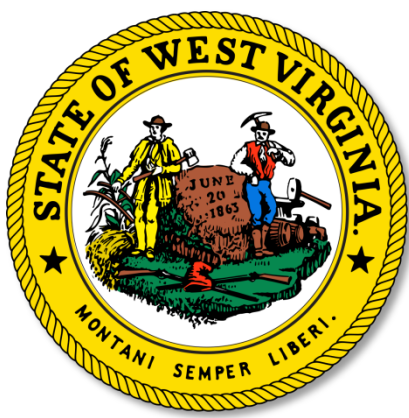

All the source code for STO applications, for which source code is available, is currently stored either on a server or on a developer's workstation or network drive.

Our consultants will migrate all and reviewed or re-written applications' source code into the new source code repository. Also will write basic technical documentation for all reviewed or re-written applications, including such things as dependencies (files, jobs, etc.); purpose of the application; and any other important information about the application. This will be a 'living' document and will be stored in source code control alongside code.

Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (W. Va.
