- 2. MANDATORY TERMS: The Solicitation may contain mandatory provisions identified by the use of the words "must," "will," and "shall." Failure to comply with a mandatory term in the Solicitation will result in bid disqualification.

No one individual is permitted to represent more than one vendor at the pre-bid meeting. Any individual that does attempt to represent two or more vendors will be required to select one vendor to which the individual's attendance will be attributed. The vendors not selected will be deemed to have not attended the pre-bid meeting unless another individual attended on their behalf.

- 10. - 12. - 13. REGISTRATION: Prior to Contract award, the apparent successful Vendor must be properly registered with the West Virginia Purchasing Division and must have paid the \$125 fee, if applicable.
- 14. UNIT PRICE: Unit prices shall prevail in cases of a discrepancy in the Vendor's bid.
- 15. PREFERENCE: Vendor Preference may be requested in purchases of motor vehicles or construction and maintenance equipment and machinery used in highway and other infrastructure projects. Any request for preference must be submitted in writing with the bid, must specifically identify the preference requested with reference to the applicable subsection of West Virginia Code § 5A-3-37, and must include with the bid any information necessary to evaluate and confirm the applicability of the requested preference. - 18. ELECTRONIC FILE ACCESS RESTRICTIONS: Vendor must ensure that its submission in wvOASIS can be accessed and viewed by the Purchasing Division staff immediately upon bid opening. - 22. INTERESTED PARTY DISCLOSURE: West Virginia Code § 6D-1-2 requires that the vendor submit to the Purchasing Division a disclosure of interested parties to the contract for all contracts with an actual or estimated value of at least \$1 Million. That disclosure must occur on the form prescribed and approved by the WV Ethics Commission prior to contract award. A copy of that form is included with this solicitation or can be obtained from the WV Ethics Commission. This requirement does not apply to publicly traded companies listed on a national or international stock exchange. A more detailed definition of interested parties can be obtained from the form referenced above.
- 23. WITH THE BID REQUIREMENTS: In instances where these specifications require documentation or other information with the bid, and a vendor fails to provide it with the bid, the Director of the Purchasing Division reserves the right to request those items after bid opening and prior to contract award pursuant to the authority to waive minor irregularities in bids or specifications under W. - 2.3. "Contract" means the binding agreement that is entered into between the State and the Vendor to provide the goods or services requested in the Solicitation.
- 2.4. "Director" means the Director of the West Virginia Department of Administration, Purchasing Division.
- 2.5. "Purchasing Division" means the West Virginia Department of Administration, Purchasing Division.
- 2.6. "Award Document" means the document signed by the Agency and the Purchasing Division, and approved as to form by the Attorney General, that identifies the Vendor as the contract holder.
- 2.7. "Solicitation" means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with goods or services that is published by the Purchasing Division.
- 2.8. "State" means the State of West Virginia and/or any of its agencies, commissions, boards, etc. as context requires.

4. NOTICE TO PROCEED: Vendor shall begin performance of this Contract immediately upon receiving notice to proceed unless otherwise instructed by the Agency. Unless otherwise specified, the fully executed Award Document will be considered notice to proceed.
5. QUANTITIES: The quantities required under this Contract shall be determined in accordance with the category that has been identified as applicable to this Contract below.
Open End Contract: Quantities listed in this Solicitation are approximations only, based on estimates supplied by the Agency. It is understood and agreed that the Contract shall cover the quantities actually ordered for delivery during the term of the Contract, whether more or less than the quantities shown.
Service: The scope of the service to be provided will be more clearly defined in the specifications included herewith.
Combined Service and Goods: The scope of the service and deliverable goods to be provided will be more clearly defined in the specifications included herewith.
One Time Purchase: This Contract is for the purchase of a set quantity of goods that are identified in the specifications included herewith. Once those items have been delivered, no additional goods may be procured under this Contract without an appropriate change order approved by the Vendor, Agency, Purchasing Division, and Attorney General's office.
6. EMERGENCY PURCHASES: The Purchasing Division Director may authorize the Agency to purchase goods or services in the open market that Vendor would otherwise provide under this Contract if those goods or services are for immediate or expedited delivery in an emergency. Emergencies shall include, but are not limited to, delays in transportation or an unanticipated increase in the volume of work. An emergency purchase in the open market, approved by the Purchasing Division Director, shall not constitute of breach of this Contract and shall not entitle the Vendor to any form of compensation or damages. This provision does not excuse the State from fulfilling its obligations under a One Time Purchase contract.
7. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS: All of the items checked below must be provided to the Purchasing Division by the Vendor as specified below.
BID BOND (Construction Only): Pursuant to the requirements contained in W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(c), All Vendors submitting a bid on a construction project shall furnish a valid bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid protecting the State of West Virginia. The bid bond must be submitted with the bid.
PERFORMANCE BOND: The apparent successful Vendor shall provide a performance bond in the amount of 100% of the contract. The performance bond must be received by the Purchasing Division prior to Contract award.

☐ LABOR/MATERIAL PAYMENT BOND: The apparent successful Vendor shall provide a labor/material payment bond in the amount of 100% of the Contract value. The labor/material payment bond must be delivered to the Purchasing Division prior to Contract award.

- 12. The Purchasing Division Director may, in writing, authorize the use of foreign steel products if:
  - c. The cost for each contract item used does not exceed one tenth of one percent (.1%) of the total contract cost or two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00), whichever is greater. For the purposes of this section, the cost is the value of the steel product as delivered to the project; or
  - d. The Director of the Purchasing Division determines that specified steel materials are not produced in the United States in sufficient quantity or otherwise are not reasonably available to meet contract requirements.

- 3.1.3.3 Frame shall be welded per AWS-D1.1 structural steel guidelines.
- 3.1.3.4 Frame outer beams shall be 3/8-inch X 6-inch top flange, 3/8-inch X 3 ½-inch bottom flange with a 3/16-inch web thickness minimum.

#### **Landoll 440B Single Drop Traveling Axle Trailer or Equal (7021EC01)**

- 3.1.3.5 Frame inner beams shall be ¾-inch X 6-inch bottom flange in the undercarriage travel area and a ½-inch X 6-inch top flange with 3/16-inch web minimum.
- 3.1.3.6 Frame shall be designed and rated for full capacity of the trailer.

#### 3.1.4 Platform

- 3.1.4.1 Platform shall be single drop type eight and one half feet in width.

- 3.1.6.5 Hydraulic cylinder circuits will include a counter balance valve and must operate at 20 gallons per minute flow.

#### 3.1.7 Winch

3.1.7.1 Winch shall be Warn or equal 30,000 pound minimum planetary with 2 speed and air release spring tension and 4-way cable roller guide.

#### Landoll 440B Single Drop Traveling Axle Trailer or Equal (7021EC01)

- 3.1.7.2 Winch shall have 85 feet minimum of 5/8-inch minimum flex 9 cable.
- 3.1.7.3 Winch shall have a minimum 3-foot long high test 3/8-inch minimum lead chain with a minimum 5/8-inch grade 100 self-locking hook attached.
- 3.1.7.4 Winch shall have a winch guard with dual LED work lights mounted on winch guard.

- 3.1.10.2 Shall have eight tires and be 255/70/22.5 radial with Correct ply rating matched to the full GVWR capacity of the trailer. Goodyear or equal

#### **3.1.11 Brakes**

3.1.11.1 Shall be Dexter or equal air disc brake size matched for maximum GVWR or trailer.

### Landoll 440B Single Drop Traveling Axle Trailer or Equal (7021EC01)

3.1.11.2 Each axle shall be equipped with air disc brakes.

#### 3.1.12 Suspension

3.1.12.1 Shall be of the thru-axle type with Neway RLU228 air Ride or equal matched for GVWR of trailer.

### 3.1.13 Undercarriage

- 3.1.13.1 Shall travel forward and return hydraulically.
- 3.1.13.2 Shall be equipped with a centralized grease system located at the rear of the undercarriage that feeds axles and traveling undercarriage rollers.
- 3.1.13.3 The undercarriage shall travel on a minimum of four 4-inch 40,000 pound minimum greaseable and replaceable needle bearing rollers.

# COVID-19 Guidelines for

# Pre-Construction & Pre-Bid Meetings

The following guidelines are to be used when holding pre-construction and pre-bid meetings. Pre-construction and pre-bid meetings may require case-by-case analysis.

### WV Purchasing Division Temporary Pre-bld Meeting Policy - COVID-19 Precautions

- 1. Pre-bid meetings must be removed from solicitations as a requirement, wherever possible, and replaced with publication of written materials conveying the needed information (except when contrary to agency policy).
- 2. In instances where site inspections are necessary for bidders to have a full understanding of the project, the Purchasing Division recommends that pre-bid meetings (and the underlying solicitation) be delayed until this period of heightened concern has ended. If delaying the solicitation is not possible or would cause an undue hardship on the spending unit, the pre-bid meeting should be conducted in a manner that minimizes the risk of COVID-19 transmission to the greatest extent possible.
- 3. Under no circumstances is a spending to conduct a pre-bid meeting that violates a policy or declaration of the Governor's Office.

For existing central solicitations, the spending unit should work with its designated Purchasing Division buyer to issue addenda to modify pre-bid meeting requirements where necessary. On agency delegated solicitations, the spending unit can make the necessary adjustments under their delegated authority.

### Department of Transportation Pre-Construction and Pre-bid Meetings Guidelines

- When possible, limit the number of representatives of each vendor to a maximum of two (2).
- Require each vendor representative to wear a mask upon entering and while moving throughout a DOT facility for the duration of the pre-construction and pre-bid meeting.
  - o Any representative who arrives at a DOT facility without a mask will not be permitted to enter.
- In areas where a minimum 6ft distancing is not feasible amongst vendors, groups must be staggered during inspections.
- For pre-construction or pre-bid meetings located at the Capitol Complex:
  - Pre-construction or Pre-bid meetings can be conducted by using the West Virginia State Training Center located in Building 7, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor.
  - o For room scheduling/availability please contact the Facility Scheduler, Jeremy Walker, at 304-414-0840 or by email at <a href="mailto:dop.registrar@wv.gov">dop.registrar@wv.gov</a>

- Vendor representatives must be met by a DOT employee conducting the meeting upon arrival to a DOT facility
  and escorted to the meeting location. After completion of the meeting, vendors must be escorted out of the
  facility.
- Upon completion of the meeting, all hard surfaces must be sanitized by the DOT employee(s) conducting the meeting.
- Pre-construction and Pre-bid meetings can be held outside of a DOT facility provided all safety guidelines can be met and no additional cost are incurred.
- Vendor representatives must provide their own refreshments.
- Delivery of bids to Building 5 must be scheduled. A DOT employee must meet the vendor representative at the Building 7 entrance and escort them to the bid box and back out of the facility. All facility COVID protocols apply.

# Disclosure of Interested Parties to Contracts

Pursuant to W. Va. Code § 6D-1-2, a state agency may not enter into a contract, or a series of related contracts, that has/have an actual or estimated value of \$1 million or more until the business entity submits to the contracting state agency a Disclosure of Interested Parties to the applicable contract. In addition, the business entity awarded a contract is obligated to submit a supplemental Disclosure of Interested Parties reflecting any new or differing interested parties to the contract within 30 days following the completion or termination of the applicable contract.

For purposes of complying with these requirements, the following definitions apply:

"Business entity" means any entity recognized by law through which business is conducted, including a sole proprietorship, partnership or corporation, but does not include publicly traded companies listed on a national or international stock exchange.

"Interested party" or "Interested parties" means:

 A business entity performing work or service pursuant to, or in furtherance of, the applicable contract, including specifically sub-contractors;

(2) the person(s) who have an ownership interest equal to or greater than 25% in the business entity performing work or service pursuant to, or in furtherance of, the applicable contract. (This subdivision

does not apply to a publicly traded company); and

(3) the person or business entity, if any, that served as a compensated broker or intermediary to actively facilitate the applicable contract or negotiated the terms of the applicable contract with the state agency. (This subdivision does not apply to persons or business entities performing legal services related to the negotiation or drafting of the applicable contract.)

"State agency" means a board, commission, office, department or other agency in the executive, judicial or legislative branch of state government, including publicly funded institutions of higher education: Provided, that for purposes of W. Va. Code § 6D-1-2, the West Virginia Investment Management Board shall not be deemed a state agency nor subject to the requirements of that provision.

The contracting business entity must complete this form and submit it to the contracting state agency prior to contract award and to complete another form within 30 days of contract completion or termination.

# **PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT**

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

ALL CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

#### **DEFINITIONS:**

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-20-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compilance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (W. Va. 
