Per the specifications, drawings, and 1 addenda disseminated, Almost Heaven Interiors offers to provide and install 1 lot of MechoSystems' Mecho/5, Mecho/15, and UrbanShade manually operated window roller shades as described in the options below:

Option #1 (per specifications)

1 lot of Mecho/5, Mecho/15, and UrbanShade manually operated shades having sunscreen cloths in #1319 – Silver Birch (3% open) and blackout cloths in #0703 – Black. Each shade would be provided with a Clear Anodized (aluminized finish) Snap-Loc fascia. The shades would be provided and installed as follows:

- 116 Mecho/5 shades with #0703 – Black cloths; 1 each installed attached to the top horizontal mullion of every individual interior window of the offices on floors 7, 8, & 9 of Building #5.

As stated above, it is our opinion that option #1 exactly satisfies the specifications of this RFQ. However, option #2 reduces, by more than half, the number of control chains necessary to operate the shades and screws which would need to be drilled into the window mullions and door frames. Option #3 also provides the same benefits, as well as matches the interior face of the blackout shadecloth to the sunscreen shades. Additionally, the white backing of the #0819 blackout cloth on the exterior windows can help reduce radiant solar energy gain by contrast to the dark backed #0703 and #0253 cloths.

The above figures include the new shades as described, freight-in and delivery, and installation labor. Approximate time to order fulfillment is 3-4 weeks after receipt of notice to proceed. This proposal will remain valid for purchase for 1 month. Performance and material/wage bonds will be provided following an offer of contract. PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

ALL OTHER CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. "Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (W. Va. 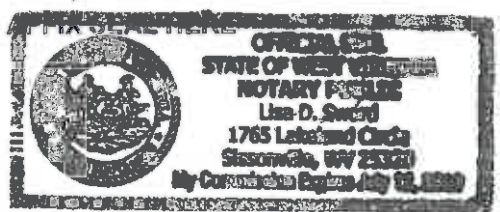
