PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

ALL CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. "Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.


"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.





1,0 Clarifications

- 1.01 All timber removed from State Park shall not be sold. Any marketable timber will be stored onsite.
- 1.02 Towers #2 and #3 shall not be cut up. Towers #2 and #3 shall be removed in whole and transported to the golf course approximately 8 miles away to be used by Fire and Rescue.
- 1.03 Several existing small bridges exist on the access road to the lower section. Contractor is responsible for ensuring that these bridges are capable of supporting any construction equipment necessary for the project.







1,0 Clarifications

- 1.01 All timber removed from State Park shall not be sold. Any marketable timber will be stored onsite.
- 1.02 Towers #2 and #3 shall not be cut up. Towers #2 and #3 shall be removed in whole and transported to the golf course approximately 8 miles away to be used by Fire and Rescue.
- 1.03 Several existing small bridges exist on the access road to the lower section. Contractor is responsible for ensuring that these bridges are capable of supporting any construction equipment necessary for the project.
- 1.04 WVDNR will be responsible for disconnecting the power to the station at the bottom of the existing tram.
