

33. A contractor who uses steel products in violation of this section may be subject to civil penalties pursuant to W. Va. Code § 5A-3-56. As used in this section:
 - a. "State Contract Project" means any erection or construction of, or any addition to, alteration of or other improvement to any building or structure, including, but not limited to, roads or highways, or the installation of any heating or cooling or ventilating plants or other equipment, or the supply of and materials for such projects, pursuant to a contract with the State of West Virginia for which bids were solicited on or after June 6, 2001.
 - b. "Steel Products" means products rolled, formed, shaped, drawn, extruded, forged, cast, fabricated or otherwise similarly processed, or processed by a combination of two or more or such operations, from steel made by the open heath, basic oxygen, electric furnace, Bessemer or other steel making process. The Purchasing Division Director may, in writing, authorize the use of foreign steel products if:
 - c. The cost for each contract item used does not exceed one tenth of one percent (.1%) of the total contract cost or two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00), whichever is greater. For the purposes of this section, the cost is the value of the steel product as delivered to the project; or
 - d. The Director of the Purchasing Division determines that specified steel materials are not produced in the United States in sufficient quantity or otherwise are not reasonably available to meet contract requirements.
- 44. PREFERENCE FOR USE OF DOMESTIC ALUMINUM, GLASS, AND STEEL: In Accordance with W. Va. Code § 5-19-1 et seq., and W. Va. - **3.1.3.8** Windshield Wipers shall be winter blade type with heaviest arms, linkages and motor available by manufacture.
- **3.1.3.9** Wipers shall be minimum of 2-speeds, electric with intermittent feature.
- **3.1.3.10** Washer system shall be electric with largest capacity reservoir available by manufacturer.

3.1.4 Instruments: The following instruments shall be contained in the truck cab.

- **3.1.4.1** Coolant gauge and oil pressure gauge shall have both dial type readout and either an audible or visual alarm to warn operator when safe operating conditions are exceeded.

- 3.1.5.14 Cab shall have a minimum of four (4) additional switches.
- 3.1.5.15 Cab shall have OEM PTO switch.
- **3.1.5.16** Accessories not indicated above but are included in the manufacturer's standard model bid must be provided.

3.1.6 Engine:

- **3.1.6.6** Engine Compression Brake: Must be full engine compression brake minimum 2 stages with selector switch and on/off power switch and shall be dash mounted.
- **3.1.6.7** Air filter shall be largest volume available offered by manufacturer for severe duty conditions.
- 3.1.6.8 Engine shall have a Phillips-Temro or equal 1000 watt/120-volt block heater with corrosion resistant weather proof receptacle housing located on left side of cab. The engine block heater and the fuel water separator overnight heater shall be powered via the same electrical connection.

3.1.6.9 Engine shall have a Davco Fuel Pro or Equal water separator with 120-volt overnight heater and 12-volt DC pre-heater. The engine fuel water overnight heater and the engine block heater shall be powered via the same electrical connection.

- **3.1.19.7** Wheel guard separators shall be installed between wheels and wheel hub front and rear.

3.1.20 Electrical System & Lighting:

- **3.1.20.1** Shall have manufacturer's 12-volt negative ground system with manufacturer's radio interference suppression.
- **3.1.20.2** Shall have minimum of three (3) group 31 12- volt maintenance free Batteries total CCA of 3375 with threaded studs.
- **3.1.20.3** Alternator capacity shall be 160 AMPS minimum with internal regulator.
- **3.1.20.4** Cab and chassis must have best available wiring shield available by manufacturer.
- 3.1.20.5 The cab and chassis shall have:
 - 3.1.20.5.1 Day time running lights
 - 3.1.20.5.2 LED cab marker lights.
 - 3.1.20.5.3 Halogen head lamps
 - **3.1.20.5.4** Park and turn signals

3.1.21 Paint, Decals and Logos:

- 3.1.21.1 The cab exterior and interior paint shall be base coat clear coat urethane paint yellow/gold, DuPont F9885, Sherwin Williams 73266, Sikkens 4017, PPG 85246 or Napa 73266.
- **3.1.21.2** The cab grill shall be manufacturer's standard stainless steel or impact resistant composite plastic.
- **3.1.21.3** The cab shall not be painted over top another finished color.
- 3.1.21.4 Chassis paint shall be urethane base, chassis color black.

3.1.22 Power Take Off and Hydraulics

- 3.1.22.1 Power take off shall be made of cast iron.
- **3.1.22.2** Unit shall be capable of mounting to fully automatic style transmission.
- 3.1.22.3 PTO shall be of the Hot Shift design and have a rotatable direct mount cast iron flange for the hydraulic pump to mate to. Shall be of the Wet Spline design, PTO/pump shafts are bathed in oil.
- **3.1.22.4** PTO to engine speed shall be in the maximum range of 116% to 120%.

- **3.1.26.10** Shall have a 2-man fixed steel platform option 750lbs. minimum capacity.
- 3.1.26.11 Shall be plumbed for hydraulic tool circuit at tail shelf.
- **3.1.26.12** Body shall have lights and reflectors in accordance with FMVSS#108 light package (complete LED including reverse lights).
- 3.1.26.13 Shall have 6 oval LED strobe lights: 2-on rear of truck, 2-on sides and 2-on front of truck minimum size 1-5/8-inch-high X 5-inches wide Whelen 500 series or equal.
- **3.1.26.14** Shall have minimum of 4-LED rear floodlights Hella Brand# H71030401 or equal.

3.1.27 Hydraulic Test and Inspection:

3.1.27.1 Any items not specifically stated herein, but necessary for proper system operation, shall comply with recommended hydraulic industry standards. The vendor shall be responsible for pretesting of hydraulic system which shall include the following: A startup and initial high pressure run of all hydraulic system components shall be done to check for leaks, heat buildup, system efficiency, pressure settings, etc.

3.1.28 Miscellaneous Information:

3.1.28.1 The vendor is responsible to furnish a truck that is properly engineered and that conforms to all and any laws governing such equipment.

3.1.29 Unspecified Accessories & Features:

3.1.29.1 All parts, equipment, accessories, materials, design and performance characteristics not specified herein, but which are necessary to provide a complete unit, must be furnished with each unit and required to conform to strength, quality of material, and quality of workmanship to those which are advertised and provided to the market in general by the unit Industry. All parts and accessories advertised and regularly supplied as standard shall be included, except those which would represent duplication of these specified and except those which, by specification, are not to be furnished. All standard

safety features, required by Federal and State Law, shall be included.

3.1.30 Pre-Build Meeting:

3.1.30.1 After award of contract there will be a mandatory pre-build meeting with successful vendor, manufacturers and up fitters at the WVDOT/Equipment Division, 83 Brushy Fork Rd. Crossing, Buckhannon WV or successful vendors location.

4. CONTRACT AWARD:

- **4.1 Contract Award:** The Contract is intended to provide Agencies with a purchase price on all Contract Items. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides the Contract Items meeting the required specifications for the lowest overall total cost as shown on the Pricing Pages.
- 4.2 Pricing Pages: Vendor should complete the Pricing Pages in wvOasis by completing the Year, Make, Model and inserting quoted Unit Price. If submitting on paper, Vendor should complete the Exhibit_A Pricing Page by completing the Year, Make, Model and inserting quoted Unit Price. The Exhibit_A Pricing Page is provided in Excel and formatted to automatically calculate the Grand Total Cost. However, it is the vendors responsibility to ensure the calculations for their bid is correct before submitting. In the event of an error, the Unit Price shall prevail. Vendor should complete the Pricing Pages in their entirety as failure to do so may result in Vendor's bids being disqualified.

The Pricing Pages contain a list of the Contract Items and estimated purchase volume. The estimated purchase volume for each item represents the approximate volume of anticipated purchases only. No future use of the Contract or any individual item is guaranteed or implied.

Vendor should electronically enter the information into the Pricing Pages through wvOASIS, if available, or as an electronic document.

5. ORDERING AND PAYMENT:

5.1 Ordering: Vendor shall accept orders through wvOASIS, regular mail, facsimile, email, or any other written form of communication. Vendor may, but is not required to, accept on-line orders through a secure internet ordering portal/website. If Vendor

has the ability to accept on-line orders, it should include in its response a brief description of how Agencies may utilize the on-line ordering system. Vendor shall ensure that its on-line ordering system is properly secured prior to processing Agency orders on-line.

5.2 Payment: Vendor shall accept payment in accordance with the payment procedures of the State of West Virginia.

6. DELIVERY AND RETURN:





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
