be evaluated for genuineness and market value. Coins and currency will be evaluated by a coin and currency specialist. These appraisals will be used to determine individual lots and groupings into lots and to place emphasis on the items in the auction. These findings will be integrated into item descriptions as well.

The descriptions will be based on the initial descriptions from the property spreadsheet provided by the STO. As the appraiser provides additional descriptions or corrections, we will update the spreadsheet description fields. When the spreadsheet is uploaded into the online auctions, the most complete and accurate information will be available to bidders.

Video (with audio) recordings are logged-in with the assets' ID numbers, the time and date of opening and are kept for the full course of the contract. The recordings are available to the client at any time and can be forwarded upon completion of the contract if desired. We would consider those tapes to be West Virginia property if requested by the STO.

Marilyn Burgess is responsible for setting minimum bids and starting prices for auctions at LoneStarOnline.com. She has set prices for tens of thousands of online lots in the past eighteen years. Her experience as a practicing auctioneer, selling and overseeing the sale of over

\$519,000,000 in assets, has given her an excellent feel for starting prices and bid behavior of online buyers. She will also be responsible for setting starting prices based on valuations provided from the appraisers.

Group the contents into lots to maximize the bids received

With the approval of the Unclaimed Property Division, packets with low or minimum value whose value is too low to generate online bids will be sorted into like or similar affinity groups to be combined in lots made up of a number of box holder's property. These will then be assigned to lots taking care to balance the respective box holders' contribution to the lot by approximate value or, in the absence of any appreciable value, by some equitable measure such as weight or volume and to distribute the revenues proportionately. We expect to fine tune this approach to try to account equitably and rationally for box holder property.

Face value, non-numismatic coins are an easier matter. We will account for the face value by Property ID number and account for the pro rata proceeds from such a lot based on the respective face values. If Box holder A has 75¢ face value in a non-numismatic lot and Box holder B has 25¢ in face value and the lot sells for \$2.00, then A gets \$1.50 and B gets \$.50.

Other types of low/minimum value assets will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis. We will try our best to be fair and equitable in valuing such items and applying revenues appropriately.

Preparing Assets for Auction

This process is performed in a special sterile, secure room within Lone Star's secure offices. Only Lone Star employees are allowed into this room during the processing. Strict dual control is maintained at all times. The functions are:

- Sequencing of packets in numerical order, facilitate flow to all other stations;
- Unpacking, assembling and verifying packets and assigning lots for digital photography, placement of lots on individual trays to maintain identity and integrity of each lot with lot number on each tray;
- Arranging of lots on backgrounds and appropriate photo stands for digital photography for the web site;
- Tagging, sealing, packaging; and
- Data entry of verified lots into auction database, office liaison informs Unclaimed Property of exceptions/corrections, and data is proofed.

Each lot, whether it is the contents of one packet, a portion of a packet or a group of packets belonging to the same box holder, is placed in a discreet, separate container during processing to assure the integrity of each lot. Each receives its own unique lot number and tag to assure that the distinct and separate identities of items will be maintained in the event of claim (of either property or auction proceeds) on a particular lot. The lot number for each packet is entered into a corresponding field for that packet to assure that the lot number, packet number and box holder ID is forever associated with the lot number. Large lots are placed on a tray (or on multiple trays).

Once verification has occurred, the lots are moved to the next station for photography. Lots which have been verified are individually arranged against a neutral background and are photographed using a high resolution digital camera. Images are taken in lot-order sequence showing lot number

tags in each image. Attention to detail, knowledge of composition, lighting and photography are essential in this phase.

Following photography, lots proceed to the area where they are sealed in bags with Lone Star lot tags on the inside of the bags. These are then placed into archive boxes in sequential order, and the boxes are marked with the lot number series for the contents of that box. Only a workable portion of the assets are ever out of the vault at any given time. This assures that lot tags cannot be misplaced, lost or inadvertently switched.

Throughout the process from the time we take possession of the merchandise until the final reports are prepared and sent to the Treasurer's representative, each packet and each sub-packet will be tracked with the Property ID number which has been assigned to each respectively. When the completed spreadsheet with packet numbers, lot numbers and additional appraiser descriptions is uploaded into the online software, the Property ID number is entered into the Consignor field. From that point forward, the lot is forever associated with that Property ID number (box holder) as the Consignor. All reports you will receive will attach the Consignor (Property ID number) to each lot sold or unsold. The Treasurer will have enduring electronic and printed reports that reflect the correct box holder ownership of each lot sold by Lone Star Auctioneers.

Accountability

To create reports which prorate the percentage of a lot's value for grouped line items, our staff developed a report which calculates the percentage of return on an item-by-item basis. After an auction, the revenue for a lot is reinserted into the spreadsheet, and proportionate revenue is calculated for each line item balanced to the selling price of that lot. We will modify this spreadsheet to account for the allocation of revenue to each box holder of combined lots.

The STO will receive reports that clearly account for all lots, all consignors (box holders) and for all buyers.

Throughout the process from the time we take possession of the merchandise until the final reports are prepared and sent to the designated Treasurer's representative, each packet and each sub-packet will be tracked with the Property ID number which has been assigned to each respectively by the Unclaimed Property Division. When the completed spreadsheet with packet numbers, lot numbers and additional appraiser descriptions is uploaded into the online software, the Property ID number is entered into the *Consignor* field. From that point forward, the lot and each item is forever associated with that Property ID number (box holder) as the Consignor. All reports you will receive will attach the Consignor ID (Property ID number) to each lot and item sold or unsold.

Online auctions for the STO

We propose to offer West Virginia Unclaimed Property in a series of overlapping auctions each lasting ten days. A given auction would go live, and bidding would begin on a Friday and continue for ten days closing on the second Monday following launch date. Since most online bidding of this type occurs on weekends and 24 to 48 hours prior to the close of the auction, most bidders will come to the site after the next auction is posted. Thus, the first thing they encounter coming to your auction,

which is closing, is your next auction's merchandise. This creates an immediate awareness of the upcoming items and continues to build a market for West Virginia unclaimed property auctions.

We will sell the full current inventory of unclaimed property within the required time frame of the contract and would continue to sell your unclaimed property as it escheats to the state and falls into your possession. The most advantageous method for the STO would be to maintain a presence online with ongoing auctions.

Advertising and Promotion

Lone Star Auctioneers has a full-time advertising specialist on staff. Karen Plunk routinely designs, prepares, and places all auction advertising and promotion with the exception of any specific advertising the client wishes to place. Lone Star absorbs the cost for all such advertising that we develop and place. The specifics of the advertising campaign for the West Virginia Unclaimed Property are addressed below.

All advertising and promotional materials are submitted to the STO designated personnel for approval before being sent to media outlets unless the client otherwise specifies. At the end of each advertising campaign, our advertising specialist will prepare a media packet and send it to the designated representative of the Treasurer showing proof of advertising.

We strongly encourage the Treasurer's Information Office to prepare and disseminate promotional materials about the Unclaimed Property auctions to various media around the state and national news organizations. Such materials will have much more impact and generate much more publicity than the same material issued by a *for profit* entity. We will issue press releases about the program to media, but experience has repeatedly demonstrated our assertion about government promotion and *for profit* efforts.

Classified Newspaper Advertising

Lone Star Auctioneers will submit an advertising plan for review and approval once the volume and value of assets are known. We will place classified advertising in the Charleston <u>Gazette</u> and other newspapers as merchandise warrants. We will also place classified advertising in other West Virginia newspapers statewide as the value of assets warrant. The frequency of additional state-wide advertising will depend on the timing and occurrence of the online auctions and the value of the items up for auction.

Electronic Auction Brochures

The most effective advertising Lone Star Auctioneers will do on behalf of the West Virginia unclaimed property auctions will be frequent email notifications to our existing internet bidders who number over 103,000 and who are registered and approved to bid in our online auctions at www.LoneStarOnline.com.

Those bidders have purchased over \$13,250,000 in unclaimed and forfeited property.

We email electronic auction brochures to our registered online bidders on a regular basis.

To receive these emails, a bidder has to choose the option to receive them, and all registered bidders

have the option to opt-out at any time with a click of a button.

Reference Publications

Lone Star utilizes two additional sources of reference material which greatly enhance our ability to reach the specialty markets mentioned above.

- One is a publication which lists all regularly published trade journals, magazines, newspapers, tabloids, etc. in the U.S.
- It describes the readership, circulation and frequency and gives full contact information.
- The other is a source book providing the names, phone numbers and addresses of collectors, newsletters, museums, galleries and associations for a seemingly endless array of special interest categories of jewelry, coins, stamps, artwork, collectibles, autographs, memorabilia, antiques, etc.
- Each category is divided into very specific areas of interest.

These publications make our approach much more informed organized and targeted when finding markets for particularly unusual items. We prefer not to provide the names of these publications in this proposal but will gladly provide them to the evaluation committee if requested.

Internet Advertising

Another important method used to advertise and promote the West Virginia Unclaimed Property auction will be the purchase of key words on the major search engines. Key words provide a significant advantage in the creation of highly visible online auctions.

Auction Calendars, Trade Publications and Affinity Websites

For particularly valuable pieces or as merchandise warrants, Lone Star will advertise West Virginia's online auctions in appropriate trade publications and/or have them featured on those publications' websites or affinity sites pertinent to the items. For example, we currently have a 6.2 CT Fancy Yellow Diamond, Grade VVS, which we had certified by the Gemological Institute of America. It is scheduled for an upcoming online auction for the State of Alabama. It's retail value is approximately \$65,000.

Qualifications

- 3.1 The Texas Auctioneers' Licenses which are maintained by Lone Star's professional auctioneers are reciprocal with the State of West Virginia's auctioneer licenses. We will comply with this and any other authorizations, licenses, permits and certifications which are required by law. Lone Star Auctioneers currently uses and will continue to use a Federal Firearms License holder to sell firearms for the State of West Virginia in accordance with federal law if we are awarded the contract.
- 3.2 Lone Star Auctioneers has conducted auctions of unclaimed property from safe deposit boxes since 1991. We have conducted **online** auctions of unclaimed contents of safe deposit boxes since June 1, 2004, approximately 13 years.
 - In the past three years we have sold over \$1,000,000 in valuable assets for state unclaimed property programs on LoneStarOnline.com. The number of lots sold in that time is 14,148 lots

of unclaimed property. This number represents a fraction of the number of individual items sold since so many lots are composed of a number of items which are grouped into lots.

3.3 Our References (Exhibit B) will confirm our performance and the results achieved through our online auctions on behalf of our clients. We encourage you to contact each of our references.

SECTION II – MISCELLANEOUS, contains a set of reports which combine to form a detailed audit trail, supporting materials which illustrate Lone Star's Licensing, Certifications, Insurance, plus a full auction listing, a full lot listing, a number of screen shots of unclaimed property which has been sold on LoneStarOnline, plus a full set of auction reports for the review of the evaluation committee.

Mandatory Requirements:

- **4.1.1** Lone Star Auctioneers is a full-service auction firm with the capability to conduct a wide range of auctions.
- 4.1.2 We affirm that Lone Star Auctioneers will furnish all material, labor, equipment, and supplies necessary to perform the services required, unless otherwise specified or agreed in writing by the parties.
- **4.1.3** We affirm that Lone Star will comply with this requirement as detailed on pages 9 10 of this Bid Response in the section which pertains to vault storage, appraisal room, recordings of asset processing, etc.
- 4.1.4 Lone Star has procedures in place, plus the hardware and software capabilities to ensure the security and recoverability of data under performance of this RFQ.

Spectrum Net Designs hosts our online server, provide 24 hour technical support and monitoring and provide our customizations and periodic upgrades. Lone Star owns all our server hardware and software. We have a state-of-the-art server with Raid 5 and multiple redundancies, as well as, a backup server. If an entire server crashes, LoneStarOnline.com continues to operate with almost zero downtime.

All hardware, software, and our two cloud servers are housed in a state-of-the-art data center which is served by a backup generator capable of powering the entire data center in the event of a complete power outage. There are three separate independent internet trunks serving the data center from three different major U.S. cities. These are tied directly into the Internet source and are not served by ISP resellers.

We have the following bandwidth and support available at all times:

- 400GB of Bandwidth per month with unlimited throughput
- 4U of space in our data center cabinet
- Managing of server updates
- Managing of software updates
- Daily backup of files

Server Hosting

Spectrum Net Designs Tier 1 Data Center is one of the leading facilities of its kind in North American with redundant and reliable networks, backed by world class engineering and operations expertise. The Data Center is self-contained with the corporate headquarters, featuring its own power, fire suppression system, heating and cooling system, security and backup generator. A top-of-the-line backup system offers multiple redundant connections to the Internet backbone through several carriers located in different cities.

Spectrum Net Designs Data Center services come with superior customer support seven days a week, constant network monitoring and incredibly fast connections. Information in the Data Center is safe, secure and easily accessible by customers — even in the event of a power outage or the failure of a major backbone carrier. Spectrum offers daily backups, routine maintenance and server statistics, system monitoring, troubleshooting and much more.

- **4.1.5** We affirm that Lone Star will comply with this requirement. This process is detailed in the section <u>The Proposed Work Plan</u> on pages 5 6 of this proposal.
- **4.1.6** We affirm that Lone Star will comply with this requirement.

Experience with Appraisals

Lone Star Auctioneers has been transporting, storing and selling seized and unclaimed valuables such as jewelry, precious metals, coins, etc., and quite a bit of minimally valued assets, for federal, state and local agencies since 1989. The vast majority of this merchandise has been seized and forfeited assets on behalf of the U. S. Marshals Service (under the National Jewelry Contract) and the contents of unclaimed safe deposit boxes for the states of Texas, California, Alabama, South Carolina, Utah and Colorado. In each of these contracts, the assets were appraised prior to their being sold at auction, and although we were not responsible for appraising the assets, we did work very closely with the appraisers for the USMS and had frequent and meaningful contact with the appraisers for the various state Unclaimed Property contracts.

Mr. Randy Cook and Ms. Suzanne Cook of Southwest Gold and Silver Exchange in Fort Worth are the appraisers whom we propose to use for the evaluation of STO Unclaimed Property. They provided appraisal services under the original WVA STO contract and will continue to provide their skilled services under a new Lone Star contract with the STO.

The Cooks have done appraisals around the U.S., routinely dealing with estates, attorneys and trustees. They currently conduct the appraisals of unclaimed property for the Alabama and Utah unclaimed property auctions and conducted the appraisals for South Carolina's unclaimed property. They both have tremendous experience and a great breadth of knowledge of precious metal, coins, jewelry and other valuables.

Lone Star works with independent appraisers. We consider it a gross conflict of interest for an auctioneer to be the sole determiner of value for assets which that auctioneer is expected to sell.

4.1.7 Once verification has occurred, the lots are photographed for online sale. Lots which have been verified are arranged one at a time against a neutral background and are photographed using a high resolution digital camera in lot order sequence showing lot number tags in each image.

The descriptions will be derived from the basic property spreadsheet which is provided by the Treasurer. As the appraiser provides additional descriptions or corrections, we will update the spreadsheet description fields. When the spreadsheet is uploaded into the online auctions, the most complete and accurate information will be available to bidders.

Please review the sample screen shots of unclaimed property for examples of photographic images and descriptions created for LoneStarOnline auctions. Screen shots may be found following Exhibit B – References and Site Requirements.

- 4.1.8 Lone Star acknowledges, understands and will comply with this requirement. With the consent of the Treasurer's representative, Lone Star will assign starting prices and minimum selling prices on the items offered in each auction. We will monitor auctions for the STO and will reduce starting prices on re-list items which are receiving no bids.
- 4.1.9 The screen shots which are submitted following Exhibit B References and Site Requirements illustrate the information available for an online auction, including the complete lot listing for a current West Virginia auction, plus listings of individual lots. One detailed individual lot listing illustrates the description, photographs, payment methods, Terms and Conditions, shipping information and full disclosure of information for buyers' use and understanding. Other sample listings provide an abbreviated view of several unclaimed property lots sold.

Proprietary Domain Name for Exclusive Use on West Virginia State Treasurer's Website
In the event Lone Star Auctioneers is the successful proposer for this contract, we purchased the domain www.WestVirginiaUnclaimedProperty.org for use on the Treasurer's website. With the Treasurer's approval, this will provide a link to STO auctions without giving the appearance of endorsing any particular private sector company. Naturally, we would be pleased to provide a link to LoneStarOnline.com for the Treasurer's webpage as the successful contractor.

- 4.1.10 The most effective advertising Lone Star Auctioneers will do on behalf of the West Virginia unclaimed property auctions will be frequent email notifications to our existing internet bidders who currently number over 103,000. These are individuals who are registered and approved to bid in our online auctions at www.LoneStarOnline.com.
- 4.1.11 Shipping, insurance and handling costs are calculated according to a shipping fee chart posted in conjunction with each lot. A link to the shipping chart is imbedded in the information for each lot. Those costs are added to invoices and paid by each respective buyer. A shipping fee chart is available on the page of each lot in an unclaimed property auction.
- **4.1.12** Lone Star Auctioneers will comply with the requirements of the W.VA code as cited. We have obtained a copy of Senate Bill No. 149 which modifies section 8A-5, and will sell to buyers who qualify to purchase firearms under the terms of the Code.

Firearms may only be shipped from our FFL dealer to FFL licensed firearms dealers by next day air and observing strict requirements for shipping. Eligible buyers may pick up firearms at Lone Star's FFL associate with identity confirmation using a valid government issued photo ID and confirmation of age over 18.

4.1.13 System capabilities for inventory management include a secure data management system, strict facility security and dual-control inventory management procedures which are summarized as follows:

Inventory data will be maintained in Excel spreadsheet format which is backed up at regular intervals on our secure server. A read-only copy of the original inventory as well as worksheets which have been revised or re-formatted to meet the needs of different auction and reporting functions will be maintained as additional back up files. The Excel file will be imported into our auction software and will be exported for reporting purposes once an auction is reconciled.

Procedures for physical inventory management are in place and fully functional. Lone Star staff members who handle unclaimed property assets are carefully trained in security and asset management procedures which ensure the integrity and security of assets at all times.

4.1.14 We affirm that Lone Star will comply with this requirement. We monitor for such items as contraband, counterfeit and items which are otherwise illegal to sell (e.g. ivory, blood diamonds, fakes and forgeries). In addition, we are sensitive to the potential that controversial items, such as engraved military medals, Nazi paraphernalia and other items would inflame public opinion surrounding the state's unclaimed property auctions. We will notify the STO of the presence of such items.

Other items for which we screen are cigarette lighters, perfume and flammable items which are hazardous material (*HAZMAT*) and cannot be shipped, even by the STO. The fines for shipping such items are significant, even if inadvertently or innocently done.

- **4.1.15** Lone Star has the capacity and ability to conduct the number of auctions specified and proposed. We affirm that Lone Star will comply with this requirement. We will offer our recommendations based on our experience.
- **4.1.16** We affirm that Lone Star will comply with this requirement. The Auction Results Spreadsheet which is described earlier in this proposal will provide all the detailed data required by the STO. This report is provided in Excel format, the same format as the inventory which comes from the STO to the contractor.
- 4.1.17 Lone Star Auctioneers will prepare and submit the following reports with sale proceeds:
 - **4.1.17.1** Auction Status Report a complete detailed accounting of total sales, sales tax, buyers premium, expenses, total due from buyers, total paid by buyers, total commissions earned, net due to state, etc.
 - **4.1.17.2** Consignor Final Statement Report a lot by lot summary for each individual consignor

- of buyer, company, address, telephone, winning bid price, tax, and total amount due by lot number.
- **4.1.17.3** Consignor Summary Report a line item report by Consignor # (Property ID #) with total sales by consignor, commissions by consignor, other fees or expenses and total amount due for the auction.
- **4.1.17.4** Lot Sales Report a report in lot number order with a description, the buyer and the winning bid for each lot.
- 4.1.17.5 Unsold Lot Report a list of lots that were not sold and/or collected in the auction.
- **4.1.17.6** Active Buyers Report a list of buyers in buyer number order with their name, address, telephone and fax numbers, user name and total amount purchased.
- **4.1.17.**7 Buyer Payment Report same information as Active Buyers Report but with actual payment received and payment type.
- 4.1.17.8 Auction Results Spreadsheet this report provides separate worksheets sorted by lot number and by SD Box Number (or other identifying number designated by the STO). The column headings and data may be customized to the STO's needs. Column headings from a typical Auction Results Spreadsheet include, but are not limited to the following:


Description Notes

- 4.1.18 As bidding ends on a lot, the word "completed" appears and bids can no longer be placed on that lot. After a few seconds, the lot automatically disappears from the auction page. At the conclusion of bidding on all the lots, the sold lots would be viewed via the Completed link on the Treasurer's web page.
- **4.1.19** Lone Star will comply with this requirement as detailed previously; we have extensive experience with other entities' similar requirements.
- **4.1.20** Lone Star Auctioneers employees and their family members are prohibited from bidding on West Virginia STO auction items.
- **4.1.21** We affirm that Lone Star will comply with this requirement. We have a current Business Registration Certificate, Account # 2254-6933, which will remain in force throughout the duration of any State of West Virginia contract which is awarded to Lone Star Auctioneers.
- **4.1.22** We affirm that Lone Star's computerized auction program is capable of the following:
- **4.1.22.1** Items will be listed by lot number and each lot will be permanently associated with the safekeeping ID number as shown in screen shots of items sold which follow **Exhibit B References and Site Requirements.**
- 4.1.22.2 Our custom online auction software program identifies items according to this specification.

- **4.1.22.3** Notices are emailed to buyers when payments have been received and processed. The details of the buyer's purchases are included.
- **4.1.22.4** The process of uploading an auction includes importing data from an Excel spreadsheet. The information required above would be exported from each auction after reconciliation and would be available in the final Auction Results Spreadsheet report.
- 4.1.22.5 Lone Star will send email notifications to over 60,000 existing internet bidders who are registered and approved to bid in our online auctions. To receive these emails, a bidder has to choose the option to receive them, and all registered bidders have the option to opt-out at any time with a click of a button.
- 4.1.23 Once payments are received and processed, each buyer will receive a payment notification by email which acknowledges receipt of the payment and which includes the information required above. Auction records are kept for one year in fire-roof filing cabinets in our office and are kept indefinitely in storage after one year has passed.
- 4.1.24 As a casual seller of firearms, Lone Star Auctioneers is licensed to sell, but exempt from the need to have a Federal Firearms License. For this reason we are not required to maintain the same records which an FFL would maintain. The licensed buyers who receive the firearms are required to file and maintain records under their own licenses.
 - Lone Star maintains sales records permanently, thus will have a permanent record of all sales of firearms.
- 4.1.25 Lone Star will guarantee and will bear responsibility for all forms of payment tendered by buyers. Lone Star will accept cash, cashiers' checks, personal and company checks, Visa, MasterCard and Discover credit cards for purchases of Treasurer's Unclaimed Property. The Auctioneer will receive all sale proceeds, and will be responsible for deducting the approved contract fee and making final settlement and payment to the Treasurer. Final payment should be made within five (5) business days following the auction.
 - Reports and invoices will be submitted electronically at the time of transmission of auction proceeds with the approval of the STO.
- 4.1.26 The most cost-effective, yet safe and insured, means of transferring unclaimed property assets from the West Virginia State Treasurer's Office, Unclaimed Property Division to Lone Star Auctioneers vault in Fort Worth, Texas, would be for Unclaimed Property Division staff to double-box the assets into corrugated boxes and ship them directly to Lone Star using ParcelPro (a private third-party insurer which ships through UPS and FedEx). Each interior and exterior box is to be labeled separately with labels provided by us via email. Lone Star would email shipping labels to Unclaimed Property Division when a shipment is scheduled. Each box would be insured for an amount mutually determined by Unclaimed Property Division and Lone Star to cover the assets in that box. UPS would pick up the ParcelPro-insured boxes for shipment to Lone Star at our expense. Lone Star would pay the shipping and supply costs for ParcelPro/UPS and would invoice the STO for cost reimbursable shipping expenses.

The State of West Virginia shipped 100 boxes of unclaimed property to us using this method under the original contract without incident. Alabama has shipped 191 boxes of their unclaimed property to us in this manner without incident. South Carolina and Utah shipped their unclaimed property to us by the same method.


- **4.1.27** Lone Star Auctioneers will comply with this stipulation to ship at its expense assets to be returned to the STO under these situations.
- 4.1.28 Lone Star Auctioneers understands and will comply with this stipulation and pay the appraiser and collect and maintain the modest Buyer's Premium which is in keeping with other unclaimed property auctions.
- 4.1.29 These requirements are included in our Terms and Conditions of Sale. Each bidder must affirmatively agree to comply with all Terms and Conditions prior to being approved to bid.
- 4.1.30 Confidentiality, security and the integrity of data in all forms are of crucial importance to the way Lone Star conducts business. Our website security protects the personal information by means which are detailed on Page 10 11 above. We process credit card payments by phone (rather than storing credit card information online). The requirements of the US Marshals Service and other government agencies are stringent, thus we are accustomed to confidentiality and security of information requirements. Our security precautions are in place and operational.





Assessing Official Comments:

QUALITY: The support provided by the contractor to the US Marshals Service on this contract has been exceptional. The facility provides more than adequate space for both indoor and outdoor storage and meets all security requirements, actually exceeding the minimum contract requirements. The contractor has gone above and beyond the security requirments for the outside perimeters. There is additional pipe fencing above ground, around the entire perimeter and also buried 6 feet below the ground. The fencing behind the building is 24" higher than the required 6 feet, and the front gate has an additional 4" heavy duty rolling pipe gate. There were no dicrepancies found during any of the monthly inspections. The contractor's focus on customer service is superb. On at least 5 occasions in which we had unusual circumstances arise with the towing of a vehicle, the contractor's response significantly exceeded the requirements of the contract. On more than four occasions, the US Marshals Service needed last minute accommodations for vehicles and the contractor responded, again exceeding contract requirements. Their attention to detail of every vehicle that arrives at their facility also exceeds contract requirements in that when they have found several vehicles with locked compartments, they notified the COR immediately. They did not take it upon themselves to unlock the compartments, but they asked for an agent to search the compartment, just in case the agent may have missed something. On occasion, when space is available, the contractor will store vehicles inside that are categorized for outside, at no additional cost. Finally, the contractor's knowledge of specialty vehicles or vehicles with after market additions, has proven to be very beneficial, resulting in best value when marketing the vehicles at auction.

SCHEDULE: The contractor has gone above and beyond the standard requirement of meeting our schedule for towing vehicles. The requirement to schedule a tow with an Agency Point of Contact (POC) is within 24 hours of receiving notification by the Contracting Officer Representative (COR). The contractor is consistently in contact with the agency POC within hours of the notification, significantly exceeding contractural requirements. On more than six occasions we have had early morning seizures (before 8:30 am) and the contractor was successful every time to meet our needs. During monthly inspections, the contractor ensures efficient and effective inspections by ensuring the records for all selected vehicles are readily available and the staff support for each inspection is standing by to ensure timely responses to inspecion requests. The contractor is very efficient and timely when it comes to execution fo a sub task order.

COST CONTROL: The contractor recommended selling vehicles on-line. This allows the sale of forfeited vehicles as soon as they become available. Implementing the on-line sales reduced the number of days for storage and resulted in cost savings. This not only exceeds the contract requirement of holding an auction at least every two months, but it keeps a forfeited vehicle from sitting and incurring unnecessary expenses until the next auction is scheduled. Due to the large number of vehicles seized in this district, this concept has been very favorable. Having the ability to immediately sell forfeited vehicles allows payment to the lienholders and victims in a timely manner.

MANAGEMENT: The overall performance to manage the US Marshals Service seized vehicles during this period has been superior. It is evident that the contractor manages their employees, not only professionally, but also in a timely and efficient manner when it comes to towing the vehicles. Tows are often completed before the required timeframe as outlined in the SOW. On several occasions, the contractor performed real time, early morning seizures, when requested. Whenever there is a special need by the USMS, the contractor always delivers. The contractor is very thorough in reviewing each vehicle upon day of delivery. All documentation is annotated and kept in the vehicle file. If there are any unusual circumstances upon arrival of a vehicle, the contractor immediately notifies the COR. Only US Marshals Service vehicles are stored at this particular facility and no other outside agency vehicles. The contractor has sold every vehicle

we have requested them to sell. A majority of the time, the vehicles are sold at a higher price than required by the USMS. This is a great indication of the quality of auctioneers the contractor has on staff. There is a significant turnover of vehicles from towing to selling and the contractor never skips a beat.

ADDITIONAL/OTHER: Ratings were completed by COR Linda Blake.

RECOMMENDATION:

Given what I know today about the contractor's ability to perform in accordance with this contract or order's most significant requirements, I would recommend them for similar requirements in the future.
