4.1.1.6 Quality Drug Testing ensures a strict code of ethics in compliance with Federal HIPAA mandates that will ensure patient confidentiality. All test results and material acquired shall become the property of WV VNF and the State of West Virginia. Information will not be released to any other party without prior consent of the WV VNF.

4.1.1.17 Quality Drug Testing will provide, upon request, expert witness testimony regarding the results and accuracy of specific employee testing should the results and subsequent actions be challenged by the employee.

4.1.2.10 Quality Drug Testing will provide a Certified Medical Review Officer certified in accordance with 49 CFR Part 40 and will provide proof of the MRO Certification.

4.1.2.11 Quality Drug Testing will provide confirmed test results to the WV VNF Assistant Administrator or his/her designee via confidential means immediately upon confirmation by the MRO, but not later than 4:00 p.m. on the third business day following the date of a test. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

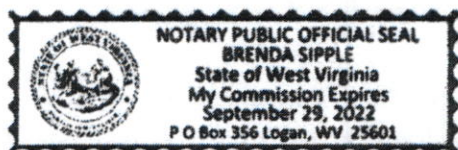
