
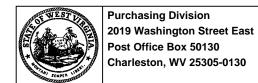

The original language in contract will be listed first with question and answer to follow below.

1. 3.1.1.4 The unit specified herein and offered shall be manufactured on or after January 1, 2020 and will be clearly identified and marked with date of manufacture.

Question #1: Request date of Manufacture for tractor changed to a 2019 or 2020 machine.

Question #2: What if the tractor is produced before Jan 1, 2020?

Answer: Question #1. Will accept 2019 or 2020 model.

Question #2. Will accept.

2. 3.1.1.2 Wheelbase shall be 90 inches minimum.

Question: Will you accept Wheelbase of 88.6 inches?

Answer: Yes. Will accept.

3.. 3.1.2.3 Shall be Manufacturers standard (4) four-cylinder minimum, water cooled, 4 valves per cylinder diesel powered engine.

Question: The RFQ specifies that the state wants four (4) Wheel Drive Tractor John Deere 6110M. We are requesting that the listed specification 3.1.2.3 be corrected to include 2 valves per cylinder, which more accurately describes the current model year 2020 production of the John Deere 6110M tractor.

Answer: Yes. Will revise to read Shall be manufacturers standard (4) four-cylinder minimum, water cooled, diesel powered engine.

4. 3.1.6.4 Shall have Manufacturer factory back up alarm.

Question: Can the backup alarm be dealer installed?

Answer: No. Leave as written.

5. 3.1.9.1 Unit shall have Whelen IX4AC liberty II LED amber and white lightbar or equal, mounted on the top rear center of cab protection.

Answer: The Equipment Division will be removing section 3.1.9.1, we will be installing our own light bar.

6. 3.1.12.5 Transmission shall have speed matching feature to match speed gears to road speed during range shifting.

Question: Please clarify statement 3.1.12.5

Answer: Answer: As the operator shifts up or down a range, the tractor will select the appropriate speed gear within that range depending on tractor speed. An example would be if the tractor was operating in B4 and the operator shifted to C range. The tractor would select gear two based on information that the controller receives from various speed sensors (engine, range box, and wheel speed). Without speed matching, the transmission would shift from B4 to C4, representing a larger jump in speed and would not be as smooth.

7. 3.1.14.1 Right side stabilizer for front axle shall be included.

Question: Why is the right side stabilizer for front axle under the tractor requirements? Shouldn't it be listed under the boom mower section?

Answer: Yes. Should be in the mower section and is still a mandatory requirement

- 8. 3.1.19 Tires The following are mandatory requirements related to the tires.
- 3.1.19.1 Front tire shall be Nokian TRI 2 or equal 400/80/24 minimum with correct ply and load rating for model bid.
- 3.1.19.2 Rear tires shall be Nokian TRI 2 or equal 480/80/34 Minimum with correct ply and load rating for model bid.

Question #1: Are 400/80R28 (Alliance) front tires fine?

Question # 2: Are 480/80R38 (Alliance) rear tires fine?

Answer: Question #1. No. Leave as written. Question #2. No. Leave as written.

- 9. 3.1.20.6 Shall be equipped with sway control blocks on PTO housing to prevent horizontal movement.
- 2.1.20.7 Shall be equipped with right and left side adjustable draft link stabilizer bars.

Question #1: Will 3 point sway bars be acceptable? Bid spec calls out for 3 point blocks.

Question # 2: Can a sway bar be used instead of sway blocks? (3.1.20.6 & 3.1.20.7)

Answer: Question #1. No. Leave as written.

10. 3.1.21.3 Cab shall have Poly-shield or equal on right side 1/2 inch thick minimum with anti-scratch coating on both sides, installed into the original cab manufactured door and side window. Windows shall be tinted at all locations.

Question: A. Industry standard for right hand polycarbonate windows on boom mowing tractors is 3/8-inch thick. Will 3/8-inch thickness be acceptable?

Answer: No. Leave as written.

11. 3.1.21.4 Cab unit shall be equipped with heater, defroster, air conditioning and standard AM/FM radio with Bluetooth and shall be installed by the manufacturer.

Question: We politely ask that you change the language to: Cab unit shall be equipped with heater, defroster, and air conditioning and shall be installed by the manufacturer. An AM/FM radio with Bluetooth shall be installed.

Answer: Yes. Will revise to read: Cab unit shall be equipped with heater, defroster, air conditioning installed by manufacturer. A Jensen SWJHD1635BT or equal AM/FM radio with Bluetooth shall also be installed.

12. 3.2.2.2 Unit shall be counterweighted to maintain the most possible ground pressure of tires on opposite side of mower during all reach out, up, and down operations of boom with specified head. Rear tire that holds counterweight shall be filled with beet juice, water or calcium filled will not be accepted.

Question: Will you accept windshield washer fluid to replace beet juice?

Answer: No. Leave as written.

13. 3.2.3.7 All motor circuit hoses shall be a minimum of 1 inch diameter, four (4) wire braided.

Question: The standard hose Tiger uses meets SAE standard 100R17. The hydraulic hose we use has a working pressure of 3000PSI, and a minimum burst pressure of 12,000 PSI. Will the state change the specifications to allow 1 inch 2 wire hydraulic hose?

Answer: Yes. Will accept two (2) wire braided hose.

14. 3.2.5.7 Boom swing from stow position shall be 140 degrees forward minimum and be a rear stow design.

Question #1: The Bengal boom mower Tiger Mowers is offering has a 112 degree swing forward from the rear stowed position. Will the state change the specification to allow 112 degrees of forward swing from stow position as it is stated in bid # 0054? (DOT20\*54)-3.2.5.6 Boom swing from stow position shall be 110 degrees forward minimum and shall be rear stow design only.

Question # 2: We request that the State change the specification to a minimum 110 degree swing forward from the rear stowed position.

Answer: Question #1. Yes. Will change 3.2.2.7 to read Boom swing from stow position shall be 110 degrees forward minimum and be a rear stow design.

Question #2. Yes. Will change 3.2.2.7 to read Boom swing from stow position shall be 110 degrees forward minimum and be a rear stow design.

15. 3.2.6.3 Side skirts shall be a minimum of 1/4 inch steel.

Question: What is the required side skirt material thickness for mower deck, first bid states (20\*51) 3/8" material and this bid specs 1/4"?

Answer: Bid spec DOT200000053 has a minimum side skirt material thickness requirement of 1/4 -inch. Bid spec DOT200000051 is a separate bid spec and has a side skirt minimum thickness requirement of 3/8-inch. Leave as written

#### 16. 3.2.7 Optional Cutting Heads

Question: A. The current bid does not address how the hydraulic lines are to be disconnected and reconnected when an optional cutting head is changed from another head. Would hydraulic quick coupler fittings that seal upon being disconnected to prevent oil loss and system contamination be desired on all hydraulic lines that need to be disconnected in order change between the various optional hydraulic attachments?

Answer: Will accept manufacturers standard hydraulic connections.

### 17. 3.2.7.1 Tiger Growler Mulcher Head or equal Exhibit E

Question: A. For boom mounted mulching, two primary cutting styles, Disk Style and Drum Style, exist in the market. Operational economics and cutting productivity are generally better with a disk style cutting head. Will a disk style mulching head be equal to Exhibit E?

Answer: Yes. Will accept

19. 15. PREFERENCE: Vendor Preference may be requested in purchases of motor vehicles or construction and maintenance equipment and machinery used in highway and other infrastructure projects. - 3.1 Contract Items and Mandatory Requirements: Vendor shall provide Agency with the Contract Items listed below on an open-end and continuing basis. Contract items must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements as shown below.
  - 3.1.1 General 4 Wheel Drive Tractor general mandatory requirements.
    - 3.1.1.1 Unit shall be 4-wheel drive.
    - 3.1.1.2 Wheelbase shall be 90 inches minimum.
    - 3.1.1.3 Tractor dry weight (without ballast): shall be 10,000 lbs. minimum.
    - 3.1.1.4 All daily checks shall be done from ground level.
    - 3.1.1.5 The unit specified herein and offered shall be manufactured on or after January 1, 2020 and will be clearly identified and marked with date of manufacture.
  - **3.1.2 Engine** The following are mandatory requirements related to the tractor's engine.
    - 3.1.2.1 Engine shall be Tier 4 final.
    - 3.1.2.2 Shall have 85 PTO horsepower minimum.
    - 3.1.2.3 Shall be Manufacturers standard (4) four-cylinder minimum, water cooled, 4 valves per cylinder diesel powered engine.
    - **3.1.2.4** Shall be Manufacturers standard governor with engine key shut off, wire sealed by Manufacturer.
  - 3.1.3 Engine Lubrication System The following are mandatory requirements related to engine's lubrication system.

- 3.1.3.1 The engine shall have full pressure lubrication with oil filter and oil bypass system.
- 3.1.3.2 Shall have engine oil cooler
- **3.1.4 Engine Cooling System** The following are mandatory requirements related to the engine's cooling system.
  - 3.1.4.1 Shall have manufacturer's largest cooling system offered.
  - 3.1.4.2 Cooling system shall be equipped with a coolant recovery tank and sight glass.
  - 3.1.4.3 Shall have engine air filtration system.
  - 3.1.4.4 Shall have Dry type dual element (2 stage) air cleaner with self-dumping valve.
  - 3.1.4.5 Unit shall an air filter restriction indicator that is operator visible when service is required.
- **3.1.5 Exhaust System** The following are mandatory items related to the exhaust system.
  - 3.1.5.1 The muffler shall be mounted in compliance with Tier 4 final standards and not interfere with the articulated boom mower.
- **3.1.6 Electrical System** The following are mandatory items related to the electrical system.

  - 3.1.6.4 Shall have Manufacturer factory back up alarm.

- 3.1.7 Charging System The following are mandatory items related to the charging system.
  - 3.1.7.1 Charging system shall be 12volt negative ground
- 3.1.8 Engine Fuel System The following are mandatory requirements related to the engine's fuel system.
  - 3.1.8.1 If fuel tank is exposed, manufacturers skid plate must be provided.
  - 3.1.8.2 Dual stage fuel filtering shall be provided.
  - 3.1.8.3 Unit shall have a fuel water separator.
  - 3.1.8.4 Shall have largest manufacture DEF tank offered not to interfere with articulated boom mower.
- 3.1.9 Lighting The following are mandatory requirements related to the lights.
  - 3.1.9.1 Unit shall have Whelen IX4AC liberty II LED amber and white lightbar or equal, mounted on the top rear center of cab protection.
  - 3.1.9.2 Shall have two (2) high-low beam head light (halogen) with manufacturers heavy duty console mounted switch.
  - 3.1.9.3 Shall have four (4) LED factory roof mounted work lights; two (2) front and two (2) rear.
  - 3.1.9.4 Shall have fender mounted rear taillights and turn signals.
  - 3.1.9.5 Unit shall have seven pin (7) factory installed terminal out socket to provide lighting for towed equipment.
  - 3.1.9.6 Shall have four (4) factory roof mounted flashing warning lights; two (2) front and two (2) rear.
  - 3.1.9.7 Unit shall be provided with console and dome lighting.

- **3.1.10** Unit Instrumentation The following are mandatory requirements related to the unit's instrument panel.
  - 3.1.10.1 Unit Instrumentation shall include:
    - A. Tachometer
    - B. Speedometer
    - C. Hour meter operable from engine operation not key switch
    - **D.** Coolant temperature indicator with audible buzzer or warning light

- 3.1.11 Clutch The following are mandatory requirements related to the clutch.

- **3.1.12 Transmission** The following are mandatory requirements related to the transmission's design and arrangement.
  - 3.1.12.1 Shall have power shift design, power shuttle provides touch button powershifting through the gears of each range and must have a transmission that can be shifted on the go without using a clutch within the speed gears.
  - 3.1.12.2 Shall have transmission forward and reverser control that can be shifted from forward to reverse without the use of a clutch and shifted on the go, shifter mounted on the steering column.
  - **3.1.12.3** The unit shall have a minimum of 15 forward speeds and 15 reverse speeds.
  - 3.1.12.4 Range selections requires clutch usage but can be shifted while moving through all ranges.
  - **3.1.12.5** Transmission shall have speed matching feature to match speed gears to road speed during range shifting.

- 3.1.13 Differential The following are mandatory requirements related to the differential.

  - 3.1.15.1 The rear axle shall be flanged-type axle.
- 3.1.16 Planetary Final Drives The following are mandatory requirements related to the tractor's planetary final drives.
  - 3.1.16.1 Planetary final drives shall be in board type.
- 3.1.17 Hydraulic System The following are mandatory requirements related to the tractor's hydraulic system.
  - 3.1.17.1 Tractor hydraulic system shall be closed center; pressure flow compensated load sensing type and provide 29 GPM minimum pump flow.
  - 3.1.17.2 Tractor shall have a minimum of three (3) mechanically controlled SCV control valves John Deere 450 series or equal with three (3) detent positions and Hydraulic flow adjustment. See attachment Exhibit C
  - 3.1.17.3 Shall have hydraulic hoses that can be coupled and uncoupled while tractor is running.

- 3.1.17.4 Tractor hydraulic system shall be separate from mower attachment hydraulic system.
- 3.1.18 Brakes The following are mandatory requirements related to the brakes.
  - 3.1.18.1 Manufacturer's standard park braking system shall be provided.
  - 3.1.18.2 Tractor shall have hydraulic actuated service brakes.
  - 3.1.18.3 Tractor shall have wet-type disk brakes which must be both self-adjusting and equalizing.
- 3.1.19 Tires The following are mandatory requirements related to the tires.
  - 3.1.19.1 Front tire shall be Nokian TRI 2 or equal 400/80/24 minimum with correct ply and load rating for model bid.
  - 3.1.19.2 Rear tires shall be Nokian TRI 2 or equal 480/80/34 Minimum with correct ply and load rating for model bid.
- 3.1.20 Three Point Hitch The following are mandatory requirements related to the hitch.
  - 3.1.20.1 Hitch shall have external switch to control raising and lowering from rear of tractor for safety purposes.
  - 3.1.20.2 Hitch lift capacity shall be 6,190 lbs. minimum at 24 inches behind lift point.
  - 3.1.20.3 Hitch shall be electro-hydraulically operated.
  - 3.1.20.4 Three-point hitch shall be Category II with telescopic end links.
  - 3.1.20.5 Center link shall be Category II with ball ends.
  - 3.1.20.6 Shall be equipped with sway control blocks on PTO housing to prevent horizontal movement.

- 3.1.20.7 Shall be equipped with right and left side adjustable draft link stabilizer bars.
- 3.1.20.8 Shall be equipped with left and right-side hand adjustable lift rods to adjust the horizontal plane of implements.
- 3.1.20.9 Draw bar shall swing and be adjustable.
- **3.1.21 Cab and Related Accessories** The following are mandatory requirements related to the cab and accessories.
  - 3.1.21.1 Cab shall be OSHA approved ROPS.
  - 3.1.21.2 Cab shall be standard model for unit bid mounted by the manufacturer insulated and pressurized
  - 3.1.21.3 Cab shall have Poly-shield or equal on right side 1/2-inch-thick minimum with anti-scratch coating on both sides, installed into the original cab manufactured door and side window. Windows shall be tinted at all locations.
  - 3.1.21.4 Cab unit shall be equipped with heater, defroster, air conditioning and standard AM/FM radio with Bluetooth and shall be installed by the manufacturer.
  - 3.1.21.5 Cab shall be equipped with an additional retractable instructional seat, for safe operator training
  - **3.1.21.6** Cab shall have two (2) lockable entry doors keyed alike; one (1) left and one (1) right.
  - 3.1.21.7 Seat shall be cloth covered type protected with scotch guard (or equal) and equipped with a seat belt and air suspension.
  - 3.1.21.8 Seat shall have a height and swivel adjustment.
  - 3.1.21.9 Seat shall be equipped with adjustable arm rests.
  - 3.1.21.10 Unit shall be equipped with a tilt/telescoping steering wheel.

- 3.1.21.11 Toolbox shall be provided, weather resistant, lockable, and mounted for operator convenience.
- 3.1.21.12 Air conditioner condenser shall have a screen protecting it from debris, that is both removable and cleanable.
- 3.1.21.13 Cab unit shall have front and rear windshield wipers and washers.
- 3.1.21.14 Tractor shall have Left and right-side view mirrors and in cab rear view mirror.
- 3.1.21.15 Cab and tractor shall have a type of non-skid step (steps) and hand holds for safety purposes.
- 3.1.21.16 Unit shall be equipped with a first aid kit mounted inside of cab.
- 3.1.21.17 All features that are manufacturer's standard equipment that are not specifically addressed above shall be provided.
- 3.1.21.18 Unit shall be delivered to the WVDOH with all manufacturers recommended safety related decals and safety features intact.
- 3.1.22 PTO Requirements The following are mandatory requirements related to the PTO (power take off).
  - 3.1.22.1 Tractor shall have a minimum of 540 PTO R.P.M.
  - 3.1.22.2 Tractor shall be setup to operate 540rpm PTO implements as well as 1000rpm PTO implements.
  - 3.1.22.3 PTO shall be able to be engaged and disengaged on the go, and be independent operating style
  - 3.1.22.4 Shall be equipped with PTO active warning that is seat activated.

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- 3.1.23 Paint The following are mandatory items related to the color of unit.
  - **3.1.23.1** The tractor shall be painted manufacturer's standard color.
- 3.2 21 Foot Minimum Tiger Bengal Mid-Mounted Articulated Hydraulic Powered Boom Mower With 60-inch Rotary Cutter Head or Equal The following are general mandatory requirements related to the above mower.

#### 3.2.1 General

- 3.2.1.1 The unit specified herein and offered shall be manufactured on or after January 1, 2020 and will be clearly identified and marked with date of manufacture.
- 3.2.1.2 Perimeter guarding for the cab roof shall be 7 Gauge thickness minimum to protect tractor from falling debris along with limb risers minimum 3-inch x 2-inch square tubing 1/8-inch thickness will be provided and installed by the mower manufacturer. See attached Exhibit D
- 3.2.2 Frame The following are mandatory items related to the frame.
  - 3.2.2.1 Frame shall be sub frame type. Unit bid will be bolt on with no welding to the tractor. Shall have dual axle braces 3 ½-inch x 3 ½-inch x 1/8th-inch minimum secured to the tractor and rear axle housings. All framework and counterweight shall have a minimum of (8) eight inches of ground clearance.
  - 3.2.2.2 Unit shall be counterweighted to maintain the most possible ground pressure of tires on opposite side of mower during all reach out, up, and down operations of boom with specified head. Rear tire that holds counterweight shall be filled with beet juice, water or calcium filled will not be accepted.
  - **3.2.2.3** The mower controls shall feature an in-cab master ON/OFF switch for complete power shutdown.
  - **3.2.2.4** The wheel counterweight shall be self-centering and have a weight decal.

- 3.2.3 Hydraulic Reservoir The following are mandatory items related to the hydraulic reservoir.
  - 3.2.3.1 Shall have Manufacturer's hydraulic oil reservoir properly sized to operate all mower functions including forward swing, rearward swing, up, down, and rotary head functions.
  - 3.2.3.2 Tank shall have a built-in oil level sight glass and thermometer.
  - **3.2.3.3** Hydraulic filter shall be capable of providing complete filtration for system.
  - 3.2.3.4 Tank shall be equipped with a lockable shut off valve for the ability to lock the valve in the open position to protect against accidental deadheading
  - 3.2.3.5 Unit shall be equipped with a Tandem gear or piston style pump to operate all mower functions. The mower and its control shall have their own independent hydraulic system.
  - 3.2.3.6 Hydraulic GPM shall be manufacturer's highest specified to operate all mower functions at maximum efficiency.
  - 3.2.3.7 All motor circuit hoses shall be a minimum of 1-inch diameter, four (4) wire braided.
  - 3.2.3.8 Deck hoses shall be four (4) wire braid fitted with cordura sleeving for brush protection.
  - 3.2.3.9 Mower controls shall be a proportional five (5) section valve minimum, controlled through a single electronic joystick.
  - **3.2.3.10** Valve shall allow a minimum of three (3) functions simultaneously.
  - 3.2.3.11 The swing, lift, and dipper sections shall have individual relief valves to give breakaway protection.

- **3.2.3.12** Mower cutter shall have an 8 second maximum emergency shutdown.
- 3.2.3.13 Mower head motor shall take 6 seconds minimum to wind up to full RPM for a "no-shock-load startup".
- 3.2.3.14 Mower shall have an electric solenoid operated hydraulic lock valve incorporated in the head tilt function to prevent cylinder leak down during storage or transportation
- 3.2.3.15 Hydraulic system shall be equipped with oil-to-air cooler with integrated electric fan
- 3.2.3.16 The model bid will have been in the manufacturers model line for a minimum of one (1) year(s) of production time prior to bid.
- 3.2.4 Boom Rest The following are mandatory items related to the boom rest.
  - 3.2.4.1 When in stow, tractor and mower shall be maximum 133 inches width, with 60-inch rotary mower, and 11-foot-high maximum.
  - 3.2.4.2 An axle boom stow system constructed of minimum ¼" x 4"x 4" square tubing with water drain holes and shall be mounted to the mower frame with frame member extending to the axle mounts. 3-point hitch system and P.T.O shall function normally.
- 3.2.5 Boom The following are mandatory items related to the boom.
  - 3.2.5.1 Boom pivot pin shall be 41-inches minimum above ground level.
  - 3.2.5.2 Boom shall be minimum two (2) piece design, with all hinge points of the arm and mast shall have minimum 1 1/2-inch diameter steel pins with greaseable, replaceable steel bushings.
  - 3.2.5.3 Kingpost or Turret style mounting is acceptable.

- if kingpost mount is used shall be a minimum of 2-inch diameter pin.
- 3.2.5.4 Inner boom shall be made of 7-inch x 6-inch x 1/4-inch steel tubing minimum, with a 50,000 lb. per square inch minimum yield strength.
- 3.2.5.5 Dipper boom shall be made of 6-inch x 4-inch x 1/4-inch steel tubing minimum, with a 50,000 lb. per square inch minimum yield strength.
- 3.2.5.6 All hinge points shall be T-1 steel reinforcement.
- 3.2.5.7 Boom swing from stow position shall be 140 degrees forward minimum and be a rear stow design.
- 3.2.5.8 Blade reach up shall be minimum 20 feet.
- **3.2.5.9** Boom reach out shall be minimum 21 feet from tractor centerline to outside edge or cutting blade arc.
- 3.2.6 60-inch Rotary head Attachment The following are mandatory items related to the brush head.
  - 3.2.6.1 Minimum 60-inch rotary cutting head.
  - 3.2.6.2 Top deck shall be 110000 P.S.I Domex or equal 1/8<sup>th</sup>-inch thick minimum, continuously welded for strength.
  - 3.2.6.3 Side skirts shall be a minimum of 1/4 inch steel.
  - **3.2.6.4** Top deck shall be reinforced with Domex or equal with a reinforced spindle mount plate.
  - **3.2.6.5** Deck shall have replaceable bolts on full length skid shoes.
  - 3.2.6.6 Spindle shall be one piece forged with integral 7 1/4-inch drive hub
  - 3.2.6.7 Spindle shall have stationary wire wrap protection

- **3.2.6.8** Blade carrier shall be (3) three blade rotary cutting head with a pan or stump jumper.
- **3.2.6.9** Blades shall be manufacturer recommended size and strength matched to the unit bid.
- 3.2.6.10 Blade bolts shall be manufacturers recommended size and strength matched to the unit bid
- 3.2.6.11 Hydraulic Motor shall be cast steel and shall be sized to match the hydraulic pump proposed by the mower manufacturer.
- 3.2.6.12 Brush head shall be required to have a front safety shield, hydraulic actuated, center feed metal door operational from joystick control or on main control panel.
- 3.2.6.13 Cutter deck tilt rotation shall be 160 degrees minimum.
- 3.2.6.14 Rear shield shall be full width rubber/fabric material.
- 3.2.7 Optional cutting heads- The following are additional mandatory items the manufacturer shall bid for purchase and shall meet or exceed the following. See Attached
  - 3.2.7.1 Tiger Growler Mulcher Head or equal Exhibit E
- 3.2.8 Paint The following are mandatory items related to the color.
  - 3.2.8.1 Mower shall be manufacturer's standard color.
- **3.2.9 Miscellaneous** The following mandatory items are related to the mower.
  - **3.2.9.1** Complete unit shall be delivered with all manufacturers' safety features intact.

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- 3.2.9.2 The unit specified herein and offered shall be manufactured on or after January 1, 2020 and will be clearly identified and marked with date of manufacture.
- 3.2.9.3 Unspecified Accessories & Features: All parts, equipment, accessories, material, design and performance characteristics not specified herein, but which are necessary to provide a complete unit, must be furnished with each unit and required to conform to strength, quality of material, and quality of workmanship to those which are advertised and provided to the market in general by the unit industry. All parts and accessories advertised and regularly supplied as standard shall be included, except those which would represent duplication of these specified and except those which, by specification, are not to be furnished. All standard safety features, required by Federal and State Law, shall be included.

#### 3.3 Vendor

#### 3.3.1 Vendor Responsibility:

- 3.3.1.1 The vendor is responsible to furnish a 4-wheel drive tractor with a mid-mounted articulated boom mower with 60" rotary cutting head and optional attachments that is properly engineered and that confirms to all and any laws governing such equipment.
- 3.3.1.2 Inspection: WVDOH requires unit shall have a West Virginia State inspection sticker upon delivery, if applicable.

#### 3.3.2 Representative Unit for Test:

3.3.2.1 The successful vendor must (if specified) provide the DOH one (1) completed represented unit to be observed and evaluated on each order to ensure compliance with specification. If requested, the time period for testing and evaluation shall be seven (7) working days following receipt of the unit. DOH will incur no obligation for deterioration of surfaces, finishes, seals, and mechanical or electrical parts on the unit resulting from operation and testing

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within the limits of these specifications; nor will DOH incur obligation for damage to the unit resulting from failure to meet specifications when due care and attention is given by DOH and testing is done within the limits of these specifications. Failure of the pilot unit to satisfactorily meet specifications as bid may be cause for cancellation of the purchase order and return of the delivered unit along with all associated equipment to the vendor at the vendor's expense.

#### 3.3.3 Operating and Service Manuals and Parts Lists:

3.3.3.1 An operator's manual must be included with each unit upon delivery. A "line sheet" (if applicable) and the "Equipment Preventative Maintenance Questionnaire", (Exhibit "B") must be with pilot unit upon delivery, Attn: Todd Campbell. There must be 12 service/shop/maintenance manuals and 14 parts manuals; USB storage drive is preferred in lieu of parts manuals. Manuals and USB storage drive shall be delivered upon completion of delivery of total units. Failure to do so will delay payment.

#### 3.3.4 Training:

3.3.4.1 Manufacturers and/or dealers will be required to stage a thorough seminar on the subjects of Preventative Maintenance, Operator, and Mechanic Training. In order to keep operators and mechanics updated, the successful vendor shall conduct training sessions covering the operation, maintenance, trouble- shooting with each purchase order against this open-end contract.

#### 3.3.5 Preventative Maintenance & Operator Procedures:

3.3.5.1 Manufacturers and/or dealers will be required to submit to the Equipment Division, in addition to the operating and service manuals, booklets and pamphlets explaining the Preventative Maintenance and Operator Procedures to be used by the operators of this equipment, and must include such things as daily prestart inspection procedure, service schedule, and routine maintenance required, safety precautions, etc. The successful vendor shall furnish all training aids; i.e. videos, projectors as required in conducting the training.

#### 3.3.6 Warranty and Service Policy:

3.3.6.1 The bid shall include a breakdown of the complete manufacturer's warranty per section. The unit must be accompanied upon delivery by the unit's manufacturers executed warranty and service policy. Turret system mowers shall carry lifetime parts warranty coverage on turret system

#### 4. CONTRACT AWARD:

- 4.1 Contract Award: The Contract is intended to provide Agencies with a purchase price on all Contract Items. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides the Contract Items meeting the required specifications for the lowest overall total cost as shown on the Pricing Pages.
- 4.2 Pricing Pages: Vendor should complete the Pricing Pages (Exhibit A) by completing the Year, Make, Model, and inserting quoted unit price. Vendor should take estimated Quantity and multiply by unit price to calculate the total bid amount. Vendor should complete the pricing pages in their entirety as failure to do so may result in Vendor's bids being disqualified.

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The Pricing Page contains a list of the Contract Items and estimated purchase volume. - 8.2 Reports: Vendor shall provide quarterly reports and annual summaries to the Agency showing the Agency's items purchased, quantities of items purchased, and total dollar value of the items purchased. Vendor shall also provide reports, upon request, showing the items purchased during the term of this Contract, the quantity purchased for each of those items, and the total value of purchases for each of those items. Failure to supply such reports may be grounds for cancellation of this Contract.
