The original language in contract will be listed first with question and answer to follow below.

1. 3.1.1 General – Asphalt Paver Tractor 8' to 15' Extendible Width Paver Roadtec RP 170e or equal general mandatory requirements.

Question: Asphalt Paver Tractor 8' to 15' minimum (Vogele VF500 8' to 15'6")

Answer: will accept 15'6"

2. 3.1.2.1 Length with front mounted hydraulic extendible screed 21 foot 10-inches minimum.

Question # 1: Please change to: 19'7" from front of push roller to trailing edge of screed plate with hinged walkway.

Question # 2: Our unit is 21' with our front mounted screed option. Will you reduce it to 21'

Question #3: Our paver is 19.5' long

Answer: Q#1, Q#2, Q#3 will accept

3. 3.1.2.2 Width 8-foot 6-inches maximum transport width.

Question #1: Our unit is 8'8" transport width. Will you increase

Question # 2: Can maximum transport width be changed to 9'6"?

Answer: Q#1,Q#2,Q#3 will accept

4. 3.1.2.4 Paver with front mounted hydraulic extendable Screed Weight 35,800lbs. maximum.

Question #1: Please change to 36,500 Lbs. Maximum.

Question # 2: Asking the spec to read minimum operating weight of 38,150 lbs.

Question #3: Our unit is 36,722 lbs. with front mounted screed. Will you increase?

Question # 4: Can maximum weight be changed to 39,050 lbs.

Answer: will change to read: 3.1.2.4 Paver with front mounted hydraulic extendable Screed Weight 39,100lbs. maximum.

5. 3.1.2.5 Fuel tank capacity 80-gallons minimum.

Question # 1: Please change to 57 Gallons Minimum

Question # 2: Our unit is 73 gallons. Fuel burn for this unit at the highest load factor is 6 gallons per hour (average fuel burn is 3.0-4.5 gallons per hour), so it will easily cover a 12 hour shift of paving without needing to be refueled, Will you reduce?

Question #3: Our fuel tank is 40 gallons

Question # 4: Can minimum be changed to 65 gallons? 65-gal fuel capacity can easily deliver a full shift of paving.

Answer: Will change to read: 3.1.2.5 Fuel Tank capacity shall be largest advertised by manufacturer being bid.

6. 3.1.2.7 Hydraulic Tank 65 gallons minimum.

Question # 1: Please change to 50 Gallons

Question # 2: Our unit is 58 gallons, which is designed by the manufacturer to adequately cover the needs of the machine. Will you reduce?

Question # 3: Our hydraulic tank is 50 gallons

Question # 4: Can hydraulic tank be 25.1 gallon minimum?

Answer: Will change to read: 3.1.2.7 Hydraulic tank capacity shall be largest advertised by manufacturer being bid.

7. 3.1.3.1 Drive tires (2) shall be a minimum of 16:00 x 24 (40.6 m x 610 mm) high flotation sand rib tires and shall be hydroflated for maximum tractive effort.

Question: Please change to "or" equivalent Radial tire 385/95 R25

Answer: Will change to read: 3.1.3.1 Drive tires shall standard for manufacturers model bid.

8. 3.1.3.2 Front steering suspension shall consist of four solid bogie wheels of minimum 14-inches x 22-foot dimension, arranged in pairs, and each side tied together with a solid linkage to prevent misalignment or bowing from one side to the other. Paver to have maximum inside turning radius of 32-inches.

Question# 1: There is an error in the spec- it should read "14 inches x 22-inches instead of 14-inches x 22-foot"

Question # 2: Our unit has a turn radius of 54-inches, will you increase?

Answer: Will change to read 3.1.3.2 Front steering suspension shall consist of four solid bogie wheels of minimum 14-inches x 22-inches dimension, arranged in pairs, and each side tied together with a solid linkage to prevent misalignment or bowing from one side to the other. Paver to have maximum inside turning radius of 54-inches.

9. 3.1.3.3 Traction drive to rear tires shall be hydrostatic. Paving speeds shall be infinitely variable to at least 300 fpm and travel speeds infinitely variable to at least 10 mph. Two speed planetary drives shall be shift able at either operator's station via an electric switch.

Question # 1: Please change to 250 fpm

Question # 2: Our unit has a paving speed of 250 fpm, which is still a great deal higher than the speed at which a normal paving crew is able to pave. Will you reduce?

Question #3: Can 300 fmp be changed to 240 fmp? Travel 0-11 mph. We have 2 speed drive motors with single speed planetary.

Answer: Will change to read: 3.1.3.3 Traction drive to rear tires shall be hydrostatic. Paving speeds shall be infinitely variable to at least 240 fpm and travel speeds infinitely variable to at least 10 mph. Two speed planetary drives shall be shift able at either operator's station via an electric switch.

10. 3.1.3.4 Paver shall have differential lock located at each operator's station to provide momentary lock of both drive motors to prevent drive wheel slippage.

Question # 1: (Vogele Intelligent Machine Control provides all time Differential Lock)

Question # 2: The previous item 3.1.3.3 requires the drive to be hydrostatic, therefore it has no differential that can be locked. Please clarify this spec.

Answer: Q# 1 will accept

Answer: Q# 2 Paver shall have the ability divert power equally to drive wheels when a low traction situation occurs, either hydraulically or with a differential lock

11. 3.1.3.5 Paver must have Front Wheel assist both rear bogie wheels shall be hydraulic motor drives.

Question: Please clarify this spec as well. Are you stating that the paver should front wheel assist as well as both rear bogie wheels having drive motors?

Answer: correct

12. 3.1.4.1 Engine shall be turbocharged; water-cooled (6) six-cylinder diesel

Question #1: Please change to 4 cylinders

Question # 2: Our engine is a Cummins 4.5 L 4 cylinder

Question # 3: Our unit is 4 cylinders but still meets the horsepower requirements. This will actually result in fuel savings as it is a more efficient engine.

Answer: Leave as written

13. 3.1.4.2 Engine shall be 174 hp minimum at 2200 rpm Tier 4 Final emissions compliant.

Question # 1: Please change to 173 HP

Question # 2: Our engine is 160 HP

Question #3: Can 174 mph be changed to 173?

Answer: Leave as written

14. 3.1.4.3 Engine shall be 12 or 24-volt electric starting, minimum 100-amp alternator, with battery disconnect switch.

Question # 1: Please change to 75 amp. (24V 75 amp is equal or better than 12 V 100 amp.

Question # 2: Alternator size minimum of 100 amp/ Asking the spec to read minimum of 70 amp

Answer: Will change to read: 3.1.4.3 Engine shall be 12 or 24-volt electric starting with battery disconnect switch.

15. 3.1.4.4 Engine shall have full digital engine condition instrumentation, oil and fuel filters, engine high temperature/low oil pressure shutdown, muffler and severe duty air cleaner.

Question: add warning light

Answer: will change to read: 3.1.4.4 Engine shall have full digital engine condition instrumentation, oil and fuel filters, engine high temperature/low oil pressure shutdown or warning lights, muffler and severe duty air cleaner.

16. 3.1.4.5 Engine turbocharger shall include an insulated turbo blanket to minimize heat in the engine compartment.

Question #1: Can this be removed from the bid? Not needed on our paver

Question # 2: or well-ventilated engine shroud

Answer: Will change to read: 3.1.4.5 Engine turbocharger shall include an insulated turbo blanket to minimize heat in the engine compartment if available by manufacturer being bid.

17. 3.1.4.6 Engine must be easily accessible through a one-piece hydraulically raise/lower hood with manual override and safety lock.

Question #1: Can hydraulic raise & lower be removed, Ours is manual, shock assisted easy opening with safety lock

Question # 2: Hydraulic or pneumatic cylinders

Answer: Will accept Hyd. or pneumatic

18. 3.1.5.2 Paver brake systems must always automatically apply when pressure is not relieved by control of the operator. System control must include a switch from each operator's station as well as foot-pedal for control during operation.

Question #1: The Dynapac is operated by joystick and does not require a foot pedal to brake the machine. Asking that the foot pedal be excluded from the bid spec.

Question # 2: We do not have a foot pedal for the brakes

Question #3: Ours does not have a foot pedal. Will automatic be accepted?

Answer: Yes, Will accept Q#1, Q#2, Q#3

19. 3.1.6.1 Paver shall be equipped with dual operator's consoles.

Question: or single console

Answer: will accept

20. 3.1.6.2 Paver Consoles must hydraulically move beyond the side of the paver for visibility in infinitely adjustable positions.

Question # 1: The Dynapac consoles are manually moved from one side of the machine to the other with little effort and lock in with pins. Asking the spec to include manually moving consoles.

Question # 2: Our unit has adjustable swing out consoles, which require less maintenance and leave less of a chance for expensive repairs. Will you accept?

Question # 3: Can hydraulically be removed? Ours moves beyond the edge of the paver manually.

Question # 4: or mounted off set cam allows powerless movement

Answer: Will accept Hydraulic or Manual.

21. 3.1.6.3 Paver Stations must consist of starting functions, two deluxe swivel padded seats with armrest, adjustable backrest and a single transferable umbrella.

Question: Our seat rotates 35 degrees with no adjustable backrest

Answer: Leave As written

22. 3.1.6.4 Each operator's console shall include power hydraulic steering with tilt steering wheel.

Question: or 18 speed adjustable seat to accomplish the same

Answer: Will change to read: Each operator's console shall include power hydraulic steering with tilt steering wheel if available by manufacturer.

23. 3.1.6.5 Paver propel console and function console shall be mounted to either side of the operator's seat. Both propel consoles shall include a rotary speed selector, electric forward/reverse control with locking center neutral position; parking brake and emergency stop control.

Question # 1: Can "rotary" language be removed?

Question # 2: Or sliding console with all functions

Answer: Will change to read: 3.1.6.5 Paver propel console and function console shall be mounted to either side of the operator's seat. Both propel consoles shall include a speed selector, electric forward/reverse control with locking center neutral position; parking brake and emergency stop control.

24. 3.1.6.6 Both paver control consoles shall be furnished with toggle switch control for the following functions: hopper wings, screed lift, screed vibrators, auger and feed conveyor operation, auger raise/lower and paver start.

Question: or push button switches

Answer: will accept

25. 3.1.7.1 Paver mainframe will be constructed of one-piece ½-inch side sheets with solid 2-inch thick minimum front cross-member.

Question: Statement **Ours has a lifetime warranty for 1st owner

26. 3.1.7.2 Axle connecting front steering bogie assemblies shall be a minimum 4-inch diameter solid shaft extending through entire width of paver and frame.

Question # 1: We do not have a mechanical connection between front steering bogies

Question # 2 Will accept yours

Question # 3: or Equivalent

Answer: Q#1 will accept yours

27. 3.1.8.1 The hopper shall have a capacity of 11 tons minimum of material with hydraulic powered folding hopper wings controlled at either operators' stations.

Question # 1: Our hopper has a 10-ton capacity.

Question # 2: This is a confusing spec used by a single manufacturer. Tons on pavers are generally used to measure throughout, such as tons per hour. Paver hoppers are generally measured by volume, such as cubic meter or cubic foot. Please clarify.

Answer: Q#1 Will change to read: 3.1.8.1 The hopper shall have a capacity of 10- tons minimum of material with hydraulic powered folding hopper wings controlled at either operators' stations.

Answer O#2 During market research all manufacturers except 1 state Hopper Capacity (tons)

28. 3.1.8.3 Two separate power adjustable flow gates, at the rear of the hopper, shall be provided to aid in flow of material to the center of the screed.

Question #1: The Dynapac uses ultrasonic sensors to automatically aid the flow of material. Flow gates are not needed. Asking the spec to include the option for Ultrasonic augers.

Question # 2: This is an antiquated spec. The majority of manufacturers have progressed beyond flow gates. Our unit is updated to a separate system that individually controls chains and augers. Furthermore, it is redundant to line 3.1.9.1 that asks for an independent left and right feed conveyors.

Question # 3: Electric paddles mounted over conveyor tunnel.

Answer: Will accept Q#1, Q#2, and #3

29. 3.1.9.3 Paver conveyor chain covers shall be bolted on to allow easy removal to access conveyor chains. Both head shaft and foot shaft grease fittings shall be location outside the paver frame for easy daily maintenance.

Question: Our bearings are sealed and have no daily maintenance.

Answer: will accept

30. 3.1.10.1 Paver Auger assembly will have the ability to raise/lower/tilt each side independent of the other via hydraulic cylinders controlled by toggle switches at both paver and screed operators' stations.

Question #1: Please consider removing tilt and toggle switch

Question # 2: We use frame raise to adjust auger height

Question # 3: Our unit can't tilt each side independently of each other; the full assembly tilts. Will you accept?

Answer: will accept

31. 3.1.10.3 Augers and feeders shall be hydraulically interlocked to provide uniform material flow to the screed as dictated by the proportional feed sensors.

Question # 1: Augers and feeders work independently but are still controlled by the feed sensors. Asking to include independently working augers and feeders.

Question: # 2: or independently controlled auger and conveyor

Answer: Will accept Q# 1 and Q# 2

32. 3.1.10.4 Manufacturer shall provide a means to stop the feed conveyors and operate the augers independent of feeders (feeder override) by way of toggle switches at each screed operator's console. Augers shall consist of minimum 16" diameter full cast Ni-hard or equivalent hardness material.

Question: independently controlled auger and conveyor

Answer: will accept

33. 3.1.12.2 Screed shall have a minimum 34-kilowatt hydraulic driven generator that provides power to electrically heat the screed.

Question: Please revise to 30 KW

Answer: Will change To read: 3.1.12.2 Screed shall have a minimum 30-kilowatt hydraulic driven generator that provides power to electrically heat the screed.

34. 3.1.12.5 The main section of the screed shall have a minimum plate width, front to back, of 2-inches, a minimum screed plate thickness of ½-inch, a minimum 400 BHN plate hardness, capable of laying materials from ½-inch minimum to 12-inch maximum in depth. The extension screed sections shall have a minimum plate width, front to back, of 8-inch, a minimum screed plate thickness of -inch, a minimum 400 BHN plate hardness.

Question: Please consider removing front to back of 2" (reason for this request is Vogele VF500 is an 8' to 15'6" with the ability to pave up to 21' with bolt on extensions.

Answer: will accept

35. 3.1.12.6 Screed shall include dual screed control boxes with toggle switch control on the main screed.

Question: or push button switches

Answer: will accept

36. 3.1.12.8 Paver tractor shall have a screed boost package with adjustable lifting pressures and time limits.

Question: or equivalent screed assist

Answer: will accept

37. 3.1.13.1 Shall have spray washdown system 12-gallon minimum capacity w/retractable hose 25-foot minimum.

Question # 1: Please consider 5 Gal

Question # 2: Asking for the capacity of the spray tanks to be a minimum of 6 gallons.

Question # 3: Our unit has a 5-gallon capacity, which will provide several days' worth of usage before needing to be refilled. Will you reduce?

Answer: Will change to read: 3.1.13.1 Shall have spray washdown system with the maximum capacity tank of manufacturer being bid w/retractable hose 25-foot minimum.

38. 3.1.13.2 Shall have Standard LED lighting package for manufacturer bid.

Question: Equivalent

Answer: Leave as written

39. 3.1.13.5 Machine shall have Dump Signal Lights.

Question #1: This is not an option on our paver. We are asking for this to be removed from the bid spec.

Question # 2: We do not have dump signal lights

Question # 3: Our unit does not have a dump signal light. This is an added cost with very little benefit to the end user. Truck drivers normally rely on the paver operator or ground man to guide the truck into the paver. Will you accept?

Answer: Will change to read: 3.1.13.5 Machine shall have Dump Signal Lights if available by manufacture bid.

40. 3.1.13.6 Machine shall have Lincoln Automated Lubrication system or equal.

Question # 1: No lube on tractor/sealed bearings

Question # 2: We do not have factory installed auto lube

Answer: Machine shall have lube system if offered by manufacturer

41. 3.1.13.7 Paver shall be set up to accept sonic grade and slope control system if added.

Question #1: To be clear this should be reworded to be specify. "The machine shall have an Automatic Grade and Slope system"

Question # 2: This is a very ambiguous spec. Are you requesting a machine with a grade and slope system? Are you requesting the capability to add a grade and slope system down the road? If so, there are various ways this could be approached as well as varying degrees of having a machine ready to accept a grade and slope system. Please Clarify.

Answer: Machine shall have capabilities to add/accept sonic grade and slope system in the future (Machine you bid would accept a complete system if DOH decided to add one)

42. 3.2.6.1 Full 3-year 3000 hours on machine 100% Parts and Labor.

Question: We do not have OEM extended machine warranties the standard is one year, 1,000 hours.

Answer: Leave as written

43. 3.2.6.2 Full 5-year 6000 Hours on Engine 100% Parts and Labor

Question: We do not have OEM extended engine warranties the standard is two years, 2000 hours.

Answer: Leave as written

44. 6.1 Delivery Time: Vendor shall deliver standard orders within 120 working days after orders are received. Vendor shall ship all orders in accordance with the above schedule and shall not hold orders until a minimum delivery quantity is met. A completed pilot model for inspection must be provided within 90 working day(s) after receipt of the purchase agreement by the successful vendor. Working day is defined as any week day, Monday thru Friday, excluding Federal and State Holidays. Vendor shall ship all orders in accordance with the above schedule and shall not hold orders until a minimum delivery quantity is met.





4. NOTICE TO PROCEED: Vendor shall begin performance of this Contract immediately upon receiving notice to proceed unless otherwise instructed by the Agency. Unless otherwise specified, the fully executed Award Document will be considered notice to proceed.
5. QUANTITIES: The quantities required under this Contract shall be determined in accordance with the category that has been identified as applicable to this Contract below.

- **3.1.9.2** Each paver feed conveyor will consist of solid drag bars mounted to roller bushed drag slat chains riding over solid, replaceable wear floors consisting of minimum 3/8-inch abrasion resistant plates of minimum 400 Brinell hardness.
- 3.1.9.3 Paver conveyor chain covers shall be bolted on to allow easy removal to access conveyor chains. Both head shaft and foot shaft grease fittings shall be location outside the paver frame for easy daily maintenance.

## 3.1.10 Paver Tractor Auger Conveyor System

- **3.1.10.1** Paver Auger assembly will have the ability to raise/lower/tilt each side independent of the other via hydraulic cylinders controlled by toggle switches at both paver and screed operators' stations.
- 3.1.10.2 Augers shall be driven independent of the feed conveyors by separate hydraulic motors with variable speed control provided by sonic (non-contacting) proportional sensors located at each end of the vibrating screed.
- **3.1.10.3** Augers and feeders shall be hydraulically interlocked to provide uniform material flow to the screed as dictated by the proportional feed sensors.
- 3.1.10.4 Manufacturer shall provide a means to stop the feed conveyors and operate the augers independent of feeders (feeder override) by way of toggle switches at each screed operator's console. Augers shall consist of minimum 16" diameter full cast Ni-hard or equivalent hardness material.
- 3.1.10.5 Augers shall be reversing distribution Augers.

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#### 3.1.11 Paver Tractor Fume Extraction System

3.1.11.1 Paver shall meet the July 1, 1997 requirements for factory standard fume scavenge systems on all highway class asphalt pavers. The scavenge or extraction system will meet all testing criteria and fume recovery efficiencies as mandated by NIOSH guidelines.

## 3.1.12 Paver Screed (Carlson EZ IV8 brand or equal)

- **3.1.12.1** Screed shall be a minimum of 8-feet wide hydraulically extendable vibratory compacting and shall be of the free-floating type.
- **3.1.12.2** Screed shall have a minimum 34-kilowatt hydraulic driven generator that provides power to electrically heat the screed.
- **3.1.12.3** Screed generator must be of enough size to heat the entire screed and run a 4-kilowatt load of paver lighting concurrently.
- 3.1.12.4 Screed shall have hydraulic extension with electric heat and vibration that are mounted to the front of the main screed. These extensions shall be slop- able and have height match functionality with electric over hydraulic controls.
- 3.1.12.5 The main section of the screed shall have a minimum plate width, front to back, of 2-inches, a minimum screed plate thickness of ½ -inch, a minimum 400 BHN plate hardness, capable of laying materials from ½-inch minimum to 12-inch maximum in depth. The extension screed sections shall have a minimum plate width, front to back, of 8-inch, a minimum screed plate thickness of -inch, a minimum 400 BHN plate hardness.
- **3.1.12.6** Screed shall include dual screed control boxes with toggle switch control on the main screed.
- 3.1.12.7 Screed shall have dual remote screed control boxes for off screed adjustments with lockable vandal covers for control boxes, power remote screed control crown control and spring-loaded two-piece end gates.
- 3.1.12.8 Paver tractor shall have a screed boost package with adjustable lifting pressures and time limits.

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#### 3.1.13 Paver Tractor/ Screed Accessories and Lighting

- **3.1.13.1** Shall have spray washdown system 12-gallon minimum capacity w/retractable hose 25-foot minimum.
- 3.1.13.2 Shall have Standard LED lighting package for manufacturer bid.
- 3.1.13.3 Shall include (1) operators' umbrella.
- **3.1.13.4** Paver shall have Guardian Telematics or equal for monitoring and troubleshooting of machine with full machine data remotely with no subscription fee for first two-years of operation.
- 3.1.13.5 Machine shall have Dump signal light.
- 3.1.13.6 Machine shall have Lincoln Automated Lubrication system or equal.
- **3.1.13.7** Paver shall be set up to accept sonic grade and slope control system if added.
- 3.1.14 Unspecified Accessories & Features: All parts, equipment, accessories, material, design and performance characteristics not specified herein, but which are necessary to provide a complete unit, must be furnished with each unit and required to conform to strength, quality of material, and quality of workmanship to those which are advertised and provided to the market in general by the unit industry. All parts and accessories advertised and regularly supplied as standard shall be included, except those which would represent duplication of these specified and except those which, by specification, are not to be furnished. All standard safety features, required by Federal and State Law, shall be included.
- **3.1.15** Unit shall be delivered: to WVDOH with all manufacturers recommended safety related decals and safety features intact.

#### 3.2 Miscellaneous Information:

#### 3.2.1 Vendor Responsibility

3.2.1.1 The vendor is responsible to furnish an extendable width wheeled asphalt paver that is properly engineered and that confirms to all and any laws governing such equipment.

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**3.2.1.2** Inspection: WVDOH requires unit shall have a West Virginia State inspection sticker upon delivery, if applicable.

### 3.2.2 Representative Unit for Test:

3.2.2.1 The successful vendor must (if specified) provide the DOH one (1) completed represented unit to be observed and evaluated on each order to ensure compliance with specification. If requested, the time period for testing and evaluation shall be seven (7) working days following receipt of the unit.
