
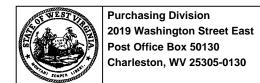


1. CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE: West Virginia Code § 21-11-2 requires that all persons desiring to perform contracting work in this state be licensed. The West Virginia Contractors Licensing Board is empowered to issue the contractor's license. Applications for a contractor's license may be made by contacting the West Virginia Division of Labor. West Virginia Code § 21-11-11 requires any prospective Vendor to include the contractor's license number on its bid. If an apparent low bidder fails to submit a license number in accordance with this section, the Purchasing Division will promptly request by telephone and electronic mail that the low bidder and the second low bidder provide the license number within one business day of the request. Failure of the bidder to provide the license number within one business day of receiving the request shall result in disqualification of the bid. Vendors should include a contractor's license number in the space provided below.

The apparent successful Vendor must furnish a copy of its contractor's license prior to the issuance of a contract award document.

- 2. DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE AFFIDAVIT: W. Va. Code § 21-1D-5 provides that any solicitation for a public improvement contract requires each Vendor that submits a bid for the work to submit an affidavit that the Vendor has a written plan for a drug-free workplace policy. If the affidavit is not submitted with the bid submission, the Purchasing Division shall promptly request by telephone and electronic mail that the low bidder and second low bidder provide the affidavit within one business day of the request. Failure to submit the affidavit within one business day of receiving the request shall result in disqualification of the bid. The awarding public authority shall cancel this contract if: (1) Vendor fails to implement and maintain a written drug-free workplace policy described in the preceding paragraph, (2) Vendor fails to provide information regarding implementation of its drug-free workplace policy at the request of the public authority; or (3) Vendor provides to the public authority false information regarding the contractor's drug-free workplace policy.

Pursuant to W. Va. Code 21-1D-2(b) and (k), this provision does not apply to public improvement contracts the value of which is \$100,000 or less or temporary or emergency repairs.

LEE HARTMAN & SONS, INC. DRUG AND ALCOHOL ABUSE POLICY

Lee Hartman & Sons, Inc. (the "Company") is committed to a safe and healthy working environment for its employees. Additionally, we have an obligation to our customers and the general public to conduct our operations safely and efficiently. With this commitment and obligation in mind, the Company is affirming its rule prohibiting alcohol and drug abuse. The Company is also affirming its willingness to assist employees with alcohol or drug related problems to find the appropriate treatment for rehabilitation and recovery.

In accordance with our policy, this notice is to emphasize to our employees (and employees of other companies and contractors) that the abuse of drugs and alcohol poses a serious threat to the safety of our employees and to the Company's operations. Accordingly, the use, possession, being under the influence or having a detectable presence of drugs or alcohol in one's system (except where expressly authorized) or manufacture, distribution or sale of such substance on Company premises or on-the-job, or off-the-job abuse of such substances which adversely affects or threatens to adversely affect an employee's job performance or other Company interests is prohibited. "Drugs" and "alcohol" include any substance with the potential to product the effects of intoxication and/or the potential to produce physical, mental, emotional or behavioral changes which could adversely affect an employee's ability to perform his job safely and efficiently. This prohibition includes any prescription or over-the-counter drug unless an employee's possession and use of such drug on Company premises, or on-the-job, is expressly authorized. The term "Company premises" in this notice is used in its broadest sense and includes all land, property, buildings, structures, cars, trucks, and all other means of conveyance owned or leased by the Company, or otherwise being utilized for Company business. The term "on-the-job" includes paid and unpaid meal periods during the business day and paid and unpaid overtime.

Employees who have drug and/or alcohol abuse problems are encouraged to request assistance through the Company or through other appropriate community agencies. The Company will take no disciplinary action against an employee who voluntarily seeks such assistance prior to the Company's determination that the employee is violating this policy. Employee participation in, an assistance program does not, however, relieve any employee from compliance with the terms of this notice or other applicable standards governing performance and conduct. Employees who violate this Drug and Alcohol Abuse Policy will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including discharge and may, in the sole discretion of the company, be allowed to participate in approved treatment as an alternative to discharge. Employees of independent contractors and temporary agency employees who violate this policy will not be allowed to perform additional services on behalf of the Company.

To further insure safe and healthy working conditions, the Company may request an employee to participate in drug or alcohol testing for justifiable reasons, which may include testing on the following bases: preemployment, reasonable suspicion, post-accident, and/or periodic.

The Company also reserves the right to take other justifiable measures, including the search of any packages, handbags, briefcases, lunchboxes, vehicles or any other personal effects employees have on Company premises. In addition, the Company also reserves the right to search all offices, desks, files, lockers, or any other areas or articles on Company premises. All offices, desks, files, lockers, computers, etc. are the property of the Company, and are issued for employee use only for employment purposes. Such inspections may be initiated by the Company without prior announcement and may be conducted at such times and locations as deemed appropriate at the sole discretion of the Company.

Participation in such testing and inspection is voluntary, but employees who refuse or interfere with the orderly administration of such testing or inspection shall be deemed in violation of this policy which will result in termination of employment. Moreover, adulteration or attempted adulteration of specimens collected in connection with this policy also will result in termination of employment. Contractor employees who refuse shall not be permitted to perform further work for the Company.

All records and information obtained by the Company regarding alcohol and drug testing, the test results and treatment of employees will be confidentially maintained by restricting access on a need to know basis to those designated by management.

Your cooperation in the enforcement of this policy will assist the Company in providing you and your fellow employees with a healthy and safe work environment.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

ALL CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (W. Va. Code §61-5-3) that: (1) for construction contracts, the vendor is not in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, and (2) for all other contracts, that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.
