



### **Machining/Welding & Fabrication Services**

1. Question: Can we bid the posted hourly rates for the (3) categories and provide proof of cost for the materials, parts and supplies with a fixed markup percentage?

Answer: Yes, bidding shall be done for the 3 hourly rates an additional line item shall be added to the pricing sheet for parts plus mark-up percentage.

2. Question: Can the DOH provide the bidders with (3) projects, one from each category and have us all submit a bid for your review to compare the quoted prices.

Answer: No, the state has 10,000+ pieces of equipment. 3 project samples will not give a good representation of work required.

3. Question: Why the State could not have each bidder submit their company's capabilities and capacities for each of the (3) categories we are bidding on.

Answer: 3.1 requires the vendor capabilities to be at a minimum CNC fabrication, Vertical milling, Horizontal lathe and Welding. A vendor description of capabilities and capacities has no bearing for locking a contractual price for services.

**4. Question:** Will the vendor be responsible for the pickup and delivery of all projects? Or will the DOH provide this service?

Answer: Vendor will be responsible for pickup and delivery from the Buckhannon facility

5. Question: How are we supposed to come up with an hourly rate when material for the jobs, trucking, shipping are all supposed to be included in this bid as a hourly rate? One job might take 1 piece of plate and be close to the shop but other jobs could include multiple different kinds of material, the piece of equipment might be 3 hours away, we all agreed that material needed should have its own bid amount, and not to be included in the 3 options on this bid list. Nobody could give us any idea of what we would be working on. (example) Saying that you need a brush hog repaired, I quote the material needed and send you the quote for the material, or even give us a list of vendors we can buy the material from. Then after that go off the hourly rate that has been set in contract, I would not mark material up just need cost of material to be paid.

**Answer**: WVDOH has 10,000+ pieces of equipment an accurate description of what jobs the vendor will be sent is impossible to determine.

**6. Question:** It was not clear how the parts and materials would be charged out on jobs.

A. Will the State cover those costs?

Answer: No, an updated pricing sheet will be attached with a line item for mark-up/mark-down percentage on parts cost.

B. Are they cost plus?

Answer: Yes, with the new pricing sheet a line item will be included for the vendor to bid mark-up/mark-down

C. Will there be a separate bid item for materials?

Answer: Yes, with the new pricing sheet a line item will be included for the vendor to bid mark-up/mark-down

D. How are those cost's to be billed?

Answer: With the new pricing sheet a line item will be included for the vendor to bid markup/mark-down

**7. Question:** Have a question about the Bid Sheet proposal for the machining, welding and fabrication services .

They have the (3) services covered on the bid sheet, but no place for materials that may be required. The DOH folks thought that the materials could be added in the hourly rates, but without knowing what we would be working on or require as needed materials, there is no way to cover materials cost in the labor rates.

All the vendors/contractors there proposed to them that they add a spot for materials cost +. On all my other T&M contracts I always show materials cost + 10%. Please let us know if they are going to add a section to cover material costs on the T&M style contract.

Answer: A new pricing sheet with a line item will be included for the vendor to bid mark-up/mark-down

### 4.1.1.8 will be added to read-

Vendor shall bill agency for parts at vendor's cost plus a

mark-up or mark-down designated by vendor on the pricing page. The mark-up shall apply to all parts and should be listed on the pricing page as a multiplier. (Example of how multiplier should be used are shown

below). For purposes of this contract, vendor's cost is the amount paid by the vendor to the manufacturer or supplier and does not include vendor's overhead, stocking fees delivery charged or other fees that are not direct payment for parts.

### Multiplier

### **Example Meaning**

- 0.5 vendor sells parts to agency at one-half (h) the vendor's cost
- 1.0 vendor sells parts to agency at vendor's cost
- 1.25 vendor sells parts to agency at vendor's cost plus 25% markup

## STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA Purchasing Division

### **PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT**

**CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS:** Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

**ALL CONTRACTS:** Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

**EXCEPTION:** The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

#### **DEFINITIONS:**

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (*W. Va. Code* §61-5-3) that: (1) for construction contracts, the vendor is not in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, and (2) for all other contracts, that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.

## **Disclosure of Interested Parties to Contracts**

Pursuant to *W. Va. Code* § 6D-1-2, a state agency may not enter into a contract, or a series of related contracts, that has/have an actual or estimated value of \$1 million or more until the business entity submits to the contracting state agency a Disclosure of Interested Parties to the applicable contract. In addition, the business entity awarded a contract is obligated to submit a supplemental Disclosure of Interested Parties reflecting any new or differing interested parties to the contract within 30 days following the completion or termination of the applicable contract.

For purposes of complying with these requirements, the following definitions apply:

"Business entity" means any entity recognized by law through which business is conducted, including a sole proprietorship, partnership or corporation, but does not include publicly traded companies listed on a national or international stock exchange.

- A business entity performing work or service pursuant to, or in furtherance of, the applicable contract, including specifically sub-contractors;
- (2) the person(s) who have an ownership interest equal to or greater than 25% in the business entity performing work or service pursuant to, or in furtherance of, the applicable contract. (This subdivision does not apply to a publicly traded company); and
- (3) the person or business entity, if any, that served as a compensated broker or intermediary to actively facilitate the applicable contract or negotiated the terms of the applicable contract with the state agency. (This subdivision does not apply to persons or business entities performing legal services related to the negotiation or drafting of the applicable contract.)

"State agency" means a board, commission, office, department or other agency in the executive, judicial or legislative branch of state government, including publicly funded institutions of higher education: Provided, that for purposes of W. Va. Code § 6D-1-2, the West Virginia Investment Management Board shall not be deemed a state agency nor subject to the requirements of that provision.

The contracting business entity must complete this form and submit it to the contracting state agency prior to contract award and to complete another form within 30 days of contract completion or termination.
