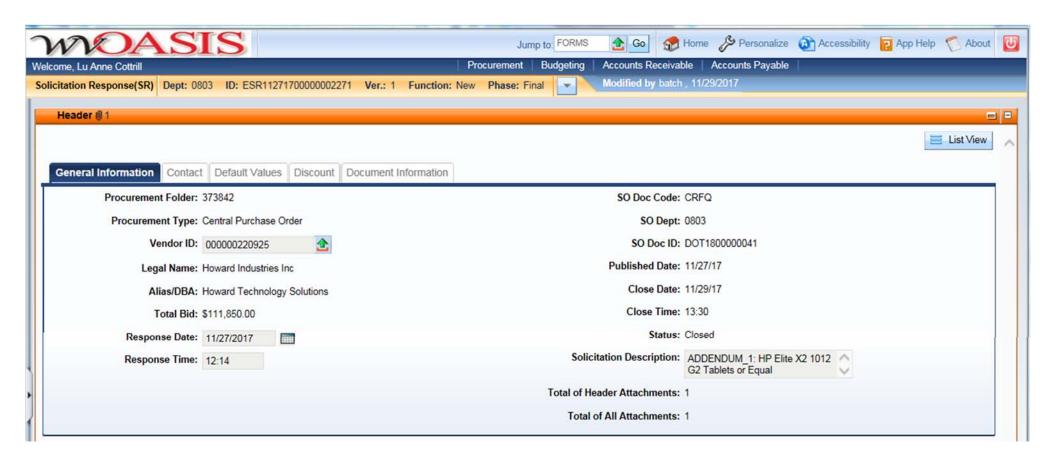
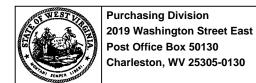

SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE: The West Virginia Purchasing Division is soliciting bids on behalf of the West Virginia Department of Transportation, the West Virginia Division of Highways to establish a contract for the one-time purchase of (25) twenty-five Hewlett Packard HP Elite x2 1012 G2 Windows Tablets or equivalent Windows Mobile Tablet Devices, Four-Year (4Yr) Manufacturers Accidental Damage Warranty, and Powered/Chargeable Docking Stations.
- **2. DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions.
 - **2.1 "Contract Item"** means components provided by a qualified manufacturer that is authorized to sell the equipment as more fully described by these specifications.
 - **2.2 "Pricing Page"** means the pages, contained in wvOASIS or attached as Exhibit A, upon which Vendor should list its proposed price for the Contract Items.
 - **2.3 "Solicitation"** means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with goods or services that is published by the Department of Transportation.
 - 2.4 "GB" stands for gigabyte.
 - 2.5 "TB" stands for terabyte.
 - 2.6 "GHZ" stands for gigahertz.
- 3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:
 - **3.1 Mandatory Contract Item Requirements:** Contract Item must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements listed below.
 - 3.1.1 (25) Hewlett Packard (HP) or equivalent Windows based tablet HP Elite x2 1012 G2 Windows Tablets with powered charging docking stations or equivalent Windows Tablet. Tablet must be provided with the factory installed components listed below:
 - HP Intel m7 processor with Intel HD Graphics 515 3.1 GHZ Turbo Boost Technology, 4 MB Cache two cores, integrated chipset, Windows 10 Pro 64 bit or equal.

- Windows 10 Professional or equal.
- 16 GB SDRAM or equal.
- Minimum 12" diagonal Full High Definition ultra slim backlit touch screen (1920x1280), direct bonded, Corning Gorilla Glass Display or equal.
- (Integrated Intel HD Graphics 515 or equal.
- Minimum 512 GB Solid State Hard Drive or equal
- Dual Band Wireless for cellular connectivity and Bluetooth 4.2.
- Must be Broadband compatible using Agency-provided SIM (Subscriber Identity Module card).
- Travel Keyboard with Click Pad Mouse that supports 2 way scroll, taps and gestures or equal.
- 45 W Smart USB Type-C Adapter with minimum 40-hour battery life or equal.
- Manufacturer's Standard warranty or equal. Warranty should include parts and labor for one year.
 - **3.1.1.1** All hardware components and warranty/support must be provided directly by hardware manufacturer.
 - **3.1.1.2** Vendor MUST <u>provide with the bid</u> a detailed configuration document outlining all the components included in the equipment being specified.
 - **3.1.1.3** Vendor shall provide pricing for (25) Accidental Damage Warranty upgrade to provide a total of four years in coverage.
 - 3.1.1.3.1 The warranty upgrade shall include a minimum of next day onsite coverage for hardware, keyboard, monitor and other internal components. Warranty shall also cover damages resulting from falls, water exposure and other forms of damage.
 - **3.1.1.4** Vendor shall provide pricing for (25) manufacturers powered/chargeable docking stations that also charges the device battery.

- **3.1.1.5** Tablet must be configured so it can accept micro-SD card from AT&T or Verizon wireless providers. Wireless service will be procured separately.
- 3.1.1.6 Alternate bids that are equal to, meet, or exceed the specifications and requirements listed are invited. In order to receive full consideration, such alternate bids MUST be accompanied by sufficient descriptive literature and/or samples to clearly identify the offer and allow for a complete evaluation.

The use of brand name or equal specifications is for describing the minimum standard of quality, technical performance and installation characteristics required and are not intended to limit or restrict competition.

4. CONTRACT AWARD:

- **4.1 Contract Award:** The Contract is intended to provide Agencies with a purchase price for the Contract Items. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides all the Contract Items meeting the required specifications for the lowest overall Grand Total cost as shown on the Pricing Pages.
- 4.2 Pricing Page: Vendor should complete the Pricing Page by providing a Grand Total cost for all the contract items being requested. If responding in WVOasis, Vendor should enter the Unit Price for each contract item. The Extended Price and the Grand Total cos will be automatically calculated. If responding on paper, Vendor should complete the Exhibit_A Pricing Page(s) by entering the Unit Price for each contract item. Then multiply the Unit Price by the Quantity for each contract line item, then enter this amount into the Extended Price box. Then add the Extended Price for each contract item and enter that amount into the Grand Total box.

The Exhibit_A Pricing Page has been provided in Excel and formatted to automatically calculate the Extended Price and the Grand Total Cost when the Unit Price is entered. However, it is the vendors' responsibility to ensure the calculations for their bid is correct before bid submission. In the event of any calculation errors, the Unit Price will prevail.

Vendor should type or electronically enter the information into the Pricing Page(s) to prevent errors in the evaluation. Vendor should complete the Pricing

Page(s) in full as failure to complete the Pricing Page(s) in its entirety may result in Vendor's bid being disqualified

5. PAYMENT:

5.1 Payment: Vendor shall accept payment in accordance with the payment procedures of the State of West Virginia.

6. DELIVERY AND RETURN:

- 6.1 Shipment and Delivery: Vendor shall ship the Contract Items immediately after being awarded this Contract and receiving a purchase order or notice to proceed. Vendor shall deliver the Contract Items within (20) twenty work days after receiving a purchase order or notice to proceed. Final cost shall include shipping charges, delivery charges. Contract Items must be delivered to Department of Transportation/Highways Information Services, Building 5, Room A-715. All server components must be installed in the server at time of delivery.
- 6.2 Late Delivery: The Agency placing the order under this Contract must be notified in writing if the shipment of the Contract Items will be delayed for any reason. Any delay in delivery that could cause harm to an Agency will be grounds for cancellation of the Contract, and/or obtaining the Contract Items from a third party.
 - Any Agency seeking to obtain the Contract Items from a third party under this provision must first obtain approval of the Purchasing Division.
- **6.3 Delivery Payment/Risk of Loss:** Vendor shall deliver the Contract Items F.O.B. destination to the Agency's location.
- 6.4 Return of Unacceptable Items: If the Agency deems the Contract Items to be unacceptable, the Contract Items shall be returned to Vendor at Vendor's expense and with no restocking charge. Vendor shall either make arrangements for the return within five (5) days of being notified that items are unacceptable, or permit the Agency to arrange for the return and reimburse Agency for delivery expenses. If the original packaging cannot be utilized for the return, Vendor will supply the Agency with appropriate return packaging upon request. All returns of unacceptable items shall be F.O.B. the Agency's location. The returned product shall either be replaced, or the Agency shall receive a full credit or refund for the purchase price, at the Agency's discretion.
- 6.5 Return Due to Agency Error: Items ordered in error by the Agency will be returned for credit within 30 days of receipt, F.O.B. Vendor's location. Vendor shall not

charge a restocking fee if returned products are in a resalable condition. Items shall be deemed to be in a resalable condition if they are unused and in the original packaging. Any restocking fee for items not in a resalable condition shall be the lower of the Vendor's customary restocking fee or 5% of the total invoiced value of the returned items.

7 VENDOR DEFAULT:

- 7.1 The following shall be considered a vendor default under this Contract.
 - 7.1.1 Failure to provide Contract Items in accordance with the requirements contained herein.
 - 7.1.2 Failure to comply with other specifications and requirements contained herein.
 - 7.1.3 Failure to comply with any laws, rules, and ordinances applicable to the Contract Services provided under this Contract.
 - 7.1.4 Failure to remedy deficient performance upon request.
- **7.2** The following remedies shall be available to Agency upon default.
 - 7.2.1 Immediate cancellation of the Contract.
 - 7.2.2 Immediate cancellation of one or more release orders issued under this Contract.
 - 7.2.3 Any other remedies available in law or equity.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

ALL OTHER CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (W. Va. Code §61-5-3) that: (1) for construction contracts, the vendor is not in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, and (2) for all other contracts, that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.
