

This includes performing all work prescribed in a workmanlike and acceptable manner, including labor, tools, equipment, supplies, material, incidentals, and quality control required to complete the work. Measurement: There will be no direct measurement of materials, labor, and services provided by the contractor in completing this item. Payment: Payment for item shall be in two installments. The first payment of 50% of the lump sum price shall be made following installation of the erosion and sediment controls. The Contractor, with approval of the COTR, shall adjust the final grades as necessary to create a finished project. The Contractor shall excavate to the lines and grades shown on the Plans. The Contractor shall perform all excavation of every description and of whatever materials encountered to the depths indicated on the Plans.
